Violation Information

1. Failed to employ or contract with one or more licensed wastewater treatment facility operators or wastewater system operations companies holding a valid Class D license or higher. Specifically, the individual operating the facility did not possess a current wastewater operator license; the license expired on July 30, 2020 [30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 30.350(d) and 305.125(1), TEX. WATER CODE § 26.0301(a), and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0011198001, Special Provisions No. 2].
2. Failed to have automatic flow measuring devices accurately calibrated by a trained person at Facility start-up and thereafter not less than annually [30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 305.125(1) and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0011198001, Monitoring Requirements No. 5].
3. Failed to measure flow according to permit requirements. Specifically, flow was not measured for the months of April, May, and June 2022 [30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 305.125(1) and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0011198001, Effluent Limitations and Monitoring Requirements No. B].
4. Failed to comply with permitted effluent limitations. Specifically, the Respondent exceeded the daily average concentration limit for biochemical oxygen demand of 100 milligrams per liter ("mg/L") with a result of 105 mg/L during the month of July 2022 [30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 305.125(1), TEX. WATER CODE § 26.121(a)(1), TCEQ Permit No. WQ0011198001, Effluent Limitations and Monitoring Requirements No. A].
5. Failed to restrict public access to the non-public irrigation area. Specifically, the Respondent was allowing a business with public access to operate on the land where treated effluent is applied which is permitted as non-public access land [30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 305.125(1) and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0011198001].
6. Failed to pay the associated late fees for TCEQ Financial Administration Account No. 23002648 [30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 21.4 and TEX. WATER CODE § 5.702].

The Order will require the Respondent to:

- a. Immediately, restrict public access to the non-public irrigation area.
- b. Within 15 days, submit written certification of compliance with a.
- c. Within 30 days:

 - (1) Flow measuring devices are calibrated annually; and
 - (2) Flow is measured in accordance with the permit.
 - ii. Conduct annual calibration of the irrigation flow meter.
- d. Within 45 days, submit written certification of compliance with c.
- e. Within 130 days, submit written certification of compliance with the permitted effluent limitations of TCEQ Permit No. WQ0011198001 including specific corrective actions that were implemented at the Facility to achieve compliance demonstrating at least three consecutive months of compliance with all permitted effluent limitation.

AGREED ORDER DOCKET NO. 2022-1675-MWD-E

I. JURISDICTION AND STIPULATIONS

On _____, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("the Commission" or "TCEQ") considered this agreement of the parties, resolving an enforcement action regarding CANYON RIDGE INVESTMENT COMPANY (the "Respondent") under the authority of TEX. WATER CODE chs. 5, 7 and 26. The Executive Director of the TCEQ, through the Enforcement Division, and the Respondent together stipulate that:

1. The Respondent owns and operates a wastewater treatment facility located at the northwest corner of McCormick Road and Bell Street, approximately 1,000 feet north of McCormick Road and approximately 4,000 feet east of Interstate Highway 27 in Randall County, Texas (the "Facility"). The Facility is near or adjacent to water in the state as defined in TEX. WATER CODE § 26.001(5).
2. The Executive Director and the Respondent agree that the TCEQ has jurisdiction to enter this Order pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE §§ 7.002, 7.051, and 7.073, and that the Respondent is subject to TCEQ's jurisdiction. The TCEQ has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE § 5.013 because it alleges violations of TEX. WATER CODE chs. 5 and 26 and the rules of the TCEQ.
3. The occurrence of any violation is in dispute and the entry of this Order shall not constitute an admission by the Respondent of any violation alleged in Section II ("Allegations"), nor of any statute or rule.
4. An administrative penalty in the amount of \$15,612 is assessed by the Commission in settlement of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations"). The Respondent paid \$380 of the penalty and \$3,122 is deferred contingent upon the Respondent's timely and satisfactory compliance with all the terms of this Order and shall be waived only upon full compliance with all the terms and conditions of this Order.

The remaining amount of \$12,110 of the undeferred penalty shall be paid in 35 monthly payments of \$346 each. The first monthly payment shall be paid within 30 days after the effective date of this Order. The subsequent payments shall each be paid not later than 30 days following the due date of the previous payment until the penalty is paid in full. If the Respondent fails to comply with the payment requirements of this Order, including the payment schedule, the Executive Director may accelerate the maturity of the remaining installments, in which event the unpaid balance shall become immediately

due and payable without demand or notice. The Respondent's failure to meet the payment schedule of this Order and/or the acceleration of any remaining balance constitutes the failure by the Respondent to timely and satisfactorily comply with all the terms and conditions of this Order and the Executive Director may demand payment of all or part of the deferred penalty amount.

5. The Executive Director and the Respondent agree on a settlement of the matters alleged in this enforcement action, subject to final approval in accordance with 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 70.10(a). Any notice and procedures, which might otherwise be authorized or required in this action, are waived in the interest of a more timely resolution of the matter.
6. The Executive Director may, without further notice or hearing, refer this matter to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas ("OAG") for further enforcement proceedings if the Executive Director determines that the Respondent has not complied with one or more of the terms or conditions in this Order.
7. This Order represents the complete and fully integrated agreement of the parties. The provisions of this Order are deemed severable and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable.
8. This Order shall terminate five years from its effective date or upon compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, whichever is later.
9. The Executive Director recognizes that the Respondent implemented the following corrective measures at the Facility:
 - a. By October 31, 2022, employed a licensed wastewater treatment facility operator holding a valid Class D license or higher; and
 - b. By March 10, 2025, paid the associated late fees for TCEQ Financial Administration Account No. 23002648.

