**EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR’S EXCEPTION TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE’S
PROPOSALS FOR DECISION**

INTRODUCTION

The Executive Director of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ or Commission) submits her Exception to the Administrative Law Judge’s (ALJ) Proposals for Decision (PFD).¹ The Executive Director supports the findings and conclusions contained in the ALJ’s PFDs and respectfully recommends the Commissioners adopt the Executive Director’s recommended change described below.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR’S EXCEPTION

The ED recommends adding the following Ordering Provision to each Order to be consistent with prior Municipal Utility District creation Orders:

Ordering Provision:

This Order shall in no event be construed as an approval of any proposed agreements or of any particular items in any documents provided in support of the petition for creation, nor as a commitment or requirement of the TCEQ in the future to approve or disapprove any particular items or agreements in future applications submitted by the District for TCEQ consideration.

CONCLUSION

The Executive Director supports the findings and conclusions contained in the ALJ’s PFDs and respectfully recommends the Commission revise the Proposed Orders, as reflected in the above Exception.
