TLAP Permit No. WQ0016111001

Decision of the Executive Director.

The executive director has made a decision that the above-referenced permit application meets the requirements of applicable law. **This decision does not authorize construction or operation of any proposed facilities.** This decision will be considered by the commissioners at a regularly scheduled public meeting before any action is taken on this application unless all requests for contested case hearing or reconsideration have been withdrawn before that meeting.

Enclosed with this letter are instructions to view the Executive Director's Response to Public Comment (RTC) on the Internet. Individuals who would prefer a mailed copy of the RTC or are having trouble accessing the RTC on the website, should contact the Office of the Chief Clerk, by phone at (512) 239-3300 or by email at chiefclk@tceq.texas.gov. A complete copy of the RTC (including the mailing list), complete application, draft permit and related documents, including public comments, are available for review at the TCEQ Central Office. Additionally, a copy of the complete application, the draft permit, and executive director's preliminary decision are available for viewing and copying at the Dripping Springs Community Library, 501 Sportsplex Drive, Dripping Springs, Texas.

If you disagree with the executive director's decision, and you believe you are an "affected person" as defined below, you may request a contested case hearing. In addition, anyone may request reconsideration of the executive director's decision. The procedures for the commission's evaluation of hearing requests/requests for reconsideration are located in 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 55, Subchapter F. A brief description of the procedures for these two requests follows.

How to Request a Contested Case Hearing.

It is important that your request include all the information that supports your right to a contested case hearing. Your hearing request must demonstrate that you meet the applicable legal requirements to have your hearing request granted. The commission's consideration of your request will be based on the information you provide.

The request must include the following:

- (1) Your name, address, daytime telephone number, and, if possible, a fax number.

- (2) The name of the applicant, the permit number and other numbers listed above so that your request may be processed properly.
- (3) A statement clearly expressing that you are requesting a contested case hearing. For example, the following statement would be sufficient: "I request a contested case hearing."
- (4) If the request is made by a group or association, the request must identify:
 - (A) one person by name, address, daytime telephone number, and, if possible, the fax number, of the person who will be responsible for receiving all communications and documents for the group;
 - (B) the comments on the application submitted by the group that are the basis of the hearing request; and
 - (C) by name and physical address one or more members of the group that would otherwise have standing to request a hearing in their own right. The interests the group seeks to protect must relate to the organization's purpose. Neither the claim asserted nor the relief requested must require the participation of the individual members in the case.

Additionally, your request must demonstrate that you are an **"affected person."** An affected person is one who has a personal justiciable interest related to a legal right, duty, privilege, power, or economic interest affected by the application. Your request must describe how and why you would be adversely affected by the proposed facility or activity in a manner not common to the general public. For example, to the extent your request is based on these concerns, you should describe the likely impact on your health, safety, or uses of your property which may be adversely affected by the proposed facility or activities. To demonstrate that you have a personal justiciable interest, you must state, as specifically as you are able, your location and the distance between your location and the proposed facility or activities.

Your request must raise disputed issues of fact that are relevant and material to the commission's decision on this application that were raised **by you** during the public comment period. The request cannot be based solely on issues raised in comments that you have withdrawn.

To facilitate the commission's determination of the number and scope of issues to be referred to hearing, you should: 1) specify any of the executive director's responses to **your** comments that you dispute; 2) the factual basis of the dispute; and 3) list any disputed issues of law.

How to Request Reconsideration of the Executive Director's Decision.

Unlike a request for a contested case hearing, anyone may request reconsideration of the executive director's decision. A request for reconsideration should contain your name, address, daytime phone number, and, if possible, your fax number. The request must state that you are requesting reconsideration of the executive director's decision, and must explain why you believe the decision should be reconsidered.

Deadline for Submitting Requests.

A request for a contested case hearing or reconsideration of the executive director's decision must be **received by** the Chief Clerk's office no later than **30 calendar days** after the date

of this letter. You may submit your request electronically at www.tceq.texas.gov/agency/decisions/cc/comments.html or by mail to the following address:

Timely requests for a contested case hearing or for reconsideration of the executive director's decision will be referred to the TCEQ's Alternative Dispute Resolution Program and set on the agenda of one of the commission's regularly scheduled meetings. Decisión del Director Ejecutivo.

El director ejecutivo ha tomado la decisión de que la solicitud de permiso mencionada anteriormente cumple con los requisitos de la ley aplicable. **Esta decisión no autoriza la construcción u operación de ninguna instalación propuesta.** Esta decisión será considerada por los comisionados en una reunión pública programada regularmente antes de que se tome cualquier medida sobre esta solicitud, a menos que todas las solicitudes de audiencia o reconsideración de casos impugnados hayan sido retiradas antes de esa reunión.

Se adjuntan a esta carta las instrucciones para ver en Internet la Respuesta del Director Ejecutivo al Comentario Público (RTC). Las personas que prefieran una copia por correo del RTC o que tengan problemas para acceder al RTC en el sitio web, deben comunicarse con la Oficina del Secretario Oficial, por teléfono al (512) 239-3300 o por correo electrónico a chiefclk@tceq.texas.gov. Si no está de acuerdo con la decisión del director ejecutivo y cree que es una "persona afectada" como se define a continuación, puede solicitar una audiencia de caso impugnado. Además, cualquier persona puede solicitar la reconsideración de la decisión del director ejecutivo. Los procedimientos para la evaluación de la comisión de las solicitudes de audiencia/solicitudes de reconsideración se encuentran en 30 Código Administrativo de Texas, Capítulo 55, Subcapítulo F. A continuación, se presenta una breve descripción de los procedimientos para estas dos solicitudes.

