Our house resides 600 feet from the proposed Sewage Plant site. We have lived at this residence for 62 years. We are not against progress, however it should not be in the detriment of those already established on Risinger Road. The current zoning (that was discussed in the open meeting) for Ellis county is one home per acre. The

proposed construction would be 4 homes per acre. This 1 and a 1/2 lane road (Risinger Road) can not support the influx of traffic. Our current school systems can not sustain the influx of students. There is currently no water rights to get water to the proposed area. This area is prone to flooding for my whole 62 years of residency. The service road that I drive on is often flooded and this is the same waterway the sewage treatment plant would put in excess of 250,000 gallons of sewage water into. This Brushy creek, can not sustain the added water especially with excessive rainfall. I am again requesting a contested case hearing so Clear Utilities LLC can answer how they plan on dealing with the above issues.

This study should evaluate a wastewater collection system and lift station that could utilize the existing TRA 5-MILE CREEK WWTP.

I am the closest house and resident to the proposed location of a sewage plant. This plant would have a HUGE detriment to the value of my home. I would no longer be able to enjoy outside and probably NOT inside my home due to the ODOR. I am 250-300 feet from the proposed site. There is no water to build this facility or water to

support the proposed housing addition so therefore no need to build it. If several hundred homes are built our lane and one-half road can not sustain the traffic. The schools and busses cannot support this influx of children. The crime rate would go up as this is proposed section 8 housing. There is no bus system or public transportation for any of the people in the 100 homes. We just had a flooding issue April/May 2024. It took weeks for the water to recede. The frontage road southbound I 45 from Risinger Road to the Sonic/Shell station was impassable for 2-3 weeks. There was standing water for 5-7 days. This same creek (Brushy creek) that flooded is the one the sewage plant would be using. This creek has a history of flooding. I have lived at this residence for 25 years. Why would you allow a sewage treatment plant where people have pre-established homes? COMMENTS: I own about 260 acres which has a significant border on Brushy Creek, across from the proposed wastewater treatment facility, as I understand its location. Brushy Creek is an intermittent stream. When we have rain, it rises quickly and inundates much of the property along it. Often it makes road crossings, such as the frontage roads along I-45 impassable and they have to be cleaned for traffic to proceed. If additional water is put into the creek, these crossings will become impassable almost all, if not all, of the time. My property bordering the creek is a wildlife refuge for a number of animals, including deer, who would be adversely affected. In addition, there are numerous species of amphibians that require the intermittent water in order to survive. Some of these species may be threatened as their

habitat is changed. Constant flow will adversely affect their habitat and these species will die off. A much more complete survey and analysis of the effect of adding this flow of water must be studied before any substantial flow is added to the stream bed. I believe a public hearing should be held to discuss these issues before any approval is considered. The release of this additional water will adversely affect the uses to which my property can be put.

The County of Ellis, Texas (the "County") offers the below comments and formally requests a contested case hearing on the above-referenced application. MoPac Expressway, Suite C400, Austin, Texas 78746. Our daytime phone number is (512) 472-8021 and fax number is (512) 320-5638.

Clear Utilities, LLC ("Clear Utilities" or "Applicant") applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ") for new TPDES Permit No. WQ0016273001 (the "Application"), seeking to authorize the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 250,000 gallons per day. The County timely submitted comments and requested a contested case hearing on July 26, 2023. However, the TCEQ did not address the County's comments in its August 5, 2024 Response to Comments. The County thus re-urges its comments and requests a contested case hearing on the Application.

The County is an affected person within the definition of that term by the Texas Administrative Code and opposes the issuance of the permit for the following reasons.

I. The County is an Affected Person.

The County is an "affected person" entitled to a contested case hearing on the issues raised in this hearing request under 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 55.203 because the County has interests related to legal rights, duties, privileges, powers, or economic interests affected by the application that are not common to the general public. Local governmental entities, such as the County, with authority under state law over issues contemplated by an application, may be considered affected persons under 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 55.203. The County has authority over various functions – including but not limited to transportation, emergency services, and health and safety – that may be affected by the proposed wastewater treatment plants and associated discharge within the County, that the Application fails to properly address. Potential contamination of surface water within the region may impact the County's ability to effectively provide emergency services, may

impact health and safety by lowering water quality, and may negatively impact the County's infrastructure.

Moreover, as a local government, the County has specific statutory authority to inspect the public water in its jurisdiction to assess whether the quality of the water meets water quality standards, and to determine whether wastewater dischargers are discharging in compliance with the requirements of a TCEQ-issued permit. Texas Water Code § 26.171. The County also has authority to enter property to make inspections and investigations of conditions relating to water quality and the right to bring a civil suit against any person that violates or threatens to violate Chapter 26 of the Texas Water Code, or any permit issued thereunder. Texas Water Code §§ 7.351 and 26.173. As an inspector, investigator, and potential enforcer of a TCEQ-issued permit, the County is affected by the issuance of this permit and has a personal interest in ensuring that any permit issued by the TCEQ in this matter meets the state law requirements, is protective of water quality, and is enforceable. This interest in the Applicant's proposed discharge within the County's jurisdiction is therefore unique to Ellis County and is not common to the general public. Thus, the County has authority under state law over the issues contemplated by this application and is therefore an affected person. 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 55.203

For these reasons, the County requests that the Commission find that the County is an affected person and grant its request for a contested case hearing.

