In gratitude for the work that the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality does to protect Texas' natural resources, I write you today to request two public meetings about applications for Discharge Permits. These public meetings would afford the residents of Gillespie County opportunity to learn more about these applications, make inquiries, and provide official comments.

The requests are as follows:

- "The Village of Grape Creek" TCEQ application for Domestic Wastewater Discharge Permit No. WQ0016363001. There is concern about the proposed discharge of 20,000 gallons / day of treated domestic wastewater in an unnamed creek, a tributary of the Pedernales River.
- "Arch Ray, LLC" TCEQ application for the proposed Texas Pollutant Discharge Permit No. WQ 0005452000. The concerns here include a proposed discharge of 35,000 gallons / day of treated domestic wastewater into an earthen ditch which feeds directly into the Pedernales River.

I respectfully request that these two public meetings be held in Gillespie County, with suitable notice to local residents and stakeholders.