Cómo solicitar una audiencia de caso impugnado.

Es importante que su solicitud incluya toda la información que respalde su derecho a una audiencia de caso impugnado. Su solicitud de audiencia debe demostrar que cumple con los requisitos legales aplicables para que se le conceda su solicitud de audiencia. La consideración de la comisión de su solicitud se basará en la información que usted proporcione.

La solicitud debe incluir lo siguiente:

- (1) Su nombre, dirección, número de teléfono durante el día y, si es posible, un número de fax.
- (2) El nombre del solicitante, el número de permiso y otros números enumerados anteriormente para que su solicitud pueda procesarse adecuadamente.
- (3) Una declaración que exprese claramente que está solicitando una audiencia de caso impugnado. Por ejemplo, la siguiente declaración sería suficiente: "Solicito una audiencia de caso impugnado".
- (4) Si la solicitud es realizada por un grupo o asociación, la solicitud debe identificar:
 - (A) una persona por nombre, dirección, número de teléfono durante el día y, si es posible, el número de fax, de la persona que será responsable de recibir todas las comunicaciones y documentos para el grupo.;
 - (B) los comentarios sobre la solicitud presentada por el grupo que constituyen la base de la solicitud de audiencia; y
 - (C) por nombre y dirección física, uno o más miembros del grupo que de otro modo tendrían derecho a solicitar una audiencia por derecho propio. Los intereses que el grupo busca proteger deben estar relacionados con el propósito de la organización. Ni la reclamación alegada ni la reparación solicitada deben requerir la participación de los miembros individuales en el caso.

Además, su solicitud debe demostrar que usted es una **"persona afectada"**. Una persona afectada es aquella que tiene un interés justiciable personal relacionado con un derecho, deber, privilegio, poder o interés económico legal afectado por la solicitud. Su solicitud debe describir cómo y por qué se vería afectado negativamente por la instalación o actividad propuesta de una manera que no sea común al público en general. Por ejemplo, en la medida en que su solicitud se base en estas preocupaciones, debe describir el impacto probable en su salud, seguridad o usos de su propiedad que puedan verse afectados negativamente por la instalación o las actividades propuestas. Para demostrar que tiene un interés personal justiciable, debe indicar, tan específicamente como pueda, su ubicación y la distancia entre su ubicación y la instalación o actividades propuestas.

Su solicitud debe plantear cuestiones de hecho controvertidas que sean relevantes y materiales para la decisión de la comisión sobre esta solicitud que fueron planteadas **por usted** durante el período de comentarios públicos. La solicitud no puede basarse únicamente en cuestiones planteadas en los comentarios que haya retirado.

Para facilitar la determinación por parte de la comisión del número y alcance de los asuntos que se remitirán a la audiencia, usted debe: 1) especificar cualquiera de las respuestas del director ejecutivo a **sus** comentarios que usted disputa; 2) la base fáctica de la disputa; y 3) enumerar cualquier cuestión de derecho en disputa.

Cómo solicitar la reconsideración de la decisión del Director Ejecutivo.

A diferencia de una solicitud de audiencia de caso impugnado, cualquier persona puede solicitar la reconsideración de la decisión del director ejecutivo. Una solicitud de reconsideración debe contener su nombre, dirección, número de teléfono durante el día y, si

es posible, su número de fax. La solicitud debe indicar que está solicitando la reconsideración de la decisión del director ejecutivo, y debe explicar por qué cree que la decisión debe ser reconsiderada.

Fecha límite para la presentación de solicitudes.

La oficina del Secretario Oficial debe **recibir** una solicitud de audiencia de caso impugnado o reconsideración de la decisión del director ejecutivo a más tardar **30 días calendario** después de la fecha de esta carta. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S RESPONSE TO PUBLIC COMMENT

The Executive Director of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (the Commission or TCEQ) files this Response to Public Comment (Response or RTC) on the application by Blizexas, LLC (Applicant) for a new permit, Texas Land Application Permit (TLAP), TCEQ Permit No. WQ0016111001, and the Executive Director's preliminary decision on the application. As required by Title 30 of the Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC) Section (§) 55.156, before a permit is issued, the Executive Director prepares a response to all timely, significant or relevant and material comments. The Office of the Chief Clerk received public meeting requests from State Senator Donna Campbell and State Representative Erin Zweiner. The Office of the Chief Clerk received timely comments from the [organizations](#) and [individuals](#) listed in the master appendix in this response. This response addresses all timely public comments received, whether or not withdrawn.

This application is subject to the requirements in Senate Bill (SB) 709, effective September 1, 2015. SB 709 amended the requirements for comments and contested case hearings. One of the changes required by SB 709 is that the Commission may not find that a "hearing requestor is an affected person unless the hearing requestor timely submitted comments on the permit application." Texas Water Code (TWC) § 5.115(a-1)(2)(B).