II. Comments

A. Issuance of the Permit could negatively affect water quality and impair existing uses within the County.

The Applicant has requested a discharge permit for a 250,000 gallons per day wastewater treatment plant. The proposed discharge point is to a pond, thence to an unnamed tributary, thence to a second order unnamed tributary, thence to Brushy Creek, thence to Red Oak Creek, thence to Upper Trinity River in Segment No. 0805 of the Trinity River Basin. The unclassified receiving water uses are limited aquatic life use for the Pond and unnamed tributary #1 (~0.14 mi. downstream of the pond), and Brushy Creek, minimal aquatic life use for unnamed tributary (second order), and high aquatic life use for Red Oak Creek. The designated uses within Segment No. 0805 for the Upper Trinity River include use as a source of primary contact recreation and high aquatic life use. The County is concerned that the application and the proposed permit do not comply with the state's water quality standards and that the discharge limits are not sufficiently stringent to protect the water quality in the receiving waters. The County is also concerned that the proposed discharge limits do not comply with the antidegradation requirements. The proposed permit does not fully contemplate the potential impacts of the discharge from a development to the receiving waters, including on the use as a primary contact recreation source and as a healthy ecosystem for aquatic life. Further, TCEQ's standard review of water quality impacts to receiving streams rely on standard modeling inputs that often significantly deviate from site-specific condition. This results in inaccurate modeling results that can minimize actual impacts of the proposed discharge to water quality in the receiving waters. Additionally, emerging contaminants that are often present in treated effluent – including pharmaceuticals, hormones, antibiotic, steroids, viruses, health care products, and many more – that are refractory during wastewater treatments,

tend to persist in an aquatic environment and could end up in the water supply of County residents. The proposed discharge may negatively affect the water quality within the County. The County therefore requests that the TCEQ require a full study on the Application's effect on the water quality in the eventual disposal point and discharge route.

B. The Applicant is not an experienced facility and system operator.

The Applicant has not demonstrated any experience or expertise in operating and maintaining wastewater systems and treatment facilities. The TCEQ should not issue a permit to an inexperienced operator without requiring the applicant to demonstrate it has the operational expertise to operate a plant that will discharge effluent.

C. The Application may not meet all of the TCEQ's requirements.

The County is continuing to fully review the Application and whether the Application contains all of the required information. Nevertheless, the County is concerned that the Application does not contain all the required information. Therefore, the County is concerned that the Application was not properly noticed.

For these reasons, the County re-urges its request that the Commission find that the County is an affected person and grant its request for a contested case hearing on the Application in order to address the concerns raised herein.

I request a contested case hearing for TCEQ Control NO. WQ0016273001, Petitioner Clear Utilities,
LLC., for the proposed Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Risinger Ridge.

I am an affected person entitled to a contested case hearing on the issues raised in this hearing request.
My property is located at 465 Goliad Circle, Palmer, TX 75152 (EllisCAD Property ID 156321 and
EllisCAD Property ID 264172). My property adjoins one of the tracts owned by Clear Utilities, LLC/
Risinger Ridge MHC LLC (EllisCAD Property ID 191881) directly to its South.

The creation of this TPDES uniquely and adversely affects me in the following way(s):

My husband, John and I have property on both the South side and North side of Brushy Creek. The
northern edge of our property adjoins the proposed Clear Utilities / Risinger Ridge development along
its Southern edge (see attached "Exhibit A"). A big portion of our property is in a flood plain but is rated
for agricultural use and we grow hay on both sides of Brushy Creek.

There is an abundance of wildlife (deer, wild hogs, bobcats, coyotes, raccoons, armadillos, and
opossums to name just a few) that live in the wooded area between Brushy Creek and the proposed
Risinger Ridge wastewater treatment plant. The wastewater from the treatment plant would have to flow
through this wooded area, altering the ecology and disturbing the habitat of the animals who live there.

The applicant may not be aware, but their property does not extend all the way to Brushy Creek. After
passing through the wildlife habitat, the wastewater would spread out over several acres of our hayfield
before pouring into Brushy Creek. Having wastewater flowing over our land would not only spoil our
hay and cause erosion, it would effectively block access to about 10 acres of our land that lie on the East
side of the proposed wastewater flow.

Directly to the East of the proposed wastewater discharge route is another tract of ours (EllisCAD
Property ID 264172) which Brushy Creek passes through, and a big portion of that tract is a Wetlands
area as designated by the Federal Government (see attached "Exhibit B"). The applicant's tract
(EllisCAD Property ID 191881) also has a Wetlands on its West side. During flood events, wastewater
from the treatment plant could erode and contaminate the fragile ecosystem in the Wetlands.

The land on both sides of Brushy Creek is in a FEMA Zone AE Special Flood Hazard Area (see attached
"Exhibit C"). The creek is currently an intermittently dry creek but during heavy rain storms, the rain
runoff causes the creek level to rise quickly and come out of its banks, flooding all the properties along it. I
have photos of floodwaters covering more than 50% of my property (see attached "Exhibit D"). Having a
wastewater treatment plant adding 250,000 gallons per day will most assuredly cause the creek to overflow
its banks more frequently than it already does.

We have two large ponds on our property on the South side of Brushy Creek. The ponds are stocked with
fish, and various other wildlife such as turtles (softshell turtles, snapping turtles and red ear sliders), snakes
and frogs reside in them. The ponds are regularly visited by migratory birds such as ducks, geese and
cranes. We catch and eat fish from our ponds. We swim in the ponds, and our animals drink from them.
We are concerned about the possibility of wastewater from the treatment plant entering the ponds during
flood events.

