Violation Information

- 1. Failed to provide secondary containment in order to prevent the release of hazardous waste or hazardous constituents to the environment. Specifically, approximately 24,000 gallons of hazardous waste was being stored in an above ground storage tank ("AST") without secondary containment [30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 335.112(a)(9) and 40 CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS ("C.F.R.") § 265.193(a)].
- 2. Failed to label all tanks that accumulate hazardous waste with the words "Hazardous Waste". Specifically, an approximately 24,000-gallon AST was storing hazardous waste and was not labeled with the words "Hazardous Waste" [30 Tex. Admin. Code § 335.53(f) and 40 C.F.R. § 262.17(a)(5)(ii)(A)].
- 3. Failed to submit a copy of the contingency plan and all revisions to all local emergency responders [30 Tex. Admin. Code § 335.61 and 40 C.F.R. § 262.262(a)].
- 4. Failed to complete closure and remediation obligations of an industrial hazardous waste facility. Specifically, the Respondent had not satisfied the closure and remediation obligations associated with converting the function of an unregistered approximately 24,000-gallon AST from storing hazardous waste to storing non-hazardous waste [30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 335.8(b)].
- 5. Failed to submit written notification to the Executive Director ("ED") at least 90 days prior to engaging in on-site treatment of medical waste. Specifically, the Respondent had not notified the ED prior to using two autoclave units for the treatment of the medical waste generated at the on-site nursing unit by the August 20, 2022 notification due date [30 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 326.37(a) and 326.39(a)].
- 6. Failed to conduct hazardous waste determinations and waste classifications. Specifically, inaccurate waste classification documentation was provided for the following waste streams: water contaminated with Bis (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate; demolished process equipment including old poly tanks, piping, and connectors; and Resource Conservation and Recovery Act empty polyethylene drums [30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 335.503(a) and 335.504 and 40 C.F.R. § 262.11].
- 7. Failed to label all hazardous waste containers in Satellite Accumulation Areas ("SAAs") with the words "Hazardous Waste". Specifically, one 5-gallon drum in a laboratory SAA was observed without a hazardous waste label [30 Tex. Admin. Code § 335.53(d) and 40 C.F.R. § 262.15(a)(5)].

- a. In lieu of labeling an approximately 24,000-gallon AST with the words "Hazardous Waste", the Respondent removed the hazardous waste from the AST on February 27, 2023;
- b. In lieu of providing secondary containment for the AST, the Respondent removed the hazardous waste from the AST on February 27, 2023;
- c. Submitted a copy of the Facility's contingency plan to all local emergency responders on December 1, 2022;
- d. Submitted written notification to the ED for on-site treatment of medical waste on December 12, 2022;
- e. Submitted complete and accurate waste determination and waste classification documentation for the three waste streams on November 18, 2022; and
- f. Properly labeled the 5-gallon drum in the laboratory SAA on November 18, 2022.

Technical Requirements:

The Order will require the Respondent to:

- a. Within 120 days, properly complete all closure and remediation obligations regarding the unregistered 24,000-gallon AST previously storing hazardous waste;
- b. Within 180 days, prepare and submit a closure report demonstrating proper closure of the unregistered 24,000-gallon AST previously storing hazardous waste; and
- c. Within 195 days, submit written certification to demonstrate compliance with a. and b.

AGREED ORDER DOCKET NO. 2023-1500-MLM-E

I. JURISDICTION AND STIPULATIONS

On	, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("the
Commission" or "TCEQ") con	sidered this agreement of the parties, resolving an enforcement
action regarding ICU MEDICA	AL, INC. (the "Respondent") under the authority of TEX. HEALTH &
SAFETY CODE ch. 361 and TEX.	WATER CODE ch. 7. The Executive Director of the TCEQ, through
the Enforcement Division, an	nd the Respondent together stipulate that:

