Executive Director,

I, Charles Neiman, am making a request for reconsideration in reference to the above permit number.. The reason I believe the decision should be reconsidered:

- Around five years ago, I was contacted in regards to SWEPCO. They were wanting a permit to discharge more chemicals into Johnson Creek, which feeds Lake O' Pines. Upon my request for the name of the chemicals I was amazed by the types of chemicals they wanted to release. One being arsenic. They stated they wanted to test the water every five years. They also stated that because I was upstream I would not be affected. I don't believe that could be a true statement, because Johnson Creek flows through my property and I can see the plant from my house.
- The case above deals with copper and the cleaning agents. I don't believe that going from two year testing to five year testing is acceptable. I further do not believe in letting companies and plants of any kind test themselves. That is the job of the EPA.
- There is a lot at stake due to the wildlife and people who depend upon this water for their livelihood. Health of people and animals is also a concern. Remember Johnson Creek feeds into Lake O' Pines.

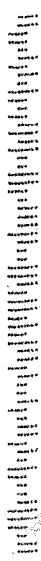

I received a letter of Intent to Obtain Water Quality Permit Amendment for Southwestern Electric Power Company. I do not agree that the company should be granted this permit to lessen the amount of times the water is checked for copper. This water containing copper leaves the power plant at 1707 Wilkes Power Plant Road, Avinger in Marion County, Tx 75630 and goes to Johnson Creek then to the Lake O' Pines. Wildlife drink from the creek and lake as well as people eat fish that comes from these waters. Southwestern Power Plant Company should have outside compliance agencies check toxic wastewater levels on a regular basis.
