Violation Information

- 1. Failed to obtain authorization to discharge stormwater associated with construction activities. Specifically, the Respondent was performing construction activities prior to obtaining authorization under Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("TPDES") Construction General Permit No. TXR150000 [30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 281.25(a)(4) and 40 CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS § 122.26(c)].
- 2. Failed to prevent an unauthorized discharge of concrete production wastewater into or adjacent to any water in the state. Specifically, the Respondent discharged concrete truck wash out water onto the ground at the Site, in a location less than 10 feet from a culvert and less than 0.25 miles from an unnamed tributary of the Brazos River below Possum Kingdon Lake [Tex. I. JURISDICTION AND STIPULATIONS

On	, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("the
Commission" or "TC	EQ") considered this agreement of the parties, resolving an enforcement
action regarding KW	Homes, LLC (the "Respondent") under the authority of Tex. WATER CODE
chs. 7 and 26. The E	xecutive Director of the TCEQ, through the Enforcement Division, and the
Respondent together	stipulate that:

- 1. The Respondent operates a large construction site located at 1016 Bermes Court in Weatherford, Parker County, Texas (the "Site"). The Site is near or adjacent to water in the state as defined in Tex. Water Code § 26.001(5).
- 2. The Executive Director and the Respondent agree that the TCEQ has jurisdiction to enter this Order pursuant to Tex. Water Code §§ 7.002, 7.051, and 7.073, and that the Respondent is subject to TCEQ's jurisdiction. The TCEQ has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Tex. Water Code § 5.013 because it alleges violations of Tex. Water Code ch. 26 and the rules of the TCEO.
- 3. The occurrence of any violation is in dispute and the entry of this Order shall not constitute an admission by the Respondent of any violation alleged in Section II ("Allegations"), nor of any statute or rule.
- 4. An administrative penalty in the amount of \$8,625 is assessed by the Commission in settlement of the violations alleged in Section II ("Allegations"). The Respondent paid \$6,900 of the penalty and \$1,725 is deferred contingent upon the Respondent's timely and satisfactory compliance with all the terms of this Order. The deferred amount shall be waived only upon full compliance with all the terms and conditions contained in this Order. If the Respondent fails to timely and satisfactorily comply with any of the terms or requirements contained in this Order, the Executive Director may demand payment of all or part of the deferred penalty amount.
- 5. The Executive Director and the Respondent agree on a settlement of the matters alleged in this enforcement action, subject to final approval in accordance with 30 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 70.10(a). Any notice and procedures, which might otherwise be authorized or required in this action, are waived in the interest of a more timely resolution of the matter.

- 6. The Executive Director may, without further notice or hearing, refer this matter to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas ("OAG") for further enforcement proceedings if the Executive Director determines that the Respondent has not complied with one or more of the terms or conditions in this Order.
- 7. This Order represents the complete and fully integrated agreement of the parties. The provisions of this Order are deemed severable and, if a court of competent jurisdiction or other appropriate authority deems any provision of this Order unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and enforceable.
- 8. This Order shall terminate five years from its effective date or upon compliance with all the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, whichever is later.
- 9. The Executive Director recognizes that the Respondent implemented the following corrective measures at the Site:
 - a. By December 19, 2023, implemented a stormwater pollution prevention plan, submitted a Notice of Intent ("NOI") to obtain authorization to discharge stormwater associated with construction activities under Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("TPDES") Construction General Permit ("CGP") No. TXR1571PI, posted a Site notice, and submitted a copy of the NOI to the receiving municipal separate storm sewer system to the Dallas-Fort Worth Regional Office; and
 - b. By January 8, 2024, removed the concrete truck wash out water and installed structural controls for the disposal of concrete truck wash out water.

II. ALLEGATIONS

During an investigation at the Site conducted on December 4, 2023, an investigator documented that the Respondent:

- 1. Failed to obtain authorization to discharge stormwater associated with construction activities, in violation of 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 281.25(a)(4) and 40 Code of Federal Regulations § 122.26(c). Specifically, the Respondent was performing construction activities prior to obtaining authorization under TPDES CGP No. TXR150000.
- 2. Failed to prevent an unauthorized discharge of concrete production wastewater into or adjacent to any water in the state, in violation of Tex. Water Code § 26.121(a)(1). Specifically, the Respondent discharged concrete truck wash out water onto the ground at the Site, in a location less than 10 feet from a culvert and less than 0.25 miles from an unnamed tributary of the Brazos River below Possum Kingdon Lake.

III. DENIALS

The Respondent generally denies each allegation in Section II ("Allegations").

IV. ORDERING PROVISIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ORDERS that:

1. The Respondent is assessed a penalty as set forth in Section I, Paragraph No. 4. The payment of this penalty and the Respondent's compliance with all of the requirements set forth in this Order resolve only the allegations in Section II. The Commission shall not be constrained in any manner from requiring corrective action or penalties for violations which are not raised here. Penalty payments shall be made payable to "TCEQ" and shall be sent with the notation "Re: KW Homes, LLC, Docket No. 2024-0360-WQ-E" to:

- 2. All relief not expressly granted in this Order is denied.
- 3. The duties and provisions imposed by this Order shall apply to and be binding upon the Respondent. The Respondent is ordered to give notice of this Order to personnel who maintain day-to-day control over the Site operations referenced in this Order.
- 4. The Executive Director may grant an extension of any deadline in this Order or in any plan, report, or other document submitted pursuant to this Order, upon a written and substantiated showing of good cause. All requests for extensions by the Respondent shall be made in writing to the Executive Director. Extensions are not effective until the Respondent receives written approval from the Executive Director. The determination of what constitutes good cause rests solely with the Executive Director.
- 5. This Order, issued by the Commission, shall not be admissible against the Respondent in a civil proceeding, unless the proceeding is brought by the OAG to: (1) enforce the terms of this Order; or (2) pursue violations of a statute within the Commission's jurisdiction, or of a rule adopted or an order or permit issued by the Commission under such a statute.
- 6. This Order may be executed in separate and multiple counterparts, which together shall constitute a single instrument. Any page of this Order may be copied, scanned, digitized, converted to electronic portable document format ("pdf"), or otherwise reproduced and may be transmitted by digital or electronic transmission, including but not limited to facsimile transmission and electronic mail. Any signature affixed to this Order shall constitute an original signature for all purposes and may be used, filed, substituted, or issued for any purpose for which an original signature could be used. The term "signature" shall include manual signatures and true and accurate reproductions of manual signatures created, executed, endorsed, adopted, or authorized by the person or persons to whom the signatures are attributable. Signatures may be copied or reproduced digitally, electronically, by photocopying, engraving, imprinting, lithographing, electronic mail, facsimile transmission, stamping, or any other means or process which the Executive Director deems acceptable. In this paragraph exclusively, the terms: electronic transmission, owner, person, writing, and written, shall have the meanings assigned to them under Tex. Bus. Org. Code § 1.002.
