This is my formal response to the recent "Decision of the Executive Director" that I received from the TCEQ. The letter noted that:

"This decision does not authorize construction or operation of any proposed facilities. This decision will be considered by the commissioners at a regularly scheduled public meeting before any action is taken on this application unless all requests for contested case hearing or reconsideration have been withdrawn before that meeting."

A. Request for a Contested Case Hearing

I, Madhu Sekharan, JD, MBA, with residential address 16614 Radiant Lilac Trail, and daytime phone number 832.920.1515 am requesting a contested hearing with this letter. I request a contested case hearing regarding Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 531, TPDES Permit No. WQ0016334001.

I am an "affected person". I have a "personal justiciable interest related to a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest affected by the application". I, as well as my other family members who reside in the Fairfield subdivision would be adversely affected by the proposed facility or activity "in a manner not common to the general public".

Violations and issues related to wastewater treatment plants in Texas include:

- -Golden Acres Waste Water Treatment Plant has had violations.
- -Almost half of Texas' major industrial facilities violated their wastewater permit
- -Sewage pollution threatens the Hill Country's streams and aguifers.
- Certain Texas wastewater plants have contracts with fertilizer companies to take their biosolids.
- A wastewater treatment plant on a ranch in Comal County has raised environmental concerns.

I have health and safety concerns that are likely to be adversely affected by the "proposed facility or activities". My home is located within miles of the proposed wastewater treatment plant. I also now manage the estate of my late mother, which includes a home located very close to the proposed facility. That home is located

at 20111 Chad Arbor Trail, Cypress, Texas 77433. That home is approximately one mile from the proposed facility. My family and I frequently spend time outdoors, walking and running along the trails of Fairfield. We have serious health and safety concerns given how that many wastewater treatment plants built in Texas experience issues of major concern to Texas residents who reside in close proximity to wastwewater treatment plants.

I disputed issues of fact that are "relevant and material" to the commission's decision on this application during the public comment period. To facilitate the commission's determination of the number and scope of issues to be referred, please note that in Texas, studies show that home property values tend to decline when a wastewater treatment plant is built within 5 miles. This has been rushed and furthermore, the best interests of the community are certainly not the focus with this proposed facility.
- **4. Review Historical Data**. Homeowners should be provided with the opportunity to review historical data, study the history of accidents at other sites such as this one, and also be able to is legal advice to understand your options and any potential recourse.
