EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR’S RESPONSE TO HEARING REQUESTS

I. SUMMARY

The Executive Director recommends that the Commission find that all other requestors are not affected persons and deny their hearing requests.

II. INTRODUCTION

The Executive Director (ED) of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ or Commission) files this Response to Hearing Requests on the petition by Steve Selinger as the landowner (Petitioner) for the creation of Shankle Road Municipal Utility District of Ellis County (District). The TCEQ received hearing requests from the individuals and entities listed in Attachment A.

The District would contain 181.5664 acres located within Ellis County. The proposed District is located in Ellis County, Texas, east of IH 45 and north of FM 660. The proposed district is not located within the corporate limits or extraterritorial jurisdiction of any city, town, or village.

The Petition states that the general nature of the work to be done by the District is:

- (1) purchase, construct, acquire, improve, or extend inside or outside of its boundaries any and all works, improvements, facilities, plants, equipment, and appliances necessary or helpful to supply and distribute water for municipal, domestic, and commercial purposes;
- (2) collect, transport, process, dispose of and control domestic, and commercial wastes;
- (3) gather, conduct, divert, abate, amend, and control local storm water or other local harmful excesses of water in the proposed District;
- (4) design, acquire, construct, finance, improve, operate, and maintain macadamized, graveled, or paved roads and turnpikes, or improvements in aid of those roads; and

(5) purchase, construct, acquire, improve, or extend inside or outside of its boundaries such additional facilities, systems, plants, and enterprises as shall be consonant with all of the purposes for which the proposed District is created. Additionally, the Petition includes a request that the proposed District be granted road powers pursuant to Texas Water Code § 54.234.

The District will be considered a “developer project” as defined by 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 293.44(a). Therefore, developer cost participation in accordance with 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 293.47 will be required.

Included with the ED’s response are: Attachment A (list of individuals and entities that submitted a hearing request), Attachment B (zoomed out map of the proposed District with hearing requestors numbered), Attachment C (zoomed out map of the proposed District with hearing requestors numbered), Attachment D (map of the proposed District showing a 1.5-mile radius with the hearing requestors numbered), Attachment E (map of the proposed District showing a 1-mile radius with the hearing requestors numbered), Attachment F (map of the proposed District showing a 0.5-mile radius with the hearing requestors numbered), Attachment G (appendix of the hearing requestors in numerical order), and Attachment H (appendix of the hearing requestors in order of distance to the proposed District). Please note that the following requestors were not included on the map: Vonne Battastini, (California address), Shellie Heard (P.O. Box as address), and Archa Cassel (P.O. Box as address).

III. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Petitioner filed an application with the TCEQ for the creation of the District and it was declared administratively complete on August 23, 2022. The Notice of District Petition was published in *Ennis News*, a newspaper generally circulated in Ellis County, where the District is proposed to be located, on December 4, 2022, and December 11, 2022. The Notice of District Petition was also posted on the bulletin board used for posting legal notices in the Ellis County Courthouse on November 29, 2022. The TCEQ received approximately 50 comments opposing the creation of the district and approximately 265 requests for a hearing. The TCEQ also received 5 public meeting requests; however, there is no public meeting requirement for proposed District creation applications. The period to request a contested case hearing ended on January 10, 2023.

The Office of the Chief Clerk sent notice of the agenda setting for the Commission’s consideration of the hearing requests on July 19, 2023.

IV. CREATION OF MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICTS

A. *District Purpose*

A municipal utility district (MUD) may be created under and subject to the authority, conditions, and restrictions of Article XVI, Section 59, of the Texas Constitution. TEX. WATER CODE § 54.011. The District in this case is proposed to be created and organized according to the terms and provisions of Article XVI, Section 59, of the Texas Constitution and Chapters 49 and 54 of the Texas Water Code.

A MUD may be created for the following purposes:

- (1) the control, storage, preservation, and distribution of its storm water and floodwater, the water of its rivers and streams for irrigation, power, and all other useful purposes;
- (2) the reclamation and irrigation of its arid, semiarid, and other land needing irrigation;
- (3) the reclamation and drainage of its overflowed land and other land needing drainage;
- (4) the conservation and development of its forests, water, and hydroelectric power;
- (5) the navigation of its inland and coastal water;
- (6) the control, abatement, and change of any shortage or harmful excess of water;
- (7) the protection, preservation, and restoration of the purity and sanitary condition of water within the state; and
- (8) the preservation of all natural resources of the state.

