**COMMENTS:** This permit is for a waste treatment facility next door to our residential property which is less than 100'away. This area on C. R. 59 aka Magnolia Parkway is primarily residential acreage homes. Our property has a large fresh body lake within 30' of the property line that supplies nourishment to fish and wildlife & recreational swimming .We are concerned of possible cross contamination due to seepage during floods, hurricanes or broken lines. Another concern is this property is very close to the American Canal and City of Pearland Water treatment plant. This American

Canal is a water source for the city of Pearland. A domestic water treatment facility should not be allowed to be built in this area of homes and wildlife. An RV resort on a busy 2 lane poorly paved road with a WEIGHT LOAD bridge of 17,500 pounds necessary to cross to get to the property is another concern. This bridge crosses the american canal which stated above is a water source for City of Pearland Texas. I oppose the application, and I request a contested hearing. A letter with more clear instructions as how to oppose this should also be issued to all residents surrounding this property. Thank you for your consideration saving our residential area from possible contamination and environmental issues that will arise.