- 1. The Respondent owns and operates a medical supply manufacturing facility located at 3900 Howard Lane in Austin, Travis County, Texas (the "Facility"). The Facility involves or involved the management of industrial and hazardous waste ("IHW") and municipal solid waste ("MSW") as defined in Tex. Health & Safety Code ch. 361.
- 2. The Executive Director and the Respondent agree that the TCEQ has jurisdiction to enter this Order pursuant to Tex. Water Code §§ 7.002, 7.051, and 7.073, and that the Respondent is subject to TCEQ's jurisdiction. The TCEQ has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Tex. Water Code § 5.013 because it alleges violations of Tex. Health & Safety Code ch. 361 and the rules of the TCEQ.
- 3. The occurrence of any violation is in dispute and the entry of this Order shall not constitute an admission by the Respondent of any violation alleged in Section II ("Allegations"), nor of any statute or rule.
- 4. An administrative penalty in the amount of \$53,413 is assessed by the Commission in settlement of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations"). The Respondent paid \$42,731 of the penalty and \$10,682 is deferred contingent upon the Respondent's timely and satisfactory compliance with all the terms of this Order. The deferred amount shall be waived only upon full compliance with all the terms and conditions contained in this Order. If the Respondent fails to timely and satisfactorily comply with any of the terms or requirements contained in this Order, the Executive Director may demand payment of all or part of the deferred penalty amount.
- 5. The Executive Director and the Respondent agree on a settlement of the matters alleged in this enforcement action, subject to final approval in accordance with 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 70.10(a). Any notice and procedures, which might otherwise be authorized or required in this action, are waived in the interest of a more timely resolution of the matter.

- 6. The Executive Director may, without further notice or hearing, refer this matter to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas ("OAG") for further enforcement proceedings if the Executive Director determines that the Respondent has not complied with one or more of the terms or conditions in this Order.
- 7. This Order represents the complete and fully integrated agreement of the parties. The provisions of this Order are deemed severable and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable.
- 8. This Order shall terminate five years from its effective date or upon compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, whichever is later.
- 9. The Executive Director recognizes that the Respondent implemented the following corrective measures at the Facility:
 - a. In lieu of labeling an approximately 24,000-gallon above ground storage tank ("AST") with the words "Hazardous Waste", the Respondent removed the hazardous waste from the AST on February 27, 2023;
 - b. In lieu of providing secondary containment for the AST, the Respondent removed the hazardous waste from the AST on February 27, 2023;
 - c. Submitted a copy of the Facility's contingency plan to all local emergency responders on December 1, 2022;
 - d. Submitted written notification to the Executive Director for on-site treatment of medical waste on December 12, 2022;
 - e. Submitted complete and accurate waste determination and waste classification documentation for the three waste streams on November 18, 2022; and
 - f. Properly labeled the 5-gallon drum in the laboratory Satellite Accumulation Area ("SAA") on November 18, 2022.

II. ALLEGATIONS

During an investigation at the Facility conducted on November 18, 2022, an investigator documented that the Respondent:

- 1. Failed to provide secondary containment in order to prevent the release of hazardous waste or hazardous constituents to the environment, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 335.112(a)(9) and 40 Code of Federal Regulations ("C.F.R.") § 265.193(a). Specifically, approximately 24,000 gallons of hazardous waste was being stored in an AST without secondary containment.
- 2. Failed to label all tanks that accumulate hazardous waste with the words "Hazardous Waste", in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 335.53(f) and 40 C.F.R. § 262.17(a)(5)(ii)(A). Specifically, an approximately 24,000-gallon AST was storing hazardous waste and was not labeled with the words "Hazardous Waste."

- 3. Failed to submit a copy of the contingency plan and all revisions to all local emergency responders, in violation of 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 335.61 and 40 C.F.R. § 262.262(a).
- 4. Failed to complete closure and remediation obligations of an IHW facility, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 335.8(b). Specifically, the Respondent had not satisfied the closure and remediation obligations associated with converting the function of an unregistered approximately 24,000-gallon AST from storing hazardous waste to storing non-hazardous waste.
- 5. Failed to submit written notification to the Executive Director at least 90 days prior to engaging in on-site treatment of medical waste, in violation of 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 326.37(a) and 326.39(a). Specifically, the Respondent had not notified the Executive Director prior to using two autoclave units for the treatment of the medical waste generated at the on-site nursing unit by the August 20, 2022 notification due date.
- 6. Failed to conduct hazardous waste determinations and waste classifications, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 335.503(a) and 335.504 and 40 C.F.R. § 262.11. Specifically, inaccurate waste classification documentation was provided for the following waste streams: water contaminated with Bis (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate ("DOP"); demolished process equipment including old poly tanks, piping, and connectors; and Resource Conservation and Recovery Act empty polyethylene drums.
- 7. Failed to label all hazardous waste containers in SAAs with the words "Hazardous Waste", in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 335.53(d) and 40 C.F.R. § 262.15(a)(5). Specifically, one 5-gallon drum in a laboratory SAA was observed without a hazardous waste label.

