I am writing to express my concern regarding US Ecology Texas' application for a proposed permit number 50421, to authorize the storage of hazardous and nonhazardous waste at US Ecology Texas Rail Site located at 4364 County Road 30, Robstown, Texas, 78380. This area is surrounded by farm land that primarily grows grain sorghum, corn, and cotton. This land has been farmed for over 100 years and is very productive with crops eaten both by humans and animals, and cotton that is made into fabrics and textiles. Some of the hazardous waste that they are seeking approval to store includes chemicals that are poisonous to humans and animals. The land area also includes water, oil, and gas pipelines.

My principal concerns include:

- Possible soil contamination due to rain water runoff that could directly impact crop production
- Possible water contamination due to water wells being located in the area
- Possible air contamination that can be inhaled or deposited on the crops and soil
- Corrosion of the water, oil, and gas pipelines by contaminants
- Decreasing property value of the and /or commercial development of land in the general area of the storage facility

I would also like to know:

- The size of the two container storage areas and the storage building.
- What percentage of hazardous vs nonhazardous waste they intend to store?
- Physical protections they will put in place to ensure chemicals will not leech into the air, soil, or water.
- When transporting chemicals by rail, how will they ensure that spills will not occur?
- How often the site will be inspected and how the public will access inspection reports.
- How often water and soil will be tested and how the public will have access to test results/reports. Also, regarding possible soil and water contamination due to rainwater runoff - How far away from the site will the water and soil will be tested?

I am requesting that the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality hold a public meeting to address the concerns listed above. There is a significant degree of public interest in this permit application and the affects that the storage of hazardous waste will have on the surrounding land and on the community.