TEX. WATER CODE § 54.012. The Commission has jurisdiction to hear this case and create the District. TEX. WATER CODE § 54.014.

B. Required Findings

The Commission must grant or deny a MUD creation application in accordance with TEX. WATER CODE § 54.021. In order to grant an application, the Commission must find that organization of the district as requested is feasible and practicable and is necessary and would be a benefit to the land to be included in the district. TEX. WATER CODE § 54.021(a); 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 293.13(b)(1). If the Commission fails to make these findings, it shall refuse to grant the petition. TEX. WATER CODE § 54.021(d); 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 293.13(a).

In determining if a project is feasible and practicable and if it is necessary and would be a benefit to the land included in the district, the Commission shall consider:

- (1) the availability of comparable service from other systems, including but not limited to water districts, municipalities, and regional authorities;
- (2) the reasonableness of projected construction costs, tax rates, and water and sewer rates; and
- (3) whether or not the district and its system and subsequent development within the district will have an unreasonable effect on the following:
 - (A) land elevation;
 - (B) subsidence;
 - (C) groundwater level within the region;
 - (D) recharge capability of a groundwater source;
 - (E) natural run-off rates and drainage;
 - (F) water quality; and

- (G) total tax assessments on all land located within a district.

TEX. WATER CODE § 54.021(b).

The Commission, however, must exclude the areas that it finds would not be benefited by the creation of the district and must redefine the boundaries of the proposed district according to its findings. 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 293.13(b)(2); TEX. WATER CODE § 54.021(c).

V. EVALUATION PROCESS FOR HEARING REQUESTS

As the application was declared administratively complete after September 1, 1999, it is subject to the requirements of Title 30, Chapter 55, Subchapter G, Sections 55.250-55.256 of the Texas Administrative Code. The Commission, the Executive Director, the Petitioner, or affected persons may request a contested case hearing on this application. 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 55.251(a). The Commission must evaluate the hearing requests and may take one of the following actions:

- (1) determine that the hearing requests do not meet the rule requirements and act on the application;
- (2) determine that the hearing requests do not meet the rule requirements and refer the application to a public meeting to develop public comment before acting on the application;
- (3) determine that the hearing requests meet the rule requirements and refer the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (“SOAH”) for a hearing; or
- (4) refer the hearing requests to SOAH for a hearing on whether the hearing requests meet the rule requirements.

30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 55.255(a).

The regulations provide that a hearing request made by an affected person must be in writing and must be filed with the Office of the Chief Clerk within the time provided in the Notice of District Petition. 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 55.251(b) and (d). These two requirements are mandatory. The affected person’s hearing request must also substantially comply with the following:

- (1) give the name, address, and daytime telephone number of the person who files the request;
- (2) identify the person's personal justiciable interest affected by the application, including a brief, but specific, written statement explaining in plain language the requestor's location and distance relative to the activity that is the subject of the application and how and why the requestor believes he or she will be affected by the activity in a manner not common to members of the general public;
- (3) request a contested case hearing; and
- (4) provide any other information specified in the public notice of application.

30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 55.251(c).

An affected person's personal justiciable interest must be related to a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest affected by the application belonging to the requestor and not an interest common to members of the general public. 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 55.256(a). The regulations give the Commission flexibility to determine affected person status by considering any relevant factor, including the following:

- (1) whether the interest claimed is one protected by the law under which the application will be considered;
- (2) distance restrictions or other limitations imposed by law on the affected interest;
- (3) whether a reasonable relationship exists between the interest claimed and the activity regulated;
- (4) likely impact of the regulated activity on the health and safety of the person, and on the use of property of the person; and
- (5) likely impact of the regulated activity on use of the impacted natural resource by the person.
- (6) For governmental entities, their statutory authority over or interest in the issues relevant to the application.

30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 55.256(c).

VI. HEARING REQUESTS

A. *Analysis of LRM-PTM Partners, LP's Hearing Request*

LRM-PTM Enterprises, LLC, general partner, and Gary D. Witherspoon, president, submitted a timely request on behalf of LRM-PTM Partners, LP. The hearing request contained the name, address, and office phone number of Mr. Witherspoon pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). It did not contain the address or phone number of LRM-PTM Enterprises, LLC. They requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). They also provided the TCEQ Internal Control Number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). The request contains a statement which includes their property's location and distance relative to the proposed District and explains how they believe they are affected in a manner not common to members of the general public by the proposed District as required by 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2).

