I am the closest resident and landowner to the West District WWTP, and live about 200 feet from the facility's fence line. I have three major concerns with the Applicant's proposed permit amendment.

- 1. My family and our neighbors fish and boat in the bayou and the oxbow. I disagree with your assertion that "existing water quality uses will not be impaired." Changing the amount and type of discharge from this facility will impair the fishing and boating we enjoy in the bayou and the oxbow adjacent to the facility. I would ask the TCEQ to investigate the impact on the local fisheries and water quality in the bayou and the oxbow.
- 2. When there is a large rain event, untreated black water overflows from the facility into the bayou and the oxbow. During Harvey, due to the bayou flow north into Rummel Creek, this untreated black water flowed through my property and my house. I understand the Applicant has received federal funds to fix this violation of EPA law, but has not done so. I would ask the TCEQ to investigate this violation of federal law, and if the Applicant is also in violation of state law under the TCEQ's jurisdiction.
- 3. This facility also has a significant impact on our local air quality. My neighbors and my family have been working with the Applicant for years to lessen the impact on our neighborhood. Applicant's staff have indicated that the odor is derived from H2S and other sulfur compounds. I would ask the TCEQ to investigate the impact on our air quality in the neighborhood adjacent to this facility.

I request a contested case hearing.