Brushy Creek becomes progressively more shallow before it reaches Interstate 45. The creek regularly
floods the service road on both the Northbound and Southbound sides of Interstate 45 whenever there is a
rain of 2-3 inches or more. The creek handles rain runoff not only from Palmer but from as far away as
Red Oak, and the service road must be closed to traffic until TXDOT is able to clean up the tree branches
and mud that cover the road after the creek overflows its banks. Adding 250,000 gallons per day of
wastewater to the creek will cause the service road to flood even more frequently, cutting off access to all
citizens who exit Interstate 45 onto the service road in order to reach their homes.

Besides the concerns about flooding, if the wastewater treatment plant were to be approved, our quiet,
rural way of life will be disturbed. We enjoy the wide open country, clean air, and non-crowded living
conditions outside city limits in Ellis County. We moved here from the city of Dallas almost 40 years ago
to get away from densely-packed housing, noise, crime and odors. The proposed wastewater treatment
plant would be so close to our house, we are sure to smell the sewage. The Risinger Ridge development is
proposed to have 1024 homes, and common sense tells us there will be multiple people living in each
home. There will be potentially thousands of children flooding both Ferris ISD and Palmer ISD, causing
overcrowding that would have to be remedied by building new schools, which means higher taxes for
everyone. Thousands of people crowded into this development will also cause a huge increase in traffic,
and cause a strain on county services such as the Sheriff's Department and area volunteer fire departments.

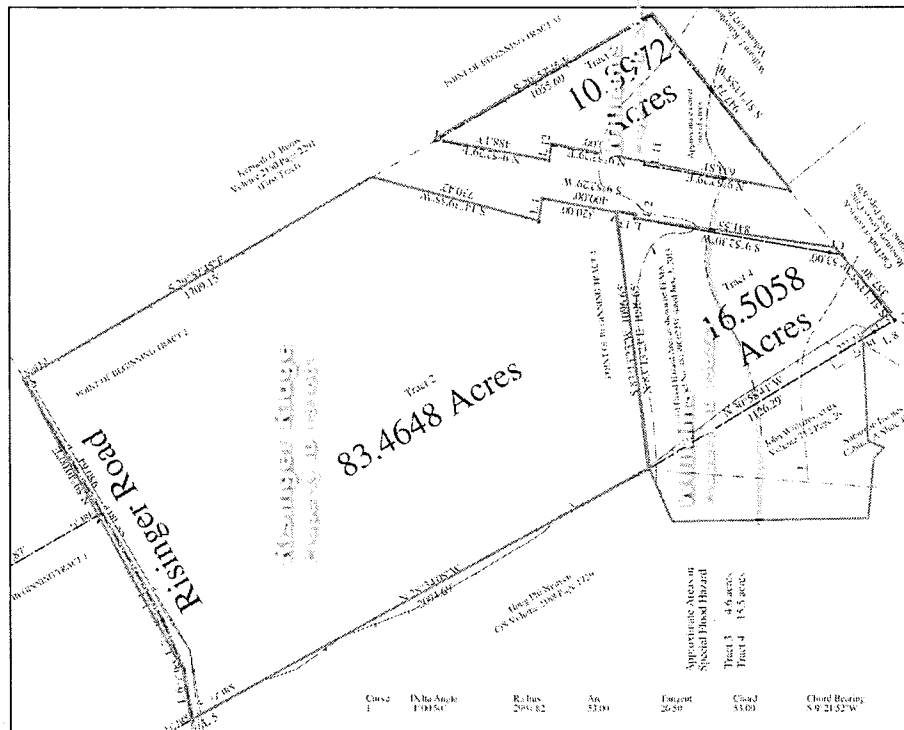


Exhibit B - Wetlands Map

Red lines indicate boundary lines of subject properties. Dotted blue line indicates centerline of Brushy Creek. The dark green areas indicate the locations of the wetlands.

