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## Violation Information

- 1. Failed to submit a Disinfection Level Quarterly Operating Report ("DLQOR") to the Executive Director ("ED") by the tenth day of the month following the end of each quarter [30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 290.110(e)(4)(A) and (f)(3)].
- 2. Failed to mail or directly deliver one copy of the Consumer Confidence Report ("CCR") to each bill paying customer by July 1 for each year, and failed to submit to the TCEQ by July 1 each year a copy of the annual CCR and certification that the CCR has been distributed to the customers of the Facility and that the information in the CCR is correct and consistent with compliance monitoring data [30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 290.271(b) and 290.274(a) and (c)].
- 3. Failed to submit a recommendation to the ED for source water treatment within 180 days after the end of the monitoring period during which the lead action level was exceeded [30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 290.117(g)(2)(A)].
- 4. Failed to submit a recommendation to the ED for optimal corrosion control treatment within six months after the end of the monitoring period during which the lead action level was exceeded [30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 290.117(f)(3)(A)].
- 5. Failed to provide public notification, accompanied with a signed Certificate of Delivery, to the ED regarding the failure to submit a DLQOR to the ED by the tenth day of the month following the end of each quarter [30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 290.122(c)(2)(A) and (f)].

- ii. Provide public notification and submit a copy of each public notification, accompanied with a signed Certificate of Delivery, to the ED regarding the failure to

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submit a DLQOR to the ED by the tenth day of the month following the end of each quarter for the first quarter of 2022.

- b. Within 45 days:
- i. Submit to the Commission a copy of the CCR provided to customers of the Facility and the certification that the CCR has been provided to the customers of the Facility and that the information in the CCR is correct and consistent with the compliance monitoring data; and
- ii. Submit written certification to demonstrate compliance with a.
- c. Within 60 days, submit written certification to demonstrate compliance with b.i.
- d. Within 180 days:
- i. Submit to the ED a source water lead and copper treatment recommendation; and
- ii. Submit to the ED an optimal corrosion control treatment recommendation.
- e. Within 195 days, submit written certification to demonstrate compliance with d.

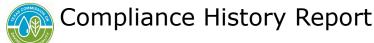

#### AGREED ORDER DOCKET NO. 2023-1312-PWS-E

On \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("the Commission" or "TCEQ") considered this agreement of the parties, resolving an enforcement action regarding the City of Edmonson (the "Respondent") under the authority of Tex. Health & Safety Code ch. 341. The Executive Director of the TCEQ, through the Enforcement Division, and the Respondent, presented this Order to the Commission.

The Respondent understands that it has certain procedural rights at certain points in the enforcement process, including the right to formal notice of violations, notice of an evidentiary hearing, the right to an evidentiary hearing, and a right to appeal. By entering into this Order, the Respondent agrees to waive all notice and procedural rights.

It is further understood and agreed that this Order represents the complete and fully-integrated agreement of the parties. The provisions of this Order are deemed severable and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable. The duties and responsibilities imposed by this Order are binding upon the Respondent.

The Commission makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law:

#### I. FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Respondent owns and operates a public water supply located at 307 West 1st Street in Edmonson, Hale County, Texas (the "Facility"). The Facility provides water for human consumption, has approximately 40 service connections, and serves at least 25 people per day for at least 60 days per year. As such, the Facility is a public water system as defined in 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 290.38(73).
- 2. During a record review for the Facility conducted on July 24, 2023 through September 8, 2023, an investigator documented that:
  - a. The Respondent did not submit a Disinfection Level Quarterly Operating Report ("DLQOR") to the Executive Director by the tenth day of the month following the end of each quarter for the third and fourth quarters of 2022 and the first quarter of 2023.
  - b. The Respondent did not mail or directly deliver one copy of the Consumer Confidence Report ("CCR") to each bill paying customer by July 1 for each year, and failed to submit to the TCEQ by July 1 each year a copy of the annual CCR and certification that the CCR has been distributed to the customers of the