The Executive Director reviewed the factors found in 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.256 for determination of an affected person. LRM-PTM Partners, LP did not demonstrate that they had a personal justiciable interest related to a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest affected by the application that is not common to members of the general public as required by 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.256(a). The request did not demonstrate that a reasonable relationship exists between their stated property interest and the proposed District as they raised issues concerning the discharge of wastewater effluent. Such concerns are outside the scope of the MUD creation process. Members of the public have the opportunity to raise their concerns regarding a proposed wastewater discharge permit during the public participation process for that permit. Furthermore, the request did not raise any of the issues found in Tex. Water Code § 54.021(b) that the Commission may consider when reviewing a MUD creation

petition. In the request, they raised issues related to property values, which the Commission may not consider when reviewing a MUD creation petition. As such, the Executive Director recommends that the Commission finds that LRM-PTM Partners, LP, is not an affected person pursuant to the criteria found in 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.256 and recommends denying their hearing request.

B. Analysis of Kevin Noack's Hearing Request

Kevin Noack, Superintendent of the Palmer Independent School District, submitted a timely hearing request. The hearing request included the letterhead of the school district, but it did not specifically state whether Mr. Noack was writing in his personal capacity or on behalf of the school district. The hearing request included his name, address of the school district, and phone number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). He requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). He also provided the TCEQ Internal Control Number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4).

The Executive Director reviewed the factors found in 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.256 for determination of an affected person. The statements in the request did not demonstrate that he had a personal justiciable interest related to a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest affected by the application that is not common to members of the general public. Specifically, Mr. Noack's hearing request raised the following issues: concern regarding hardship on current taxpayers, the increased number of school-aged children, and lack of bond capacity to build multiple campuses. The request did not address how he was personally affected by the application. Moreover, the issues raised in the hearing request are not issues the Commission may consider when reviewing a MUD petition pursuant to Tex. Water Code 54.021(b). As such, regardless of whether the request was submitted by Mr. Noack as an individual or on behalf of the school district, the Executive Director recommends that the Commission find that Mr. Noack is not an affected person pursuant to the criteria in 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.256 and recommends denying his hearing request.

C. Analysis of Hearing Requests by Individuals

1. Individuals' Hearing Requests that the ED Recommends Granting

All of the requesters below have raised issues that are within the Commission's jurisdiction to consider in the context of a district's creation. Their concerns include land elevation, groundwater level within region, recharge capability of a groundwater source, natural run-off rates and drainage, and water quality concerns. The requestors in this section are also located within close proximity to the proposed District's boundaries, which increases the likelihood that they will be affected in a way not common to members of the general public. Their locations, in conjunction with their stated concerns, demonstrate that these requestors have a personal justiciable interest in this matter. Accordingly, the Executive Director respectfully recommends that the following requestors be found as affected persons by the Commission:

David Adams (#1 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained his name, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1).

He requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). He also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). Furthermore, he identified his personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2); he raised issues relating to runoff rates and drainage, stated how he would be affected by the District in a way uncommon to the general public, and described where his property is situated in relation to the District. Due to the location of his property relative to the proposed district and the concerns raised, the Executive Director recommends that the Commission find that he is an affected person and grant his hearing request.

Elizabeth Adams (#2 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained her name, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). She requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). She also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). Furthermore, she identified her personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2); she raised issues relating to runoff and drainage, stated how she would be affected by the District in a way uncommon to the general public, and described where her property is situated in relation to the District. Due to the location of her property relative to the proposed district and the concerns raised, the Executive Director recommends that the Commission find that she is an affected person and grant her hearing request.

Marry Ann Allred (#4 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained her name, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). She requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). She also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). Furthermore, she identified her personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2); she raised issues relating to runoff, drainage, and water quality, stated how she would be affected by the District in a way uncommon to the general public, and described where her property is situated in relation to the District. Code § 55.251(c)(4). Furthermore, they identified their personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2); they raised issues relating to runoff and drainage, stated how they would be affected by the District in a way uncommon to the general public, and described where their property is situated in relation to the District. Due to the location of their property relative to the proposed district and the concerns raised, the Executive Director recommends that the Commission find that they are affected persons and grant their hearing request.