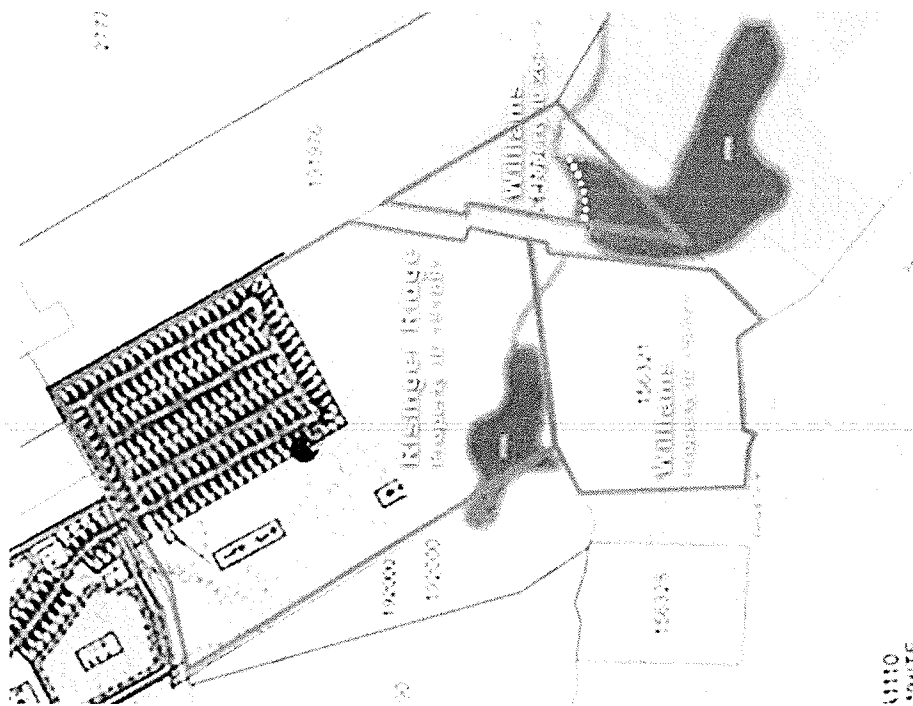


Exhibit C - FEMA Flood Zone AE Special Flood Hazard Area Map

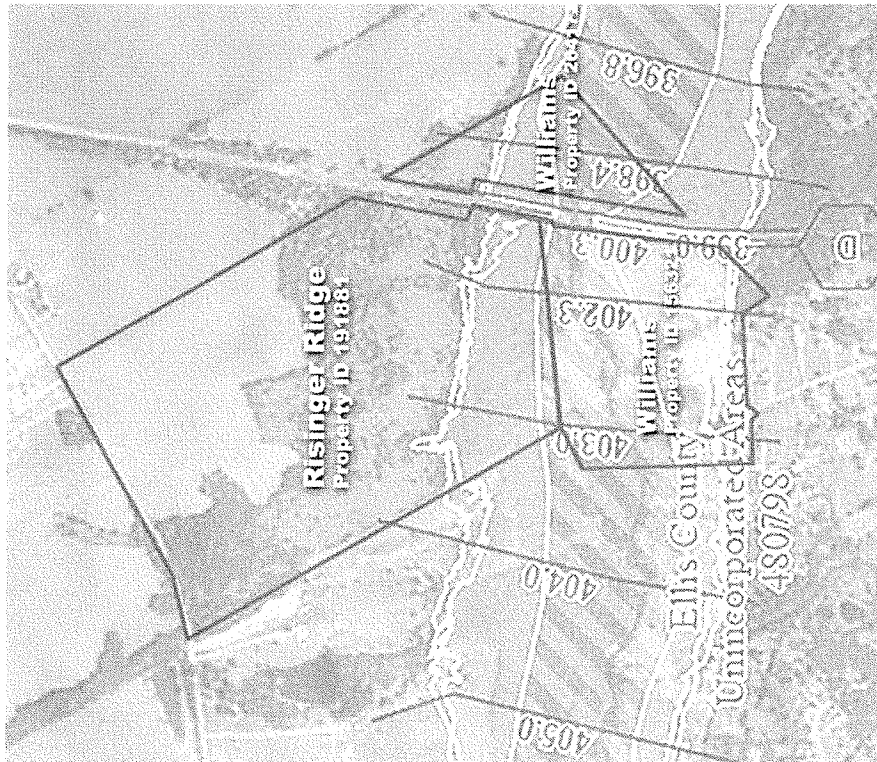


Exhibit D - Example of flooding event on our property

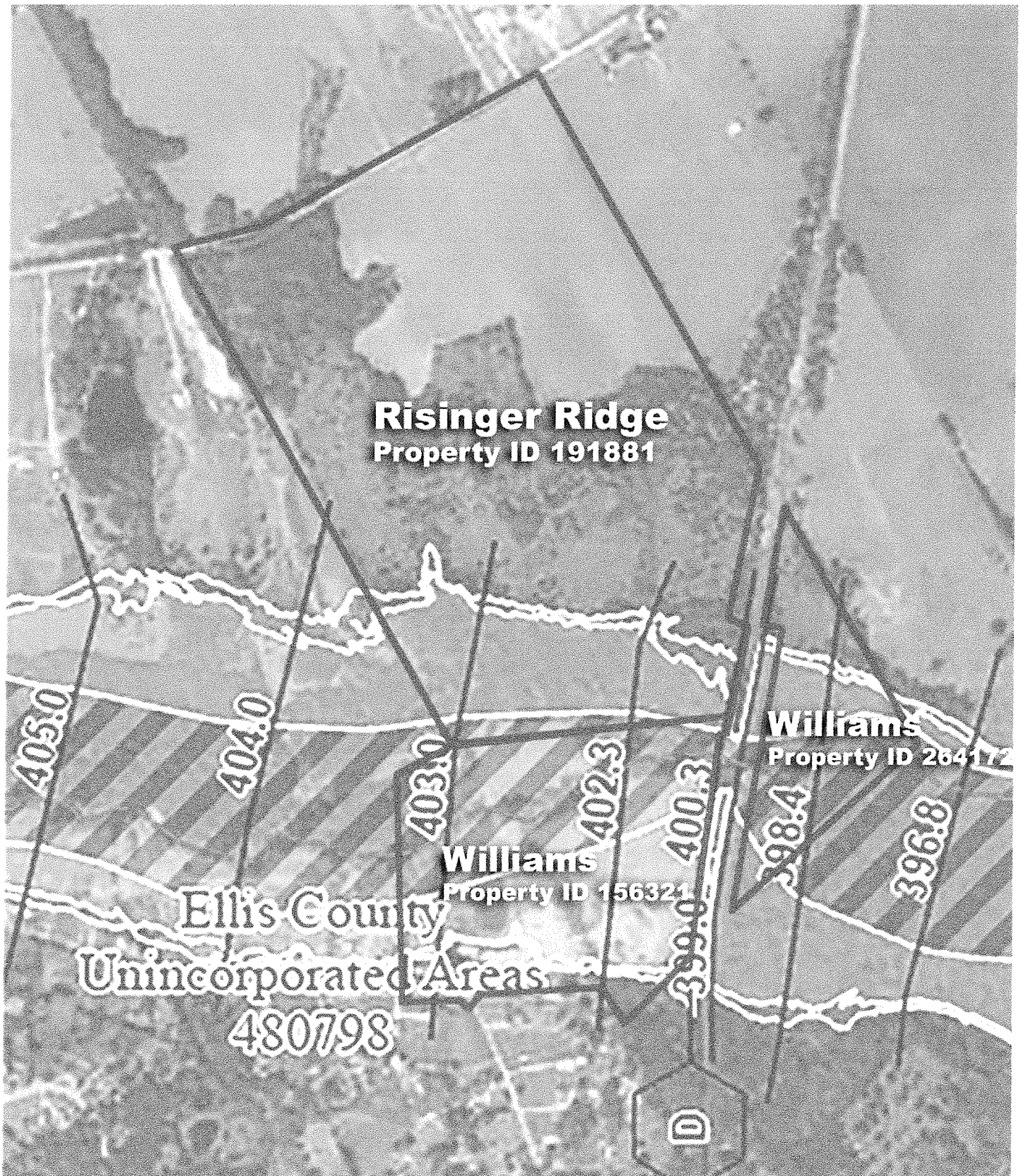
FEMA Flood Zone AE Special Flood Hazard Area

