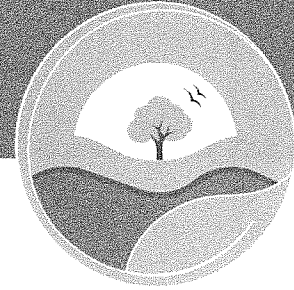

Re: Lyondell Chemical Company Water Quality Permit Amendment, WQ0002927000

Dear Ms. Gharis,

On January 5, 2021, Lyondell Chemical Channelview South Plant facility applied for an Amendment to Water Quality Permit WQ0002927000. The current permit allows for an Interim I Phase and Final Phase for Outfall 001 at the facility located at 2502 Sheldon Road, Channelview, TX 77530. Harris County Pollution Control Services Department (PCS) submits the following comment and recommendation in response to the opportunity for public comment.

Pollution Control inspects facilities in Harris County for compliance with air quality laws and regulations, reviews permit applications, and comments to the TCEQ on permitting actions. Pollution Control also works closely with the TCEQ's Houston regional office, which, as a matter of course, refers a substantial portion of environmental complaints, including nuisance complaints, from Harris County citizens to PCS. Pollution Control then investigates these complaints and, when appropriate, issues Violation Notices and refers cases to the Harris County Attorney's Office or District Attorney's Office for civil or criminal enforcement.

PCS recommends adding a criteria in the Other Requirement section in the permit, requiring Lyondell Chemical to notify the PCS prior to progressing to Final Phase. Suggested language:

- The Permittee shall notify in writing Harris County Pollution Control Services forty-five (45) days prior to progressing to the Final Phase on Notice of Completion form 20007.