II. ALLEGATIONS

During an investigation at the Facility conducted on September 19, 2022, an investigator documented that the Respondent:

1. Failed to employ or contract with one or more licensed wastewater treatment facility operators or wastewater system operations companies holding a valid Class D license or higher, in violation of 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 30.350(d) and 305.125(1), TEX. WATER CODE § 26.0301(a), and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0011198001, Special Provisions No. 2. Specifically, the individual operating the facility did not possess a current wastewater operator license; the license expired on July 30, 2020.
2. Failed to have automatic flow measuring devices accurately calibrated by a trained person at Facility start-up and thereafter not less than annually, in violation of 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 305.125(1) and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0011198001, Monitoring Requirements No. 5.

3. Failed to measure flow according to permit requirements, in violation of 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 305.125(1) and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0011198001, Effluent Limitations and Monitoring Requirements No. B. Specifically, flow was not measured for the months of April, May, and June 2022.
4. Failed to comply with permitted effluent limitations, in violation of 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 305.125(1), TEX. WATER CODE § 26.121(a)(1), TCEQ Permit No. WQ0011198001, Effluent Limitations and Monitoring Requirements No. A. Specifically, the Respondent exceeded the daily average concentration limit for biochemical oxygen demand of 100 milligrams per liter ("mg/L") with a result of 105 mg/L during the month of July 2022.
5. Failed to restrict public access to the non-public irrigation area, in violation of 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 305.125(1) and TCEQ Permit No. WQ0011198001. Specifically, the Respondent was allowing a business with public access to operate on the land where treated effluent is applied which is permitted as non-public access land.
6. Failed to pay the associated late fees for TCEQ Financial Administration Account No. 23002648, in violation of 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 21.4 and TEX. WATER CODE § 5.702.

III. DENIALS

The Respondent generally denies each allegation in Section II ("Allegations").

IV. ORDERING PROVISIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ORDERS that:

1. The Respondent is assessed a penalty as set forth in Section I, Paragraph No. 4. The payment of this penalty and the Respondent's compliance with all of the requirements set forth in this Order resolve only the allegations in Section II. The Commission shall not be constrained in any manner from requiring corrective action or penalties for violations which are not raised here. 2. The Respondent shall undertake the following technical requirements:
 - a. Immediately after the effective date of this Order, restrict public access to the non-public irrigation area.
 - b. Within 15 days after the effective date of this Order, submit written certification of compliance with Ordering Provision No. 2.a., in accordance with Ordering Provision No. 2.f. below.
 - c. Within 30 days after the effective date of this Order:

- i. Develop and implement procedures and conduct employee training to ensure that:
 - (1) Flow measuring devices are calibrated annually; and
 - (2) Flow is measured in accordance with the permit.
- ii. Conduct annual calibration of the irrigation flow meter.
- d. Within 45 days after the effective date of this Order, submit written certification of compliance with Ordering Provision No. 2.c., in accordance with Ordering Provision No. 2.f. below.
- e. Within 130 days after the effective date of this Order, submit written certification of compliance with the permitted effluent limitations of TCEQ Permit No. WQ0011198001 including specific corrective actions that were implemented at the Facility to achieve compliance and copies of the most current records, demonstrating at least three consecutive months of compliance with all permitted effluent limitation.
- f. The certifications required by Ordering Provision Nos. 2.c, 2.d., and 2.e shall include detailed supporting documentation including photographs, receipts, and/or other records to demonstrate compliance. The certification shall be signed by the Respondent and shall include the following certification language:

"I certify under penalty of law that I have personally examined and am familiar with the information submitted and all attached documents, and that based on my inquiry of those individuals immediately responsible for obtaining the information, I believe that the submitted information is true, accurate and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fines and imprisonment for knowing violations."

- 3. All relief not expressly granted in this Order is denied.

4. The duties and provisions imposed by this Order shall apply to and be binding upon the Respondent. The Respondent is ordered to give notice of this Order to personnel who maintain day-to-day control over the Facility operations referenced in this Order.
5. The Executive Director may grant an extension of any deadline in this Order or in any plan, report, or other document submitted pursuant to this Order, upon a written and substantiated showing of good cause. All requests for extensions by the Respondent shall be made in writing to the Executive Director. Extensions are not effective until the Respondent receives written approval from the Executive Director. The determination of what constitutes good cause rests solely with the Executive Director. Extension requests shall be sent to the Enforcement Division at the address listed above.
6. This Order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against the Respondent in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the OAG to: (1) enforce the terms of this Order; or (2) pursue violations of a statute within the Commission's jurisdiction, or of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued by the Commission under such a statute.
7. This Order may be executed in separate and multiple counterparts, which together shall constitute a single instrument. Any page of this Order may be copied, scanned, digitized, converted to electronic portable document format ("pdf"), or otherwise reproduced and may be transmitted by digital or electronic transmission, including but not limited to facsimile transmission and electronic mail. Any signature affixed to this Order shall constitute an original signature for all purposes and may be used, filed, substituted, or issued for any purpose for which an original signature could be used. The term "signature" shall include manual signatures and true and accurate reproductions of manual signatures created, executed, endorsed, adopted, or authorized by the person or persons to whom the signatures are attributable. - Referral of this case to the OAG for contempt, injunctive relief, additional penalties, and/or attorney fees, or to a collection agency;
- Increased penalties in any future enforcement actions;
- Automatic referral to the OAG of any future enforcement actions; and
- TCEQ seeking other relief as authorized by law.

In addition, any falsification of any compliance documents may result in criminal prosecution.