AT PUBLIC MEETING

FEMA Flood Zone AE is a Special Flood Hazard area. The properties along Brushy Creek frequently flood after rains of as little as 2-3", and the Northbound and Southbound service roads of Interstate 45 have to be closed while TXDOT clears away mud and debris from the roadway. Having 250,000 gallons of wastewater per day dumped into Brushy Creek will cause more frequent floods, and it's possible the service roads would have to remain closed most of the time since the creek is much shallower where it passes underneath I-45.

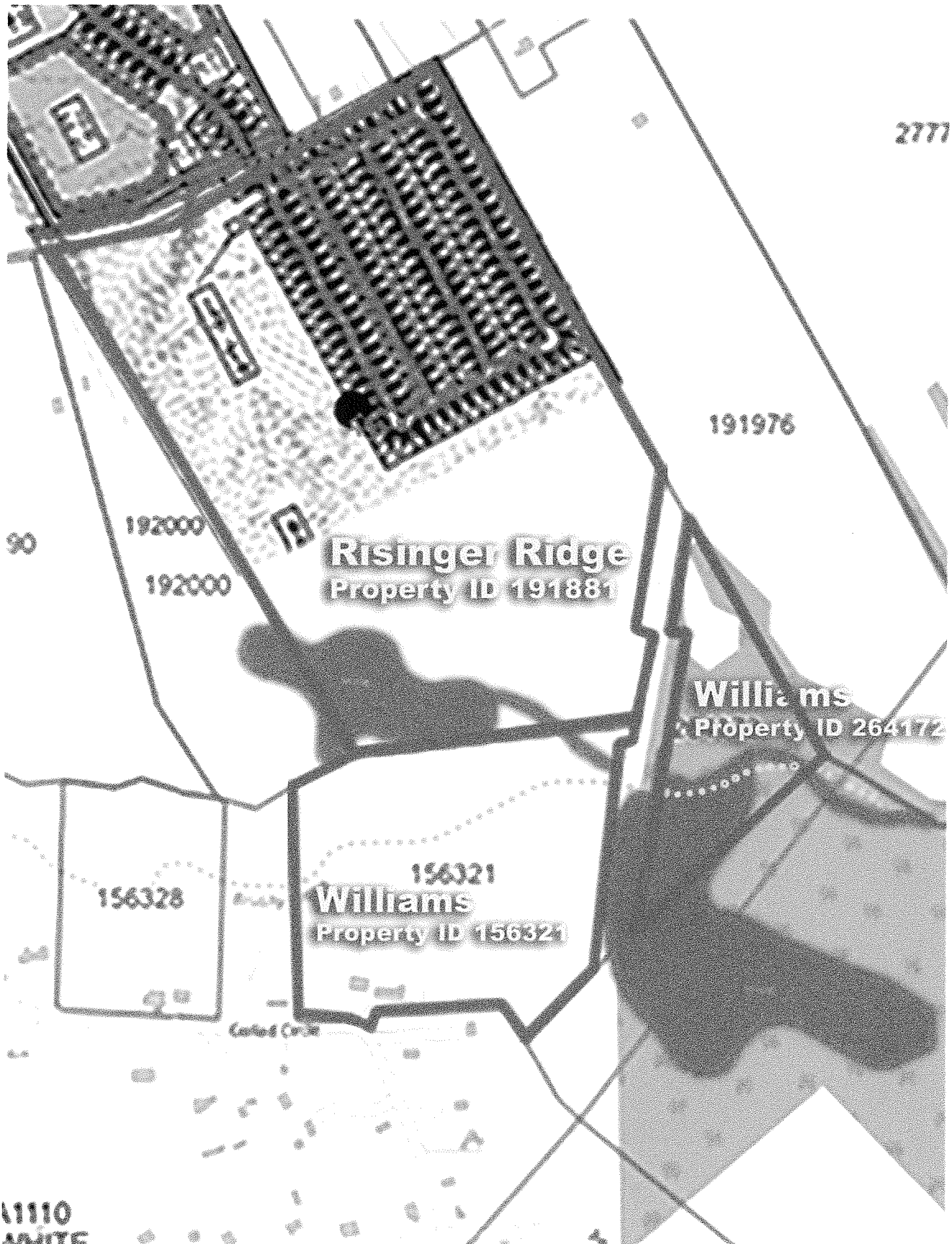
FEMA Flood Zone AE Special Flood Hazard Area Map

