**COMMENTS:** On Feb. 24th 2022 a call for a Hazmat incident went into Corpus Christi dispatch with the address for this facility but being identified as Texas Oncology? This was followed by a call from Mutual Aid and more assets again to Texas Oncology the on scene unit had to correct dispatch. There was no reverse alert to the community. Nobody was notified in the area that I know of. When I went over to see what was going on I saw hazardous material on the ground and when I took pictures from the public Road the workers at USC ecology moved to block my view I have pictures of

what I think is firefighting runoff going off of their property that I I can't attach. Like so many things with the TCEQ this process is completely inadequate. I would go to the public meeting today but I'm bleeding internally and then I'm waiting to hear whether or not I'm going to need a transfusion so this will have to do and suffice my testimony not that you won't rubber stamp everything that goes across your desk. This facility has been expanded and expanded over the years there is no way that it keeps 100% of the material that it brings in on its property within its fence line and if you were doing your jobs you would see that but you drive past unpermitted waste facilities right here in Corpus on Lipan across from Miller Hs and drive by everyday and ignore them. So I don't expect that you'll do anything to protect our community from this facility that is a Dumping Ground for the entire northern hemisphere. Everything going on at this facility should be audited at this point the last time I went to the library in Nueces Library I counted 22 volumes of expansions to this facilities permit there's no limit to what they were asked for and they're I see no limit to what you will grant them and that is not protecting my community.
