I. JURISDICTION AND STIPULATIONS

On	, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("the
Commission" or "TCEQ") con	sidered this agreement of the parties, resolving an enforcement
action regarding 717 Constr	uction Services, LLC (the "Respondent") under the authority of Tex.
WATER CODE chs. 7 and 26. T	he Executive Director of the TCEQ, through the Enforcement
Division, and the Responden	t together stipulate that:

- 1. The Respondent owns and operates a concrete batch plant located at 8625 Oberrender Road in Needville, Fort Bend County, Texas (the "Plant"). The Plant is near or adjacent to water in the state as defined in Tex. Water Code § 26.001(5).
- 2. The Executive Director and the Respondent agree that the TCEQ has jurisdiction to enter this Order pursuant to Tex. Water Code §§ 7.002, 7.051, and 7.073, and that the Respondent is subject to TCEQ's jurisdiction. The TCEQ has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Tex. Water Code § 5.013 because it alleges violations of Tex. Water Code ch. 26 and the rules of the TCEO.
- 3. The occurrence of any violation is in dispute and the entry of this Order shall not constitute an admission by the Respondent of any violation alleged in Section II ("Allegations"), nor of any statute or rule.
- 4. An administrative penalty in the amount of \$9,465 is assessed by the Commission in settlement of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations"). The Respondent paid \$7,572 of the penalty and \$1,893 is deferred contingent upon the Respondent's timely and satisfactory compliance with all the terms of this Order. The deferred amount shall be waived only upon full compliance with all the terms and conditions contained in this Order. If the Respondent fails to timely and satisfactorily comply with any of the terms or requirements contained in this Order, the Executive Director may demand payment of all or part of the deferred penalty amount.
- 5. The Executive Director and the Respondent agree on a settlement of the matters alleged in this enforcement action, subject to final approval in accordance with 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 70.10(a). Any notice and procedures, which might otherwise be authorized or required in this action, are waived in the interest of a more timely resolution of the matter.

- 6. The Executive Director may, without further notice or hearing, refer this matter to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas ("OAG") for further enforcement proceedings if the Executive Director determines that the Respondent has not complied with one or more of the terms or conditions in this Order.
- 7. This Order represents the complete and fully integrated agreement of the parties. The provisions of this Order are deemed severable and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable.
- 8. This Order shall terminate five years from its effective date or upon compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, whichever is later.

II. ALLEGATIONS

During a record review for the Plant conducted on October 12, 2023, an investigator documented that the Respondent:

- 1. Failed to submit monitoring results at the intervals specified in the permit, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 305.125(1) and (17) and 319.5(b) and Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("TPDES") General Permit No. TXG113042, Part III, Section A, Permit Requirements No. 1; and Part IV, Standard Permit Conditions No. 7.f. Specifically, the monthly conventional pollutants discharge monitoring reports ("DMRs") were not submitted for the monthly monitoring periods of December 2022, June and July 2023 by the 20th day of the following month.
- 2. Failed to collect and analyze effluent samples at the intervals specified in the permit, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 305.125(1) and 319.5(b) and TPDES General Permit No. TXG113042, Part III, Section A, Permit Requirements No. 1. Specifically, the Respondent did not collect and analyze flow, pH, oil and grease, and total suspended solid samples for the monthly monitoring period ending May 31, 2023.

III. DENIALS

The Respondent generally denies each allegation in Section II ("Allegations").

IV. ORDERING PROVISIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ORDERS that:

1. The Respondent is assessed a penalty as set forth in Section I, Paragraph No. 4. The payment of this penalty and the Respondent's compliance with all of the requirements set forth in this Order resolve only the allegations in Section II. The Commission shall not be constrained in any manner from requiring corrective action or penalties for violations which are not raised here. Penalty payments shall be made payable to "TCEQ" and shall be sent with the notation "Re: 717 Construction Services, LLC; Docket No. 2024-0350-WO-E" to:

- 2. The Respondent shall undertake the following technical requirements:
 - a. Within 30 days after the effective date of this Order,
 - i. Update the Facility's operational guidance and conduct employee training to ensure that:
 - (1) Self-reporting requirements are properly accomplished, including the timely submittal of signed and certified monthly and annual DMRs, in accordance with TPDES General Permit No. TXG113042, Part III, Section A, Permit Requirements No. 1; and Part IV, Standard Permit Conditions No. 7.f; and
 - (2) Samples are collected and analyzed, in accordance with TPDES General Permit No. TXG113042, Part III, Section A, Permit Requirements No. 1.
 - ii. Submit the required monthly DMRs for the monitoring periods of December 2022, June 2023, and July 2023 electronically, in accordance with TPDES General Permit No. TXG113042, Part III, Section A, Permit Requirements No. 1; and Part IV, Standard Permit Conditions No. 7.f.
 - b. Within 45 days after the effective date of this Order, submit written certification, and include detailed supporting documentation including photographs, receipts, and/or other records to demonstrate compliance with Ordering Provision Nos. 2.a.i and 2.a.ii. The certification shall be signed by the Respondent and shall include the following certification language:

"I certify under penalty of law that I have personally examined and am familiar with the information submitted and all attached documents, and that based on my inquiry of those individuals immediately responsible for obtaining the information, I believe that the submitted information is true, accurate and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fines and imprisonment for knowing violations."

- 3. All relief not expressly granted in this Order is denied.
- 4. The duties and provisions imposed by this Order shall apply to and be binding upon the Respondent. The Respondent is ordered to give notice of this Order to personnel who maintain day-to-day control over the Plant operations referenced in this Order.
- 5. The Executive Director may grant an extension of any deadline in this Order or in any plan, report, or other document submitted pursuant to this Order, upon a written and substantiated showing of good cause. All requests for extensions by the Respondent shall be made in writing to the Executive Director. Extensions are not effective until the Respondent receives written approval from the Executive Director. The determination of what constitutes good cause rests solely with the Executive Director. Extension requests shall be sent to the Enforcement Division at the address listed above.
- 6. This Order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against the Respondent in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the OAG to: (1) enforce the terms of this Order; or (2) pursue violations of a statute within the Commission's jurisdiction, or of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued by the Commission under such a statute.
- 7. This Order may be executed in separate and multiple counterparts, which together shall constitute a single instrument. Any page of this Order may be copied, scanned, digitized, converted to electronic portable document format ("pdf"), or otherwise reproduced and may be transmitted by digital or electronic transmission, including but not limited to facsimile transmission and electronic mail. Any signature affixed to this Order shall constitute an original signature for all purposes and may be used, filed, substituted, or issued for any purpose for which an original signature could be used. The term "signature" shall include manual signatures and true and accurate reproductions of manual signatures created, executed, endorsed, adopted, or authorized by the person or persons to whom the signatures are attributable. Signatures may be copied or reproduced digitally, electronically, by photocopying, engraving, imprinting, lithographing, electronic mail, facsimile transmission, stamping, or any other means or process which the Executive Director deems acceptable. In this paragraph exclusively, the terms: electronic transmission, owner, person, writing, and written, shall have the meanings assigned to them under Tex. Bus. Org. Code § 1.002.
- 8. The effective date of this Order is the date it is signed by the Commission. A copy of this fully executed Order shall be provided to each of the parties.