Wetlands Map

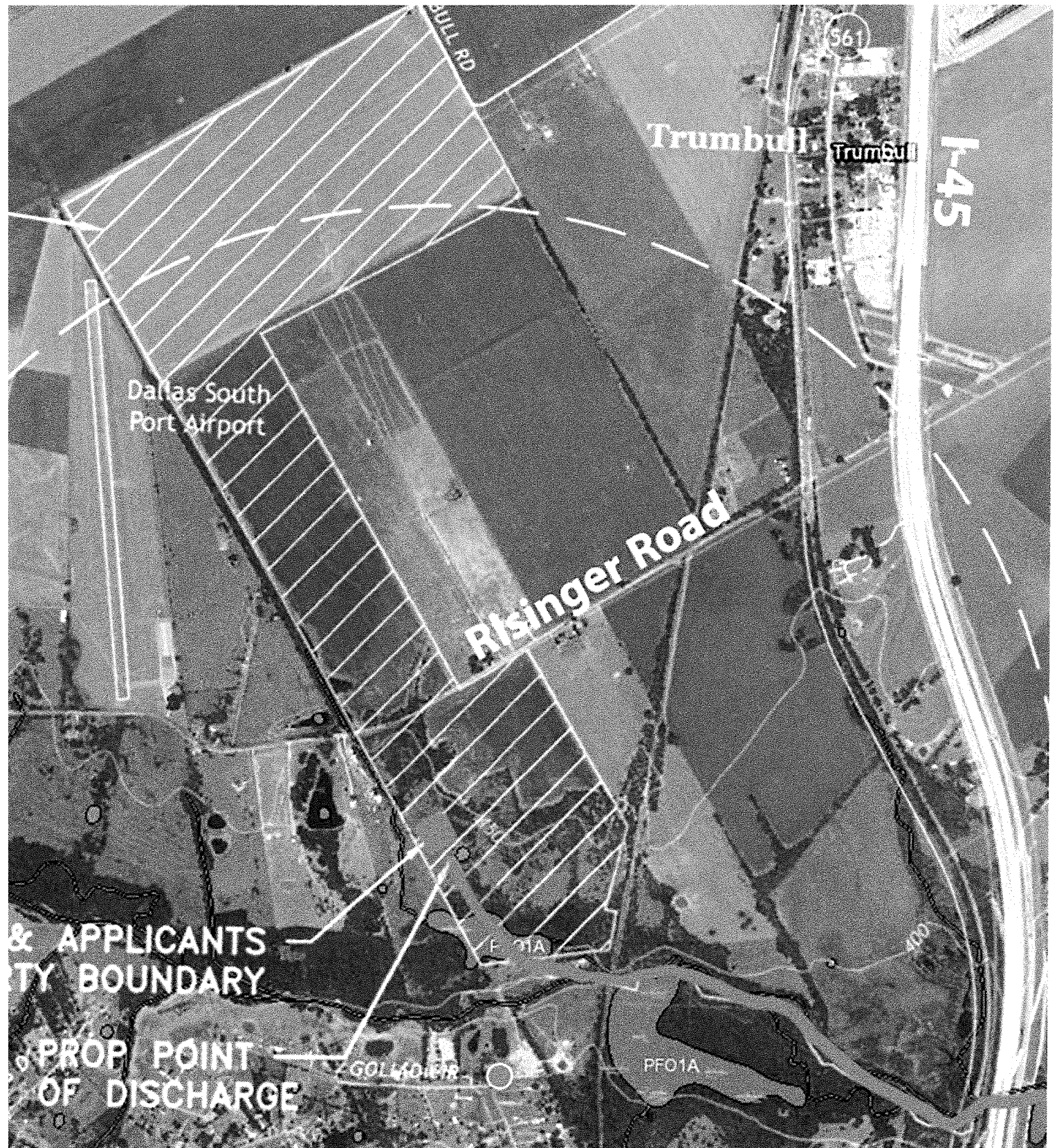
Red lines indicate boundary lines of subject properties. Dotted blue line indicates centerline of Brushy Creek. The dark green areas indicate the locations of the wetlands.

Diagonal white lines indicate the boundary lines of the Risinger Ridge property. The pink box indicates the location of the wastewater treatment plant. The pink line indicates the discharge route into Brushy Creek.

The green areas marked "PFO1A" are natural wetlands areas. The wastewater would flow daily either through or next to one of the Wetlands areas, and during flood events, wastewater would contaminate the fragile ecosystem of the larger Wetlands area South of Brushy Creek and just a bit East of the discharge point.

Floodwaters filled our entire South hayfield. For perspective, the tracks on the Kobelco excavator are about 34-36" high.

Southbound Interstate 45 service road one week after 2 inches of rain

This is how much water is still covering the Southbound I-45 service road a week after 2" of rain fell in early February 2024. Just past the concrete embankment on the left is the I-45 bridge that Brushy Creek crosses under. This falls in the FEMA Zone AE Special Flood Hazard Area and frequently floods after minimal rainfall. The service roads must be closed while TXDOT clears mud and debris from the road. This happens on both the Northbound and Southbound sides, blocking access to citizens trying to travel to and from their homes.