I. BACKGROUND

A. Description Of Facility

The Blizexas, LLC (Applicant) submitted an application to TCEQ for a new permit, TCEQ Permit No. WQ0016111001, to authorize the disposal of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 12,000 gallons per day via a subsurface area drip dispersal system (SADDS) with a minimum area of 2.75 acres of public access land. The Applicant proposes to operate Rockingwall Ranch wastewater treatment facility (WWTF) that will serve the Rockingwall Ranch Event Venue.

The Rockingwall Ranch WWTF will be an activated sludge process plant using the conventional mode. Treatment units will include an onsite lift station, two flow equalization basins, a bar screen, an aeration basin, a final clarifier, a tertiary media filter, and a chlorine contact chamber. The Applicant is proposing to use two flow equalization basins, each 40,000 gallons, to dampen the high variability of wastewater generation and convey a consistent, attenuated flow stream to the subsequent treatment units. According to 30 TAC § 217.6(d) rules, the applicant is required to submit to TCEQ the design of the proposed wastewater treatment facility including the flow equalization basins for review and approval prior to construction. The facility has not been constructed.

The facility and disposal site will be located approximately 0.25 mile east of Crumley Ranch Road and Fitzhugh Road, Hays County, Texas 78737. The facility and disposal site will be located in the drainage basin of Barton Creek in Segment No. 1430 of the Colorado River Basin. No discharge of pollutants into water in the State is authorized by this permit.

If the draft permit is issued, 12,000 gallons of treated effluent would be authorized to be land applied by subsurface area drip dispersal system irrigation to 2.75 acres at an application rate of 0.1 gallons per square foot per day. The effluent limits in the draft permit are consistent with 30 TAC Chapter 309 and Table 1 in § 309.4.

The effluent limitations in the draft permit, based on a daily average, are 10 milligrams per liter (mg/l) biochemical oxygen demand – 5 day (BOD₅), 15 mg/l total suspended solids (TSS), and 126 colony forming units (CFU) or most probable number

(MPN) of *Escherichia coli* (*E. coli*) per 100 milliliters (ml). The effluent shall contain a total chlorine residual of at least 1.0 mg/l after a detention time of at least 20 minutes based on peak flow.

B. Procedural Background

TCEQ received this application for a new permit on February 17, 2022, and declared it administratively complete on April 26, 2022. The Notice of Receipt and Intent to Obtain a Water Quality Permit (NORI) was published in *The Hays Press News Dispatch* on May 11, 2022. The application was determined technically complete on June 15, 2022. The Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision (NAPD) was published in *The Hays Press News Dispatch* on July 20, 2022. The first public meeting notice was published in *The Dripping Springs Century News* on October 27, 2022. The first public meeting was held on November 29, 2022.

The second public meeting was scheduled for January 29, 2024. A combined NORI/NAPD was published in *El Mundo* on August 10, 2023. The second public meeting notice was published in *El Mundo* on December 21, 2023, in *The Dripping Springs Century News* on December 28, 2023, and in *The Austin American-Statesman* on December 28, 2023.

The public comment period ended at the close of the meeting on January 29, 2024. This application was filed after September 1, 2015; therefore, this application is subject to the procedural requirements adopted pursuant to House Bill (HB) 801, 76th Legislature (1999), and Senate Bill (SB) 709, 84th Legislature (2015), both implemented by the Commission in its rules in 30 TAC Chapters 39, 50, and 55. The Texas Legislature enacted SB 709, effective September 1, 2015, amending the requirements for comments and contested case hearings. This application is subject to those changes in the law.

II. COMMENTS AND RESPONSES

COMMENT 1:

Individuals listed in [Appendix A](#) are concerned that surface water quality and aquatic life uses for Barton Creek will be impacted from the proposed facility.

RESPONSE 1:

TCEQ

The proposed facility is in the Barton Creek watershed. As discussed under Section I – Background above, the application is for a Texas Land Application Permit (TLAP) to dispose treated wastewater via a subsurface area drip dispersal system. The permit, if issued, would not authorize the discharge of pollutants into water in the state, including Barton Creek. Therefore, the proposed facility is not expected to cause any impacts to Barton Creek. The draft permit prohibits any wastewater from surfacing, ponding, or running off along the ground surface.

The proposed permit would authorize irrigation of 2.75 acres via a SADDs at an application rate intended to irrigate the grasses beneficially. The ED added numerous special provisions to the draft permit that are included to prevent excess wastewater irrigation and any subsequent runoff from the property to surface water. These provisions include:

- Special Provision 14 which sets a maximum wastewater application rate of 0.1 gallons per square foot per day.
- Special Provision 18 which would require the applicant to plant and maintain year-round actively growing grasses (Bermuda grass and Winter ryegrass).

- Special Provision 16 which prohibits ponding of wastewater.
- Special Provision 23 which requires the installation soil moisture sensors 12 inches below the drip irrigation lines in each zone that will automatically shut off irrigation if the soil becomes saturated.
- Special Provisions 19 and 22 which requires minimum total soil depth of 18 inches with a requirement to import and maintain soils onsite, as needed.
- Special Provision 33 which would require the applicant to divert rainwater from running onto wastewater irrigation fields.
- Special Provision 36 which establishes a setback between the SADDs and the northern property boundary.
- Special Provision 12 which requires a minimum buffer distance of 100 feet between effluent irrigation areas and surface water in the state.
- Special Provision 9 which requires the installation of suction lysimeters to sample any shallow groundwater in the soils quarterly and conduct quarterly field surveys to identify springs or seeps, as an additional safeguard against wastewater from saturating the soils and migrating to groundwater or offsite to creeks. If any water is present in the lysimeters or springs or seeps, that water must be sampled and analyzed for a variety of water quality parameters. The results of that monitoring are required to be submitted to the TCEQ Water Quality Division, Enforcement Division, and TCEQ Region 11 annually.

