# EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPLIES TO EXCEPTIONS TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S PROPOSAL FOR DECISION

#### I. OVERVIEW

The Executive Director of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ or Commission) submits her Replies to Exceptions to the Proposal for Decision.

### II. DISCUSSION

Ronnie Autry and Brazoria County (collectively "Protestants") submitted Exceptions to the Administrative Law Judge's Proposal for Decision.<sup>1</sup> The Protestants' Exceptions reiterate the arguments they made during the hearing on the merits and in their closing arguments.

As provided in the Executive Director's prefiled testimony and during cross examination at the hearing on the merits, the Executive Director considered the information provided by the Protestants in their prefiled testimony, and based on that testimony, reassessed the characteristics of the discharge route. Dr. Wallace revaluated the aerial imagery of the area and determined that the flow status would be better characterized as intermittent with pools and limited aquatic life use. Dr. Lu subsequently performed an additional Dissolved Oxygen (DO) model, to ensure the proposed effluent limits would be adequate to maintain the DO levels above Dr. Wallace's updated DO criteria. Finally, based on the revised memos, Venkata Kancharla confirmed that the change to the aquatic life use designation for Angleton Drainage Ditches Nos. 7 and 22 did not impact the draft permit. This additional review supported the Executive Director's position that the draft permit, if issued, will comply with all applicable statutory and regulatory requirements, and should be issued as drafted.

The Protestants did not successfully rebut any portion of the Executive Director's review of the application; thus, the Executive Director maintains that the draft permit complies with all applicable statutory and regulatory requirements and should be issued without changes.

## III. CONCLUSION

The Executive Director maintains her position that the draft permit meets all applicable statutory and regulatory requirements and respectfully recommends the Administrative Law Judge issue a Revised Proposal for Decision with the Executive Director's recommended changes in her Exceptions to the Proposal for Decision to accurately reflect the record and the provisions in the Draft Permit.
