
Dear Sir or Madam,

I have considerable concern regarding possible impacts to water quality that the proposed sewage treatment plant will have on the upper portions of Carancahua Bay, located in Jackson County. This portion of the bay is very shallow and has little water interchange with the open portion of Matagorda Bay to the South. As a result, any unintended release of raw sewage into the bay would have significant and long term impacts on water quality, wildlife, and the health of those already using the bay.

I request a Public Meeting be held in Jackson County so that pertinent questions may be asked regarding all impacts which might occur from the plant to be permitted. These questions likely would include, but not be limited to:

- design and operation of the plant
- who will operate and maintain the plant
- who will provide monitoring, and how that monitoring will be done
- what role will the State play, after the plant begins operations
- what studies have been made to determine the impact of the plant on the local environment and on the current usage of the bay by residents

Carancahua Bay has a large number of residential septic systems near the bay, the bay system is contaminated as mentioned in the TCEQ article below. Any addition of foreign water into this hatchery/estuary is simply not worth the ecological damage that will occur. The addition of a sewage treatment plant of this magnitude on the Carancahua Bay system will be

detrimental to the people and the hatchery/estuary. Carancahua Bay is a very important hatching bay for fish and shrimp. As well many endangered bird species (see Texas Parks and Wildlife large list of "Protected Birds" feed from this bay. Below is a article from TCEQ on the state of the bay system. TCEQ has identified Carancahua Bay as having high concentrations of bacteria, the paragraph below is from TCEQ. The presence of these bacteria may indicate a health risk to people who swim or wade in the bay—activities referred to as "contact recreation" in the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards." Especially after the freeze that Texas has seen, the fish kills that have occurred, a bay system such as Carancahua needs to remain healthy and improve health to provide hatching grounds for fish and shrimp to support all of Texas wildlife. I represent the Cape Carancahua Property Owners' Association. The Cape Carancahua Subdivision ("The Cape") is a 530-acre private, gated residential community located on Carancahua Bay, which opens into Matagorda Bay and thence flows into to the Gulf of Mexico. The Cape is located in Jackson County, Texas.

My client has serious concerns regarding the above referenced application submitted by Serenity RV Resort, LP. The proposed permit for a Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System is to authorize the discharge of treated wastewater by a route from the plant, then to a man-made ditch and finally into Carancahua Bay. Due to my client's serious concerns regarding pollution risks, we request that the application be reviewed in detail to confirm that it meets all state and federal regulatory requirements, to confirm that the engineering is sufficient and to confirm there will be no issues or pollution from the proposed design. As The Cape is a waterfront community located on Carancahua Bay, they are concerned that seasonal use from the RV park will cause throughput increases that shock the system and cause pollution on the waterfront community. My client also requests that TCEQ fully review the application to be certain provisions are in place should there be a default in design or implementation/operation of the proposed system.



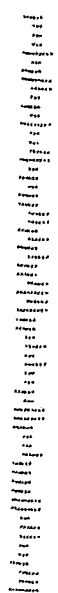