Additionally, the permit requires weekly inspections of the site by the Applicant to identify any issues like runoff, erosion, and damaged vegetation, and to record those observations in a log book. Special Provision 17 of the draft permit requires the operator to initiate any required actions to correct the issues within 24 hours of discovery.

No impacts to downstream waters, including Barton Creek, are expected from the operation of the SADDs facility in accordance with the proposed permit.

COMMENT 2:

Individuals listed in [Appendix B](#) expressed concerns related to the availability of groundwater used for drinking water.

RESPONSE 2:

Groundwater availability is not under the authority of TCEQ to consider when evaluating a wastewater permit action. Groundwater management is under the purview of the Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District for this particular property. They may be able to address groundwater supply questions at 512-858-9253 or www.haysgroundwater.com.

If the comment is referring to a concern regarding groundwater contamination, please see responses to Comments 1 and 3, which address impacts to groundwater.

COMMENT 3:

Individuals listed in [Appendix B](#) expressed concerns related to groundwater contamination of the Trinity Aquifer and its associated springs, the Edwards Aquifer, and Barton Springs.

RESPONSE 3:

The proposed facility is within the recharge zone of the Trinity Aquifer. The Executive Director evaluated the Application and supporting documentation required by state regulations to ensure that the proposal is protective of groundwater quality, including this aquifer.

The proposed facility is also within the Edwards Aquifer Contributing Zone. The Edwards Aquifer Recharge Zone lies approximately 25 miles downstream from this site. Recharge to the Edwards Aquifer occurs as surface water originating from the Edwards Aquifer Contributing Zone eventually enters the Edwards Aquifer Recharge Zone. Barton Springs discharges from the Edwards Aquifer, which does not occur under this facility.

The proposed permit does not authorize any discharge of wastewater or pollutants to waters in the state, which includes groundwater. The draft permit contains several requirements intended to prevent groundwater contamination. These requirements include numerous Special Provisions added to the draft permit to address specific site conditions, consistent with state regulations. The Special Provisions added for groundwater protection include:

- Special Provision 9 requires the applicant to install suction lysimeters to sample any shallow groundwater in the soils adjacent to the SADDs fields quarterly and conduct quarterly field surveys to identify springs or seeps. These surveys were added as an additional verification that wastewater is not saturating the soils and migrating to groundwater or offsite to creeks. If any water is present in the lysimeters or springs or seeps, that water must be sampled and analyzed for a variety of water quality parameters. The results of that monitoring will be submitted to the TCEQ Water Quality Division, Enforcement Division, and TCEQ Region 11 annually. If sampling indicates that wastewater is saturating the soils, then the Executive Director can amend the permit to include additional provisions, or may initiate Enforcement actions.
- Special Provisions 11 and 13 which requires the applicant to create setbacks between the wastewater treatment plant and the irrigation fields and any water wells.
- Special Provision 14 which sets a maximum wastewater application rate of 0.1 gallons per square foot per day.
- Special Provision 15 which requires the applicant to prevent seepage or percolation out of the root zone.
- Special Provision 17 which requires the applicant to conduct weekly inspections of the site to identify any issues like runoff, erosion, damaged vegetation and record those observations in a log book. The permit requires the operator to initiate any required actions to correct the issues within 24 hours of discovery. Should water quality testing demonstrate that wastewater is ponding in the soils, then the TCEQ could initiate enforcement action against the facility or amend the permit to address the issues.
- Special Provision 18 which requires the applicant to plant and maintain year-round actively growing grasses (Bermuda grass and Winter ryegrass).
- Special Provisions 19 and 22 which require the applicant to maintain total soil depth of 18 inches and require the applicant to import and maintain soils onsite, as needed.
- Special Provision 23 which requires the applicant to install soil moisture sensors 12 inches below the drip irrigation lines in each zone that will automatically shut off irrigation if the soil becomes saturated.

This draft permit has been determined to comply with TCEQ rules and applicable state statutes which were written to be protective of groundwater quality. Compliant operation of the proposed wastewater facility and associated SADDs is not expected to cause impacts to the Trinity Aquifer, the Edwards Aquifer, or Barton Springs.

COMMENT 4:

Individuals listed in [Appendix C](#) expressed concerns about impacts to wildlife, livestock, birds, and apiaries.

RESPONSE 4:

This proposed permit will not authorize a discharge of pollutants into waters in the state. All the treated effluent is required to be disposed on-site via SADDs irrigation and confined in the root zone. The subsurface irrigation practices are required to be designed and managed as to prevent surfacing and ponding of effluent or contamination of ground and surface waters and to prevent the occurrence of nuisance conditions in the area. The Applicant will be required to monitor the physical condition of the SADDs on a weekly basis when irrigation occurs. Any areas with problems such as surface runoff, surficial erosion, and stressed or damaged vegetation are required to be recorded in a field log kept on-site, and corrective measures are required to be initiated within 24 hours of discovery. If the wastewater facility is operated in accordance with this draft permit, there should not be any harmful impacts to wildlife, including aquatic wildlife and birds, or to bees associated with offsite apiaries.

The Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD) is the state agency that oversees and protects wildlife and their habitat. It can be contacted by calling 1-800-792-1112 or by mail at 4200 Smith School Road, Austin, Texas 78744. The TPWD received notice of this permit application.

COMMENT 5:

Individuals in [Appendix D](#) expressed concerns over the proposed facility causing increased runoff and flooding to Barton Creek.

RESPONSE 5:

The TCEQ does not have jurisdiction to address runoff, flooding, or erosion issues in the wastewater permitting process. The permitting process is limited to controlling the discharge of pollutants into (or adjacent to) water in the state and protecting the water quality of the state's rivers, lakes, and coastal waters. However, to the extent that an issue related to flooding also involves water quality, the Applicant is required to comply with all the numeric and narrative effluent limitations and other conditions in the proposed permit at all times, including during flooding conditions. In addition, the permit is designed to ensure that effluent runoff, seepage, surfacing, and pooling not occur. The water balance analysis entails that the applied effluent will be confined to the root zone and be used by the plants or held within the soil layer with no breakthrough or seepage into the formation below. The permit prohibits irrigation when there is rainfall or wet conditions.

For any flooding concerns, members of the public may wish to contact the applicable floodplain management office. The TCEQ Resource Protection Team can aid in identifying and contacting the local floodplain administrator and can be contacted by calling 512-239-4691. Additionally, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has programs designed to mitigate damage caused by flooding.

COMMENT 6:

Individuals in [Appendix E](#) expressed concerns that the facility will affect endangered species.

RESPONSE 6:

While TCEQ rules for land application permits do not specify an endangered species impact assessment, the permit requirements are designed to protect surface water and ground water quality, which will also provide protection for wildlife including endangered species. Examples of these protective requirements include the following:

1. Appropriate effluent limits, monitoring requirements, disinfection requirements, and soil monitoring requirements;

2. Provisions that specify the suitable application rate at which the effluent and its nutrients will be taken up by the vegetation with no runoff or percolation;
3. Provisions that require the maintenance of buffer zones between the SADDs area and water bodies and water wells;
4. Proper design, operation, and maintenance of the wastewater treatment facility and effluent dispersal system;
5. Proper sewage sludge disposal; and
6. Consideration of area soil conditions, recharge features, seeps, and springs.

Other environmental protection provisions include **Permit Condition 2.d.**, which requires the applicant to “take all reasonable steps to minimize or prevent any discharge or sludge use or disposal or other permit violation which has a reasonable likelihood of adversely affecting human health or the environment.” **Permit Condition 6** prohibits the storage, processing, or disposal of hazardous waste which requires a permit or other authorization pursuant to the Texas Health and Safety Code.

COMMENT 7:

Individuals in [Appendix F](#) expressed concerns related to the TLAP site location, soil suitability, and site geology for the proposed facility.

RESPONSE 7:

TCEQ does not have the authority to mandate a different location for the wastewater irrigation fields or wastewater treatment plant if the applicant’s proposed location complies with TWC Chapter 26, 30 TAC Chapter 309, relating to “Domestic Wastewater Effluent Limitations and Plant Siting,” and 30 TAC Chapter 222, relating to “Subsurface Area Drip Dispersal Systems.” The permit application and supporting information was evaluated by Water Quality Division staff and was determined to comply with these rules. TCEQ does not have jurisdiction over zoning.

Soil and geology information is required by 30 TAC Chapter 222 to be evaluated by the applicant with reports developed and submitted to the TCEQ Water Quality Division for review. The required reports and publicly available information were evaluated by a staff agronomist and geologist in the Water Quality Division.

The soils of the proposed land application area are primarily characterized as Brackett and Doss soils. Denton, Comfort, and Real soils are also present on the site, comprising less than 10% of the total acreage. All soils within the proposed land application area have silty clay, clay, and clay loam textures that are suitable for plant growth. The applicant indicates that irrigation areas will not exceed five percent slopes. These areas, when properly vegetated and maintained as required by draft Permit **Special Provisions 14, 15, 16, and 17**, will control erosion. The soil evaluation plan per 30 TAC § 222.73 submitted by the applicant and verified on site by TCEQ personnel indicate soils on site to be approximately 30 inches in depth. Per **Special Provision 19**, the applicant is required to maintain a minimum depth of six inches of soil above the drip irrigation lines and a minimum depth of twelve inches of soil below the drip irrigation lines. In areas where this minimal requirement is not met, the Applicant is required to import soils per **Special Provision 22**. The Applicant is required to submit an imported soils plan on the incorporation of the imported soils and erosion prevention for review and possible revision and approval at least 90 days prior to construction. Irrigation effluent is not designed or expected to move beyond the soil depth. **Special Provision 23** requires the placement of soil moisture sensing monitors, in each zone, twelve inches below the drip lines. These monitors are designed to automatically shut off irrigation to that zone if the soil becomes saturated.

