Texas Commission on Environmental Quality Chapter 39 – Public Notice Non-Rule Project No. 2023-037-039-LS

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has completed its Rule Review of 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 39, Public Notice, as required by Texas Government Code (TGC), §2001.039. TGC, §2001.039, requires a state agency to review and consider for readoption, readoption with amendments, or repeal each of its rules every four years. TCEQ published its Notice of Intent to Review these rules in the October 6, 2023 issue of the *Texas Register* (48 TexReg 5828).

The review assessed whether the initial reasons for adopting the rules continue to exist, and TCEQ has determined that those reasons exist. The rules in Chapter 39 are required because Chapter 39 implements various state statutes and federal regulations that prescribe the requirements for public notice of and public participation regarding applications for certain air quality; water quality; municipal, industrial and hazardous waste; underground injection control; and radioactive materials permits.

Public Comment

The public comment period closed on November 6, 2023. TCEQ did not receive comments on the rules review of this chapter.

As a result of the review, TCEQ finds that the reasons for adopting the rules in 30 TAC Chapter 39 continue to exist and readopts these sections in accordance with the requirements of TGC, §2001.039.