- Facility and that the information in the CCR is correct and consistent with compliance monitoring data for calendar years 2020 and 2021.
- c. The Respondent did not submit a recommendation to the Executive Director for source water treatment within 180 days after the end of the July 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022 monitoring period during which the lead action level was exceeded.
- d. The Respondent did not submit a recommendation to the Executive Director for optimal corrosion control treatment within six months after the end of the July 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022 monitoring period during which the lead action level was exceeded.
- e. The Respondent did not provide public notification, accompanied with a signed Certificate of Delivery, to the Executive Director regarding the failure to submit a DLQOR to the Executive Director by the tenth day of the month following the end of each quarter for the first quarter of 2022.
- 3. The Executive Director recognizes that by October 3, 2023, the Respondent submitted a DLQOR to the Executive Director by the tenth day of the month.

#### II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 1, the Respondent is subject to the jurisdiction of the TCEQ pursuant to Tex. Health & Safety Code ch. 341 and the rules of the TCEQ.
- 2. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 2.a, the Respondent failed to submit a DLQOR to the Executive Director by the tenth day of the month following the end of each quarter, in violation of 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 290.110(e)(4)(A) and (f)(3).
- 3. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 2.b, the Respondent failed to mail or directly deliver one copy of the CCR to each bill paying customer by July 1 for each year, and failed to submit to the TCEQ by July 1 each year a copy of the annual CCR and certification that the CCR has been distributed to the customers of the Facility and that the information in the CCR is correct and consistent with compliance monitoring data, in violation of 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 290.271(b) and 290.274(a) and (c).
- 4. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 2.c, the Respondent failed to submit a recommendation to the Executive Director for source water treatment within 180 days after the end of the monitoring period during which the lead action level was exceeded, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 290.117(g)(2)(A).
- 5. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 2.d, the Respondent failed to submit a recommendation to the Executive Director for optimal corrosion control treatment within six months after the end of the monitoring period during which the lead action level was exceeded, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 290.117(f)(3)(A).

- 6. As evidenced by Finding of Fact No. 2.e, the Respondent failed to provide public notification, accompanied with a signed Certificate of Delivery, to the Executive Director regarding the failure to submit a DLQOR to the Executive Director by the tenth day of the month following the end of each quarter, in violation of 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 290.122(c)(2)(A) and (f).
- 7. Pursuant to Tex. Health & Safety Code § 341.049(a), the TCEQ has the authority to assess an administrative penalty against the Respondent for violations of state statutes within the TCEQ's jurisdiction, for violations of rules adopted under such statutes, or for violations of orders or permits issued under such statutes.
- 8. An administrative penalty in the amount of \$5,050 is justified by the facts recited in this Order, and considered in light of the factors set forth in Tex. Health & Safety Code § 341.049(b). The Respondent paid the \$5,050 penalty.

#### III. ORDERING PROVISIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ORDERS that:

1. The Respondent is assessed a penalty as set forth in Conclusion of Law No. 8 for violations of state statutes and rules of the TCEQ. The payment of this penalty and the Respondent's compliance with all the requirements set forth in this Order resolve only the matters set forth by this Order in this action. The Commission shall not be constrained in any manner from requiring corrective actions or penalties for violations that are not raised here. Penalty payments shall be made payable to "TCEQ" and shall be sent with the notation "Re: City of Edmonson, Docket No. 2023-1312-PWS-E" to:

- 2. The Respondent shall undertake the following technical requirements:
  - a. Within 30 days after the effective date of this Order:
    - i. Mail or directly deliver one copy of the CCR prepared using the compliance data for the most recent calendar year to each bill paying customer and make a good faith effort to deliver the CCR to non-bill paying customers, in accordance with 30 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 290.271 and 290.274; and
    - ii. Provide public notification and submit a copy of each public notification, accompanied with a signed Certificate of Delivery, to the Executive Director regarding the failure to submit a DLQOR to the Executive Director by the tenth day of the month following the end of each quarter for the first quarter of 2022, in accordance with 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 290.122.

