

1 Consideration of the proposal for decision and proposed order concerning the Petition for the creation of North Fork Municipal Utility District of Williamson County

Commissioner's proposed changes to the ALJ's proposed order:

- **Re-number** the ALJ's proposed findings regarding the reasonableness of projected construction costs as Findings of Fact Nos. 18.1-18.3 to correct a clerical error;
- **Delete** proposed Finding of Fact No. 32 relating the ALJ's findings on groundwater and recharge effects because the finding is not relevant to the Commission's unreasonable effects inquiry for MUD creation;
- **Correct** the name "Horsley" in Finding of Fact No. 52, Conclusion of Law No. 12, and Ordering Provision No. 4 proposed in the ED's Exceptions and agreed to by the ALJ's Reply;
- **Reword** Finding of Fact No. 52 to identify the correct requirements for temporary directors under Texas Water Code § 54.022, which are different from the unnecessary revised language proposed in the ED's Exceptions and agreed to by the ALJ's Reply and to memorialize that the five individuals' affidavits indicated compliance with the temporary director requirements, as follows:

FOF 52. The Petition named Joseph Thomas, Jared Jehl, Matthew C. Silker, Chelsea Brown, and John Gilbert Horsely as temporary directors. These individuals' affidavits indicate that they are either residents of the county in which the proposed District is located, a county adjacent to the county in which the proposed District is located, or if the proposed District is located in a county that is in a metropolitan statistical area designated by the United States Office of Management and Budget or its successor agency, a county in the same metropolitan statistical area as the county in which the proposed District is located.; and

- **Amend** Ordering Provisions No. 2 and 7 and **Add** the additional proposed ordering provision proposed in the ED's Exceptions and agreed to by the ALJ's Reply to be consistent with other Commission district creation orders issued by the agency.
