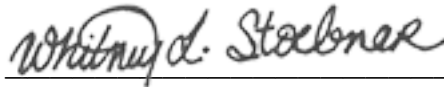
ORDER NO. 6
REOPENING THE RECORD AND ALLOWING RESPONSES TO
EXCEPTIONS

On August 26, 2025, the undersigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued a Proposal for Decision (PFD) in this matter. The exceptions period in this matter expired on September 15, 2025. Due to a technical issue with eFile Texas, the ALJ was unaware that Protestants had timely filed exceptions on September 15, 2025. Accordingly, the ALJ issued an exceptions letter on September 16, 2025, returning the case to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). After the exceptions letter issued, the ALJ became aware that Protestants had timely filed exceptions.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the record in this matter is reopened to allow the ALJ to review Protestants' exceptions and to allow the parties in this matter to respond to the exceptions in accordance with the deadlines provided in 30 Texas Administrative Code section 80.257(a). The matter is not to be returned to the Commission at this time. Upon review of Protestants' exceptions and any timely responses, the ALJ will issue an exceptions letter in this matter.