- b. Within 45 days after the effective date of this Order:
  - i. Submit to the Commission a copy of the CCR provided to customers of the Facility and the certification that the CCR has been provided to the customers of the Facility and that the information in the CCR is correct and consistent with the compliance monitoring data, in accordance with 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 290.274. The copy of the CCR and certification shall be mailed to:

- ii. Submit written certification as described in Ordering Provision No. 2.e below, and include detailed supporting documentation including photographs, receipts, and/or other records to demonstrate compliance with Ordering Provision Nos. 2.a.i and 2.a.ii.
- c. Within 60 days after the effective date of this Order, submit written certification as described in Ordering Provision No. 2.e below, and include detailed supporting documentation including photographs, receipts, and/or other records to demonstrate compliance with Ordering Provision No. 2.b.i.
- d. Within 180 days after the effective date of this Order:
  - i. Submit to the Executive Director a source water lead and copper treatment recommendation, in accordance with 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 290.117; and
  - ii. Submit to the Executive Director an optimal corrosion control treatment recommendation, in accordance with 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 290.117.
    - Respond completely and adequately, as determined by the TCEQ, to all requests for information concerning the treatment recommendations within 15 days after the date of such requests, or by any other deadline specified in writing.
- e. Within 195 days after the effective date of this Order, submit written certification, and include detailed supporting documentation including photographs, receipts, and/or other records to demonstrate compliance with Ordering Provision Nos. 2.d.i and 2.d.ii. The certification shall be signed by the Respondent and shall include the following certification language:

"I certify under penalty of law that I have personally examined and am familiar with the information submitted and all attached documents, and that based on my inquiry of those individuals

immediately responsible for obtaining the information, I believe that the submitted information is true, accurate and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fines and imprisonment for knowing violations."

- 3. All relief not expressly granted in this Order is denied.
- 4. The duties and provisions imposed by this Order shall apply to and be binding upon the Respondent. The Respondent is ordered to give notice of this Order to personnel who maintain day-to-day control over the Facility operations referenced in this Order.
- 5. The Executive Director may grant an extension of any deadline in this Order or in any plan, report, or other document submitted pursuant to this Order, upon a written and substantiated showing of good cause. All requests for extensions by the Respondent shall be made in writing to the Executive Director. Extensions are not effective until the Respondent receives written approval from the Executive Director. The determination of what constitutes good cause rests solely with the Executive Director. Extension requests shall be sent to the Enforcement Division at the address listed above.
- 6. The Executive Director may, without further notice or hearing, refer this matter to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas ("OAG") for further enforcement proceedings if the Executive Director determines that the Respondent has not complied with one or more of the terms in this Order.
- 7. This Order shall terminate five years from its effective date or upon compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, whichever is later.
- 8. This Order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against the Respondent in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the OAG to: (1) enforce the terms of this Order; or (2) pursue violations of a statute within the Commission's jurisdiction, or of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued by the Commission under such a statute.

- 9. This Order may be executed in separate and multiple counterparts, which together shall constitute a single instrument. Any page of this Order may be copied, scanned, digitized, converted to electronic portable document format ("pdf"), or otherwise reproduced and may be transmitted by digital or electronic transmission, including but not limited to facsimile transmission and electronic mail. Any signature affixed to this Order shall constitute an original signature for all purposes and may be used, filed, substituted, or issued for any purpose for which an original signature could be used. The term "signature" shall include manual signatures and true and accurate reproductions of manual signatures created, executed, endorsed, adopted, or authorized by the person or persons to whom the signatures are attributable. Signatures may be copied or reproduced digitally, electronically, by photocopying, engraving, imprinting, lithographing, electronic mail, facsimile transmission, stamping, or any other means or process which the Executive Director deems acceptable. In this paragraph exclusively, the terms: electronic transmission, owner, person, writing, and written, shall have the meanings assigned to them under Tex. Bus. Org. Code § 1.002.
- 10. The effective date of this Order is the date it is signed by the Commission. A copy of this fully executed Order shall be provided to each of the parties.