COMMENTS: My husband, John and I have property on both the South side and North side of Brushy Creek. Our property adjoins the proposed Clear Utilities / Risinger Ridge development on the Southern edge. It seems that Clear Utilities may believe that their property extends all the way to Brushy Creek, but that is not the case. We have a low water crossing that allows us access to our land on the North side of Brushy Creek; the land is in a flood plain but is rated for agricultural use and we grow hay there. There is also an abundance of wildlife (deer, wild hogs, bobcats, coyotes, raccoons, opossums to name just a few) that live in the wooded area between Brushy Creek and the proposed Risinger Ridge wastewater treatment plant. The wastewater from the treatment plant would have to flow through this wildlife

habitat, then over our land in order to reach Brushy Creek. The wastewater would spread out over several acres of our hayfield before pouring into Brushy Creek. Having wastewater flowing over our land would not only spoil our hay and cause erosion, it would effectively block access to about 10 acres of our land that lie on the other side of the proposed wastewater flow. Brushy Creek becomes progressively more shallow before it reaches Interstate 45. The creek regularly floods the service road on both sides of the highway whenever there is a rain of 2-3 inches or more. The creek handles rain runoff not only from Palmer but from as far away as Red Oak, and the service road must be closed to traffic while TXDOT cleans up the tree branches and mud that cover the road after the creek overflows its banks. Adding 250,000 gallons per day of wastewater to the creek will cause the service road to flood even more frequently, cutting off access to all citizens who exit the highway onto the service road in order to reach their homes. On the East side of Interstate 45, the creek becomes even more shallow and cuts through miles and miles of farmland where farmers graze their cattle and grow hay. The people affected by the flow of wastewater through Brushy Creek goes way beyond a 1-mile radius.

COMMENTS: I request a contested case hearing on the Risinger Ridge permit. I have property on both the South side and North side of Brushy Creek. My property adjoins the proposed Clear Utilities / Risinger Ridge development on its Southern edge. The wastewater would have to flow through a heavily wooded area full of wildlife such as deer, wild hogs, bobcats, armadillos, raccoons, and rabbits. Wastewater flow will harm the ecology of this wildlife habitat. The wastewater would then spread over my hayfield on its way to Brushy Creek, spoiling my hay and causing erosion. This whole area is in a FEMA Zone AE Special Flood Hazard area. After rains of only a few inches, rain runoff causes the creek to come out of its banks and flood my property. I have two large ponds on my property stocked with fish and home to many aquatic animals (turtles, frogs, toads, snakes) and the ponds are visited by migratory birds (ducks, geese, cranes). We eat the fish from our ponds, swim in them and animals drink from them. I am concerned about wastewater contaminating my ponds during flood events. Dumping 250,000 gallons of wastewater daily into Brushy Creek will cause the creek to flood even more frequently than it already does. Brushy Creek is much shallower where it passes under Interstate 45 less than a mile East of the wastewater discharge route, and the service road is already prone to frequent flooding - TXDOT has to close the service road, sometimes for several days, to clear mud and debris after a flooding event. The addition of wastewater will cause the service road to be closed even more than it already is, blocking access to citizens who need to use the road to access their homes, or as a way to access the highway when leaving their homes. I am concerned about odors from the treatment plant since it is so close to my home. If the wastewater treatment plant is approved, and the high-density housing development is built, I am concerned about overcrowding, increased traffic, strain on Ellis County emergency services, and strain on Ferris ISD and Palmer ISD from thousands of new students that will live in the development.

I request a contested case hearing for TCEQ Control NO. WQ0016273001, Petitioner Clear Utilities, LLC., for the proposed Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Risinger Ridge.

I am an affected person entitled to a contested case hearing on the issues raised in this hearing request. My property is located at **301A Interstate 45, Palmer, TX (EllisCAD Property ID 290145).**

The creation of this TPDES uniquely and adversely affects me in the following way(s):

I have a 226-acre farm just off Interstate 45 and Matt Road, on the border between Palmer and Ferris. I have cattle grazing in my pastures, I have multiple ponds for the cattle to drink from, and I grow hay.

Brushy Creek flows through the middle of one of the tracts I own (EllisCAD Property ID 290145). Almost the entire tract is in FEMA Flood Zone AE, which is a Special Flood Hazard area (see attached "Exhibit A") and floods on a regular basis after a heavy rain. Having 250,000 gallons per day of wastewater flowing through the creek will cause flooding to happen more frequently.

The depth of Brushy Creek where it passes underneath Interstate 45, less than a mile East of the proposed wastewater treatment plant, is much shallower than it is at the proposed wastewater discharge point (see attached "Exhibit B"). The service roads on both the Northbound and Southbound sides of Interstate 45, between Risinger Road and the first Palmer exit, regularly flood after rains of as little as 2 or 3 inches. The service roads must be closed to traffic – sometimes for several days – while TXDOT clears away mud and debris from the roads. Having 250,000 gallons per day of wastewater added to a creek that already floods several times a year will

make the situation even worse. Having flooded, closed service roads will inconvenience thousands of citizens in Ellis County who rely on those service roads to get where they need to go.

I am concerned about wastewater flooding my hayfield and spoiling the hay. I am concerned wastewater could get into the ponds my cows drink from. If the tract of land that Brushy Creek flows through constantly floods and keeps that field wet, I will not be able to access the Southern portion of my tract since the creek cuts the property in half. I won't be able to drive my trucks and tractors through there because they will get stuck in the mud.

I am concerned about how this wastewater treatment plant and the daily dumping of wastewater into the creek will affect the wildlife in this area. I have a fair amount of wooded areas on my property that are inhabited by deer, hogs and many other wild creatures. This project could affect the ecosystem that the animals rely on for survival.