The site geology was evaluated by a Texas licensed professional engineer hired by the Applicant. 30 Texas Administrative Code, Chapter 222 rules require an Applicant to submit a Recharge Feature Plan report prepared by a Texas licensed professional engineer or Texas licensed professional geoscientist with the permit application. The Recharge Feature Plan (Plan) includes a description of the site-specific geology and groundwater. Additionally, this Plan: a) must document that specific sources were checked to identify known recharge features at that site, and b) requires an inspection of the site by the certifying professional to identify any recharge features. Part of the technical review of the permit application performed by Water Quality Division staff is to review the submitted Recharge Feature Plan to verify that it complies with the rules and addresses potential recharge features identified onsite. In doing this review, a staff geologist identified deficiencies in the original Plan that were subsequently remedied by the engineer, and revised application materials were received. The final Recharge Feature Plan was determined to comply with the rules.

The Executive Director has determined that the proposed site's soils and geology data were evaluated by the applicant in compliance with 30 TAC Chapter 222. As discussed previously, the draft permit contains special provisions written for this facility that address soils and groundwater protection.

COMMENT 8:

Individuals in [Appendix G](#) expressed their concerns about the proposed facility contaminating drinking water supplies.

RESPONSE 8:

As discussed in the response to Comment 3 above, the draft permit will not authorize the discharge of pollutants or wastewater to groundwater, so groundwater quality impacts are not anticipated from compliant construction and operation of the wastewater facility and associated SADDs. Private drinking water wells are not subject to TCEQ regulation. TCEQ recommends that well owners periodically test their water for microbial and chemical contaminants and properly maintain their well. Private well owners should take steps to have their water quality tested routinely. Wells should be tested more often if under the influence of nearby surface water, or if contamination is suspected. For more information on testing private water wells, please see the National Ground Water Association website at wellowner.org/resources/water-quality/water-testing. If your well tests positive for fecal coliform bacteria, please see the TCEQ publication titled [Disinfecting Your Private Well](#) (GI-432).

COMMENT 9:

Individuals in [Appendix H](#) stated that the application is missing information or data within the application is inaccurate.

RESPONSE 9:

The permit application underwent an administrative and technical review by staff in the Water Quality Division to ensure that the applicant provided all information required by state rules and the application form. Staff determined that the application met the criteria to be declared administratively complete on April 26, 2022, and was technically complete on June 15, 2022.

As provided by state law, a permittee is subject to administrative, civil and criminal penalties, as applicable, for negligently or knowingly violating the Clean Water Act, Texas Water Code §§ 26, 27, and 28, and the Texas Health and Safety Code § 361, including but not limited to knowingly making any false statement, representation, or certification on any report, record, or other document submitted or required to be maintained under the draft permit, including monitoring reports or reports of compliance or noncompliance, or falsifying, tampering with, or knowingly rendering inaccurate any monitoring device or method required by this permit or violating any other requirement imposed by state or federal regulations.¹

COMMENT 10: STUDY

Individuals in [Appendix I](#) questioned whether a thorough environmental or geological field study has been done for the proposed facility. One commenter expressed that the geological field study should be conducted by a Texas licensed professional geoscientist.

RESPONSE 10:

The requirement in 30 TAC Chapter 222 requires the applicant to submit a Recharge Feature Plan signed by a Texas licensed professional geoscientist (P.G.) or Texas licensed professional engineer (P.E.) who visits the site and thoroughly documents any recharge features present on the property. Each identified recharge feature must have a corresponding best management practice provided. The Applicant retained a Texas licensed P.E. who certified the Recharge Feature Plan on March 10, 2022. The P.E. that did the field visit did not initially identify any recharge features on the property.

On November 29, 2022, a P.G. from the Water Quality Division and other TCEQ staff briefly visited the site prior to the first public meeting. During this site visit, the TCEQ P.G. noted that there was an empty stock pond and an old above-ground cistern (for water storage) with two nearby potentially abandoned water wells present on the property that were not identified in the Recharge Feature Plan. These were shown to the P.E. that developed the Recharge Feature Plan and the TCEQ sent a Notice of Deficiency to the P.E. to have the plan revised with appropriate best management

practices provided. The revised Recharge Feature Plan was received on January 23, 2023, from the P.E. Revisions were made to the draft permit including two new special provisions. **Special Provision 34** related to plugging the abandoned water wells and **Special Provision 35** to fill in and regrade the stock tank prior to construction of the SADDs.

Per 30 TAC 213, people planning to develop a property on the Edwards Aquifer Contributing Zone are required to submit a Contributing Zone Plan. A Contributing Zone Plan addresses certain aspects of the land development including impervious cover. It does not address wastewater irrigation, treatment, or storage, as those components are authorized by a wastewater permit. Blizexas, LLC submitted a Contributing Zone Plan to the TCEQ Edwards Aquifer Protection Program on January 6, 2023 which was approved by the Executive Director on April 24, 2023.

COMMENT 11:

Individuals in [Appendix J](#) expressed concerns related to monitoring and compliance requirements of the proposed facility.

RESPONSE 11:

The Applicant is required to analyze the treated effluent prior to irrigation and to maintain monthly reports of the results of the effluent analyses and flow measurements for a minimum of three years. The Applicant may either collect and analyze the effluent samples itself, or it may contract with a third party for either or both the sampling and analysis. However, all samples must be collected and analyzed according to 30 TAC Chapter 319, Subchapter A, Monitoring and Reporting System. The Applicant is required to further notify TCEQ if the effluent does not meet the permit limits according to the requirements in the permit.

In addition, TCEQ regional staff may sample the effluent during routine inspections or in response to a complaint.

