Dear Parties:

On May 7, 2025, the undersigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued an Amended Proposal for Decision (PFD) in this case. Exceptions to the PFD were filed on May 27, 2025, by the Executive Director (ED) of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality. No replies to exceptions were filed.

The ALJ recommends the following correction, as proposed by the ED:

- Finding of Fact No. 4: The ED referred the case to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) on June 4, July 1, 2024.

- Finding of Fact No. 9: On October 24⁵, 2005, Mr. Mewis was convicted of forgery of a financial instrument.
- Finding of Fact No. 13: On November 15¹, 2016, Mr. Mewis was convicted of tampering and fabricating physical evidence.

This clarification does not change the ALJ's analysis, findings, conclusions, or recommendations. The ED's exceptions are adopted.