I am also concerned about how the high-density housing development that the wastewater treatment plant would serve, would affect traffic, tear up roads, and overcrowd the area school systems. This is a rural area, lots of farmers and ranchers, crops growing, lots of cows and horses and sheep, lots of wildlife. Currently, the citizens living outside city limits in Ellis County have a minimum of 1 acre of land, and in many cases, dozens or hundreds of acres. Suddenly having so many extra people crowded into a relatively small space would make this area noisier and more cluttered, and not at all rural. Over 1,000 homes in the development, and if we assume 4 people per household, that would come to over 4,000 people living in the development.

Red lines indicate boundary lines of subject properties. Solid blue line indicates centerline of Brushy Creek. I own several contiguous tracts of land on the East side of Interstate 45, but Property ID 290145 is the one that Brushy Creek flows through. As you can see from the FEMA flood overlay, almost the entire tract is in FEMA Flood Zone AE which is a Special Flood Hazard area. The property frequently floods after a certain amount of rain, but having an additional 250,000 gallons of wastewater per day flowing through this shallow part of Brushy Creek will cause my farmland to flood much more frequently. I grow hay and raise cattle on this property. If wastewater floods my fields it will contaminate my hay and potentially enter the ponds that are my cows' sources of drinking water.

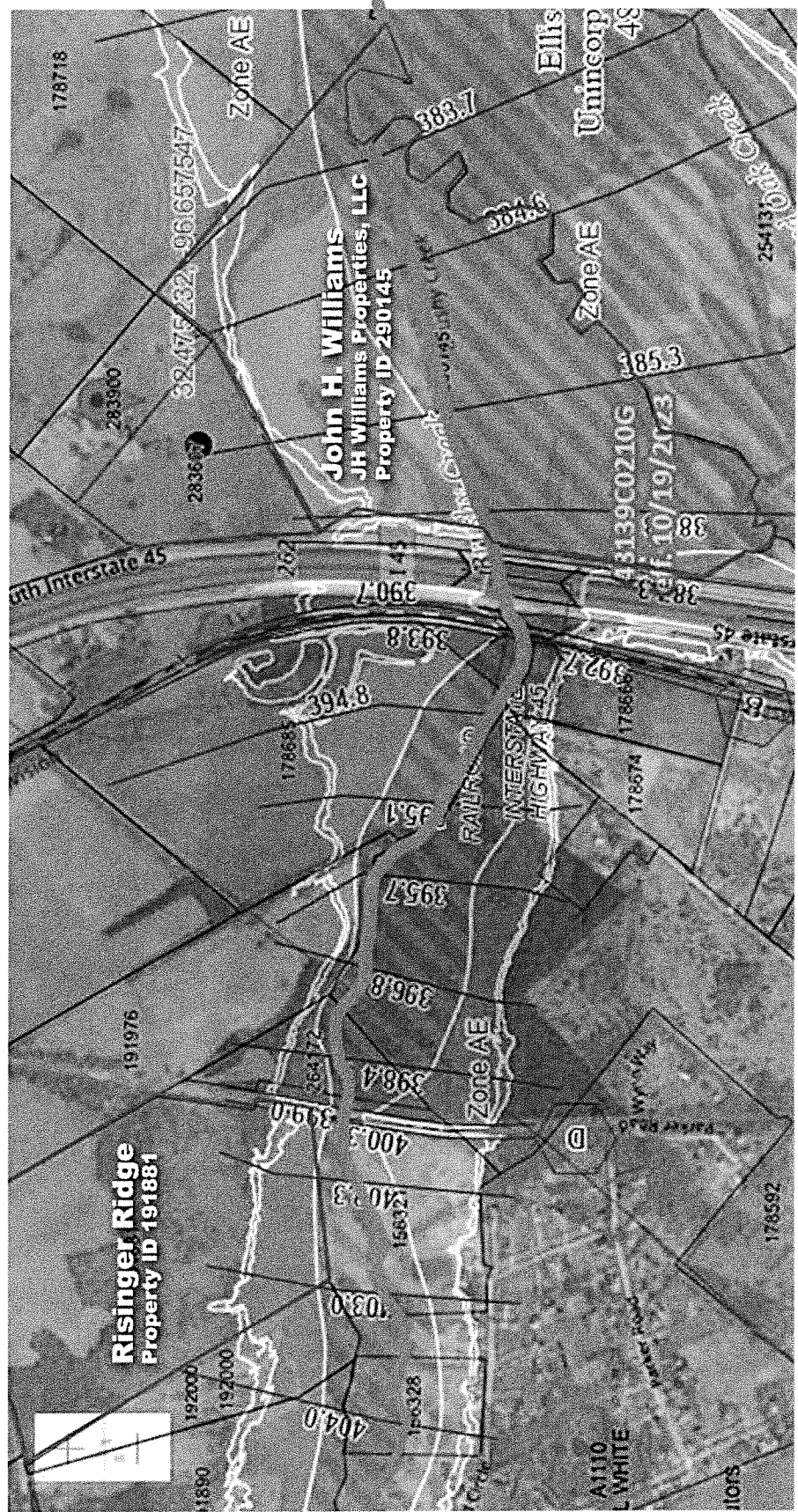


Exhibit B - Brushy Creek where it passes under Interstate 45

Looking West from NB service road

The banks of Brushy Creek are much shallower here than at the proposed discharge point, and frequently floods the service road after a rain. Adding 250,000 gallons per day of wastewater will cause more frequent flooding and closure of the road while XDOT clears away mud and debris.

The entry point of Brushy Creek to my property, after it has passed under Interstate 45. See how shallow the creek bank is. This tract is almost completely in a FEMA Zone AE Special Flood Hazard Area. Adding 250,000 gallons per day of wastewater to the creek will cause my farmland to flood more than it already does.