COMMENT 12:

Individuals in [Appendix K](#) expressed concerns with the treatment system and the proposed permit effluent limitations for the permit.

RESPONSE 12:

The proposed draft permit requires the Applicant to meet the design criteria requirements of 30 TAC Chapter 217 for domestic wastewater treatment plants prior to construction of the facility. Specifically, **Special Provision 4** of the proposed draft permit requires the Applicant to clearly show how the treatment system will meet the permitted effluent limitations of the proposed draft permit. The proposed draft permit requires the Applicant to submit to the TCEQ Wastewater Permitting Section a summary submittal letter for the design criteria according to 30 TAC § 217.6(d), prior to construction of the wastewater treatment facility. The summary letter must be signed and sealed by a Texas licensed professional engineer. If requested by the TCEQ Wastewater Permitting Section, the Applicant must submit plans, specifications, and a final engineering design report that comply with 30 TAC, Chapter 217, Design Criteria for Wastewater Systems.

The proposed treatment process involves an activated sludge process plant using the conventional mode, as described in Section I.A, [*Description of Facility*](#). The Applicant shall clearly show how the treatment system will meet the permitted effluent limitations required on Page 2 of the draft permit.² The Executive Director's staff will ensure that the plant design can adequately treat the domestic wastewater in accordance with the effluent limitations in the proposed permit during the review of the plans and specifications for this facility.

The effluent limits in the proposed draft permit are those established in 30 TAC 309.4 (Table 1) "Effluent Limitations for Domestic Wastewater Treatment Plants" for land treatment application when the effluent will be disposed by irrigation via a subsurface area drip dispersal system (SADDs). These effluent limits require the use of a secondary level wastewater treatment system. The Applicant is proposing to use a tertiary level wastewater treatment filtration system which exceeds the secondary treatment system requirement.

30 TAC § 309.4 outlines limitations for SADDs permits with public exposure or public access. The rule provides for an effluent limitation set of 20 mg/l BOD₅, and 20 mg/l TSS. In this case, the Applicant proposed an effluent set of 10 mg/l BOD₅, and 15

mg/l TSS, which is more stringent than the rule requirement. The draft permit includes the more stringent effluent set. Additionally, the rule requires a bacteria limit of 126 CFU or MPN per 100 ml which ensures the disinfection system is working properly before distribution to the system.

COMMENT 13:

Lawrence and Helen Foster stated the permit does not adequately describe the location of the injection well.

RESPONSE 13:

SADDs are classified as Class V injection wells per 30 TAC 331.11 (a)(4)(P). 30 TAC 331.7(c) requires that an Applicant for a SADDs obtain a wastewater permit and submit inventory information to the TCEQ's Underground Injection Control program. The Water Quality Division domestic permit application forms for SADDs require applicants to complete Worksheet 7.0 and submit it to the TCEQ's Underground Injection Control program for the purposes of inventorying SADDs in its Class V injection program. According to the TCEQ's Underground Injection Control program, the Underground Injection Control permit SW1200017 that is associated with this site is the number assigned to the proposed SADDs system for inventory purposes. The SADDs would be permitted under the pending TPDES No. WQ0016111001, which, if issued, would not allow the discharge of wastewater beyond 48 inches below the ground surface (or the grass root zone).

COMMENT 14: REGIONALIZATION

Individuals in [Appendix M](#) expressed concerns about whether the draft permit complies with TCEQ's regionalization policy.

RESPONSE 14:

Texas Water Code § 26.081 enumerates the state's regionalization policy. Section 26.081 states that the policy should "encourage and promote the development and use of regional and area-wide waste collection, treatment, and disposal systems to serve the waste disposal needs of the citizens of the state and to prevent pollution and maintain and enhance the quality of the water in the state." In furtherance of that policy TWC § 26.0282 authorizes TCEQ, when considering the issuance of a permit to

discharge waste, to deny or alter the terms and conditions of a proposed permit based on need and the availability of existing or proposed area-wide or regional waste collection, treatment, and disposal systems.

Domestic Technical Report 1.1 of the application requires information concerning regionalization of wastewater treatment plants.³ Applicants requesting a new permit or certain major amendments are required to review a three-mile area surrounding the proposed facility to determine if there is a wastewater treatment plant or sewer collection lines within the area that the Applicant can utilize. Applicants are required to contact those facilities to inquire if they currently have the capacity or are willing to expand to accept the volume of wastewater proposed. If an existing wastewater facility does have the capacity and is willing to accept the proposed wastewater, the applicant must submit an analysis of expenditures required to connect to a permitted wastewater treatment facility or collection system located within three miles versus the cost of the proposed facility or expansion. Finally, applicants are required to provide copies of all correspondence with the owners of existing plants within three miles of the proposed plant regarding regionalization with their system.

There are existing wastewater treatment facilities or collection systems within a three-mile radius of the proposed facility site location. The applicant has submitted mail receipts dated October 19, 2021, to the existing facilities with Permit No. WQ0014664001 - Travis County MUD 16 and WQ0014587001 - Headwaters MUD. No responses were received to accept the proposed wastewater volume prior to submittal of the application to the TCEQ. The applicant was contacted via email on January 13, 2025, to see if any responses were received from Travis County MUD 16 or Headwaters MUD. No response was received to date based on the response from the applicant received on January 13, 2025, therefore nothing changes from our initial review for the regionalization review of this permit application.

