Dear Parties:

Protestants City of Ennis, City of Waxahachie, and Ellis County filed exceptions to the Proposal for Decision (PFD) in this matter. The Executive Director (ED) of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality responded to those exceptions and filed her own exceptions.

Protestants' exceptions address the Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ) weighing of the evidence. Protestants' exceptions also express a concern that Applicant will obtain the privilege of a permit despite only minimally participating in the hearing process. The ALJ does not recommend making any changes based on these exceptions.

The ALJ recommends granting the ED's exceptions, which added a missing "0" to the permit number set out in the caption and in the PFD's introductory paragraph. Thus, the caption and introductory paragraph should note that the TPDES Permit Number is WQ0016388001. Similarly, Ordering Provision No. 1 should list permit number WQ0016388001.

With these changes, the PFD is ready for review.