Melissa & Mark Zmolik (#227 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained their name, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). They requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). They also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). Furthermore, they identified their personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2); they raised issues relating to runoff and drainage, stated how they would be affected by the District in a way uncommon to the general public, and described where their property is situated in relation to the District. Due to the location of their property relative to the proposed district and the concerns raised, the Executive Director recommends that the Commission find that they are affected persons and grant their hearing request.

2. Individuals' Hearing Requests that the ED Recommends Denying

These requests failed to demonstrate how the requestors will be affected by the activity in a manner not common to members of the general public or otherwise failed to state an interest related to a state legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest affected by the application. See 30 TAC §§ 55.251, 55.256. This group of requestors either did not explain how they believe they will be affected by the proposed District's creation or otherwise did not state concerns that are within the jurisdiction of TCEQ to address in the context of a district's creation.

Additionally, many of the hearing requests state concerns about anticipated adverse impacts from a proposed wastewater treatment facility. Concerns about a proposed wastewater treatment facility do not provide a basis for demonstrating affected person status in the district application matter now before the Commission. Requestors expressing concern about the impacts of the wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) may submit comments and hearing requests on the TPDES application when appropriate.

Aaron Lee Armstrong (#5 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained his name, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). He requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). He also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). However, the issues raised in the hearing request, flooding, wildlife concerns, emergency services, schools, traffic, and property concerns, are not issues the Commission may consider when reviewing a MUD creation application. The request also did not articulate how he is personally affected in a way uncommon to the general public. As a result, he has not identified a personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2). The Executive Director recommends the Commission deny his hearing request.

Dorothy Bjork (#15 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained her name and address pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). She requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). She also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). However, the issues raised in the hearing request, flooding, emergency services, schools, and property concerns, are not issues the Commission may consider when reviewing a MUD creation application. Ms. Bjork stated she had “water and sewer concerns” but did not articulate how that would personally affect her in a way uncommon to the general public. While the request states she is a member of Crisp Cemetery and her concerns about drainage, it does not articulate how she is affected in a way uncommon to the general public. Moreover, the request does not identify a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest that is affected by the proposed District. As a result, she has not identified a personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2). The Executive Director recommends the Commission deny her hearing request.

Gregory Bjork (#17 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained his name and address pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). He requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). He also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). However, the issues raised in the hearing request, flooding, emergency services, schools, and property concerns, are not issues the Commission may consider when reviewing a MUD creation application. Mr. Bjork stated he had “water and sewer concerns” but did not articulate how that would personally affect him in a way uncommon to the general public. While the request states he is a member of Crisp Cemetery and his concerns about drainage, it does not identify a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest that is affected by the proposed District. As a result, he has not identified a personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2). The Executive Director recommends the Commission deny his hearing request.

Clint & Tish Bouska (#18 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained their names, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). They requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). They also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). While the request expressed their opposition to the MUD petition, it did not raise any issues. The request also did not articulate how they are affected in a way that is uncommon to the general public. Moreover, the request does not identify a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or

economic interest that is affected by the proposed District. As a result, they have not identified a personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2). The Executive Director recommends the Commission deny their hearing request.

David Blake Butler (#29 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained his name, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). He requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). He also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). However, the issues raised in the request, odors, wildlife concerns, impact on livestock, traffic, roads, schools, and emergency services, are not issues the Commission may consider when reviewing a MUD creation application. While the hearing request raises issues related to runoff, this concern solely refers to the proposed WWTP rather than the MUD creation petition. Moreover, the request does not identify a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest that is affected by the proposed District. As a result, he has not identified a personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2). The Executive Director recommends the Commission deny his hearing request.

Glen Copeland (#39 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained his name, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). He requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). He also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). However, the issues raised in the hearing request, flooding, odors from the WWTP, traffic, emergency services, and schools, are not issues the Commission may consider when reviewing a MUD creation application. Moreover, the request does not identify a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest that is affected by the proposed District. As a result, he has not identified a personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2). The Executive Director recommends the Commission deny his hearing request.

Robert Crittenden (#40 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained his name, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). He requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). He also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). However, the issues raised in the hearing request, emergency services and property values, are not issues the Commission may consider when reviewing a MUD creation application. The request lists “environmental impact” as a concern but it does not raise a referable issue. He also did not articulate how he personally is affected in a way uncommon to the general public. Moreover, the request does not identify a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest that is affected by the proposed District. As a result, he has not identified a personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2). The Executive Director recommends the Commission deny his hearing request.