III. DENIALS

The Respondent generally denies each allegation in Section II ("Allegations").

IV. ORDERING PROVISIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ORDERS that:

1. The Respondent is assessed a penalty as set forth in Section I, Paragraph No. 4. The payment of this penalty and the Respondent's compliance with all of the requirements set forth in this Order resolve only the allegations in Section II. The Commission shall not be constrained in any manner from requiring corrective action or penalties for violations which are not raised here. Penalty payments shall be made payable to "TCEQ" and shall be sent with the notation "Re: ICU MEDICAL, INC., Docket No. 2023-1500-MLM-E" to:

2. The Respondent shall undertake the following technical requirements:

- a. Within 120 days after the effective date of this Order, properly complete all closure and remediation obligations regarding the unregistered 24,000-gallon AST previously storing hazardous waste, in accordance with 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 335.8.
- b. Within 180 days after the effective date of this Order, prepare and submit a closure report demonstrating proper closure of the unregistered 24,000-gallon AST previously storing hazardous waste, in accordance with 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 335.8 to:

c. Within 195 days after the effective date of this Order, submit written certification, and include detailed supporting documentation including photographs, receipts, and/or other records to demonstrate compliance with Ordering Provision Nos. 2.a and 2.b. The certification shall be signed by the Respondent and shall include the following certification language:

"I certify under penalty of law that I have personally examined and am familiar with the information submitted and all attached documents, and that based on my inquiry of those individuals immediately responsible for obtaining the information, I believe that the submitted information is true, accurate and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fines and imprisonment for knowing violations."

- 3. All relief not expressly granted in this Order is denied.
- 4. The duties and provisions imposed by this Order shall apply to and be binding upon the Respondent. The Respondent is ordered to give notice of this Order to personnel who maintain day-to-day control over the Facility operations referenced in this Order.

- 5. The Executive Director may grant an extension of any deadline in this Order or in any plan, report, or other document submitted pursuant to this Order, upon a written and substantiated showing of good cause. All requests for extensions by the Respondent shall be made in writing to the Executive Director. Extensions are not effective until the Respondent receives written approval from the Executive Director. The determination of what constitutes good cause rests solely with the Executive Director. Extension requests shall be sent to the Enforcement Division at the address listed above.
- 6. This Order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against the Respondent in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the OAG to: (1) enforce the terms of this Order; or (2) pursue violations of a statute within the Commission's jurisdiction, or of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued by the Commission under such a statute.
- 7. This Order may be executed in separate and multiple counterparts, which together shall constitute a single instrument. Any page of this Order may be copied, scanned, digitized, converted to electronic portable document format ("pdf"), or otherwise reproduced and may be transmitted by digital or electronic transmission, including but not limited to facsimile transmission and electronic mail. Any signature affixed to this Order shall constitute an original signature for all purposes and may be used, filed, substituted, or issued for any purpose for which an original signature could be used. The term "signature" shall include manual signatures and true and accurate reproductions of manual signatures created, executed, endorsed, adopted, or authorized by the person or persons to whom the signatures are attributable. Signatures may be copied or reproduced digitally, electronically, by photocopying, engraving, imprinting, lithographing, electronic mail, facsimile transmission, stamping, or any other means or process which the Executive Director deems acceptable. In this paragraph exclusively, the terms: electronic transmission, owner, person, writing, and written, shall have the meanings assigned to them under Tex. Bus. Org. Code § 1.002.
- 8. The effective date of this Order is the date it is signed by the Commission. A copy of this fully executed Order shall be provided to each of the parties.