COMMENT 15: PUBLIC NOTICE

Individuals in [Appendix N](#) expressed concerns regarding public notice and participation in the permit application process.

RESPONSE 15:

There were two public notices regarding this permit action, the Notice of Receipt of Application and Intent to Obtain a Wastewater Permit (NORI) and the Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision (NAPD). TCEQ's notice rules require applicants to provide public notices for wastewater permits by publishing the NORI in a "newspaper of largest circulation in the county in which the facility is located or proposed to be located ... if the facility is located or proposed to be located in a municipality, the applicant [must] publish notice in any newspaper of general circulation in the municipality."⁴ After the Office of the Chief Clerk has mailed the preliminary decision and the NAPD to the applicant, they are required to publish the NAPD "at least once in a newspaper regularly published or circulated within each county where the proposed facility or discharge is located and in each county affected by the discharge."⁵

TCEQ's notice rules for a new permit or major amendment require mailed notice of the NORI and NAPD to landowners named on the application map and persons on the mailing list maintained by the Office of the Chief Clerk.⁶ The applicant is required to submit a landowner map as part of the application materials. The landowner map for applications to use land disposal of the effluent must include the property boundaries of landowners surrounding the Applicant's property, location of all effluent holding/storage/evaporation lagoons, and property boundaries of the disposal sites. Any persons who submit a comment or contested case hearing request prior to the end of the public comment period are added to the mailing list for that permit action.

In accordance with TCEQ's notice rules published public notices are described in Section I. B [Procedural Background](#) of this Response. The public comment period for WQ001611101 began upon mailed and published notice of NORI which occurred in May 2022. The public comment period remained open until the close of the second public meeting that occurred January 29, 2024.

COMMENT 16:

Individuals in [Appendix O](#) expressed concern that the facility will impact property values, tourism and the local economy.

RESPONSE 16:

The water quality permitting process is limited to controlling the discharge of pollutants into or adjacent to water in the state and protecting the water quality of the state's rivers, lakes, and coastal waters. TCEQ does not have the authority to address concerns about the impact of the facility on the economy, businesses, tourism, or resale of homes as part of the wastewater permitting process. The scope of the TCEQ's regulatory jurisdiction does not affect or limit the ability of a landowner to seek relief from a court in response to activities that interfere with the landowner's use and enjoyment of his or her property. Additionally, the permit does not limit the ability of an individual to seek legal remedies against the Applicant regarding any potential trespass, nuisance, or other causes of action in response to activities that may result in injury to human health or property or that may interfere with the normal use and enjoyment of property.

COMMENT 17:

Individuals in [Appendix P](#) expressed general opposition and concerns about traffic, noise, light pollution, air pollution, and the amount of impervious cover at the proposed development.

RESPONSE 17:

TCEQ does not have the authority to address these types of issues as part of the wastewater permitting process. TWC Chapter 26 and applicable wastewater regulations do not authorize TCEQ to consider issues resulting from the development such as traffic, noise, light pollution, air pollution and impervious cover. The construction process of the development may be subject to stormwater construction permitting, authorized by a separate process.

The permit does not limit the ability of an individual to seek legal remedies against the Applicant regarding any potential trespass, nuisance, or other causes of action in response to activities that may result in injury to human health or property

or that may interfere with the normal use and enjoyment of property. For concerns, please contact local law enforcement or the Hays County Sheriff's Office at 512-393-7800 to inquire if there are ordinances in your area.

COMMENT 18:

Mark Leonard Lebovitz expressed support for the proposed draft permit.

RESPONSE 18

The ED acknowledges these comments.

III. CHANGES MADE TO THE DRAFT PERMIT IN RESPONSE TO COMMENTS

In response to Public Comments and additional technical reviews, the Executive Director has made the following changes to the draft permit:

1. The Applicant was required to move two of the proposed SADDs fields to maintain a 100-foot buffer setback from a roadside ditch on Fitzhugh Road. Additionally, the applicant agreed to move the northern two SADDs fields 25 feet from the property boundary.

As a result of the changes made to the application materials, the following changes were made to the draft permit:

1. Special Provision 34 requiring that the applicant plug any onsite abandoned water wells in accordance with 16 TAC 76 and supply copies of the plugging reports to TCEQ.
2. Special Provision 35 requiring the applicant to fill in and regrade an existing onsite stock tank prior to construction of the SADDs fields.

3. Special Provision 36 requiring a 25-foot setback between the edge of the SADDs fields and the northern property boundary where no wastewater irrigation will occur.
4. Special Provision 9 requiring the Groundwater and Seeps/Springs Monitoring Plan to require the installation of a minimum of seven suction lysimeters to sample any soil water present outside of the SADDs fields quarterly and test that water for several water quality parameters including: nitrate-nitrogen, Total Kjeldahl nitrogen, ammonia-nitrogen, total phosphorous, ortho-phosphate, chlorides, fecal coliform, and specific conductivity.
5. In the treatment process portion of the draft permit cover page and Technical Summary, the equalization basins were added per request by the Applicant.

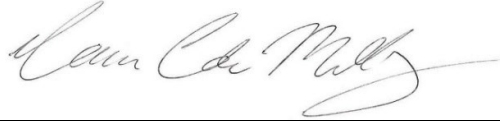