Herman L. Cryer (#42 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained his name, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). He requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). He also provided the internal control number as required in the notice

and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). However, the issues raised in the hearing request, concerns about WWTP effluent and odors, are not issues the Commission may consider when reviewing a MUD creation application. The request states his concern about disruption to a pipeline running through the property but does not provide specific details about this pipeline or its location. Moreover, the request does not identify a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest that is affected by the proposed District. As a result, he has not identified a personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2). The Executive Director recommends the Commission deny his hearing request.

Phillip Cryer (#44 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained his name, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). He requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). He also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). However, the issues raised in the hearing request, concerns about WWTP effluent and odors, are not issues the Commission may consider when reviewing a MUD creation application. The request states his concern about disruption to a pipeline running through the property but does not provide specific details about this pipeline or its location. Moreover, the request does not identify a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest that is affected by the proposed District. As a result, he has not identified a personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2). The Executive Director recommends the Commission deny his hearing request.

Shelby Cryer (#46 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained her name, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). She requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). She also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). However, the issues raised in the hearing request, concerns about WWTP effluent and odors, are not issues the Commission may consider when reviewing a MUD creation application. The request states her concern about disruption to a pipeline running through the property but does not provide specific details about this pipeline or its location. Moreover, the request does not identify a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest that is affected by the proposed District. As a result, she has not identified a personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2). The Executive Director recommends the Commission deny her hearing request.

Nell Cryer (#43 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained her name, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). She requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). She also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). However, the issues raised in the hearing request, concerns about WWTP effluent and odors, are not issues the Commission may consider when reviewing a MUD creation application. The request states her concern about disruption to a pipeline running through the property but does not provide specific details about this pipeline or its location. Moreover, the request does not identify a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest that is affected by the proposed District. As a result, she has not identified a personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2). The Executive Director recommends the Commission deny her hearing request.

Ronnie & Rose Dlabaj (#48 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained their names, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). They requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). They also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). However, the issues raised in the hearing request, such as WWTP effluent and odors, are not issues the Commission may consider when reviewing a MUD creation application. The request does not demonstrate how they are affected in a way that is uncommon to the general public. Moreover, the request does not identify a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest that is affected by the proposed District. As a result, they have not identified a personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2). The Executive Director recommends the Commission deny their hearing request.

Dorothy Dvorak (#51 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained her name, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). She requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). She also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). However, the issues raised in the hearing request, concerns about erosion, are not issues the Commission may consider when reviewing a MUD creation application. While the request states Ms. Dvorak is “the representative of Crisp Cemetery” and provides the cemetery’s address, the request does not contain any other identifying information that clearly indicates she is speaking on behalf of a group or association. Ms. Dvorak states her concerns about the potential exposure of the graves in the cemetery but does not articulate how she is affected in a way uncommon to the general public. Moreover, the request does not identify a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest that is affected by the proposed District. As a result, she has not identified a personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2). The Executive Director recommends the Commission deny her hearing request.

George Michael Kilpatrick (#93 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained his name, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). He requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). He also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). However, the issues raised in the hearing request, emergency services, odors from WWTP, and traffic, are not issues the Commission may consider when reviewing a MUD creation application. Moreover, the request does not identify a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest that is affected by the proposed District. As a result, he has not identified a personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2). The Executive Director recommends the Commission deny his hearing request.

Rhonda Kilpatrick (#94 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained her name, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). As a result, she has not identified a personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2). The Executive Director recommends the Commission deny her hearing request.

Janice Landsfeld (#99 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained her name, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). The request does not describe how he is personally affected in a way uncommon to the general public. Moreover, the request does not identify a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest that is affected by the proposed District. As a result, he has not identified a personal justiciable interest pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(2). The Executive Director recommends the Commission deny his hearing request.

Bernard D. Martinek (#115 on the map) submitted an individual, timely request which contained his name, address, and phone number pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(1). He requested a contested case hearing pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(3). He also provided the internal control number as required in the notice and pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 55.251(c)(4). However, the issues raised in the hearing request, concerns about WWTP effluent, are not issues the Commission may consider when reviewing a MUD creation application. 
