My property is located approximately .07 miles from the intersection of County Road 1226 and County Road 1121 (Woodard Ave) and the Northwest corner of the property that the facilities will service.

Specific Description of how you would be adversely affected by the facility in a way not common to the general public:

My property would be directly affected by the smell of the facility and would directly affect my property value now and in the coming years.

While wastewater treatment plants are typically placed in low-lying areas, the proposed location for this facility is within a flood plain. This facility is not planned to be run by a professional company(ies) but rather by a Homeowners association (HOA). While the understanding is that the HOA is required to have a licensed technician to run the facility, HOAs do not always have the funding to maintain the facility as needed or see wastewater treatment facilities as a priority on financial responsibilities. Along with the financial means for the wastewater treatment facilities, does the HOA have a plan (master plan) for the facility to replace the infrastructure at the typical useful span of a small wastewater facility (typically 10 years)? Should TCEQ allow the wastewater treatment facility to be approved without the ability to maintain the facility well beyond 10-20-40 years, is poor planning for the residences that the facility would serve and the neighborhood that the facility would affect.

A heavy rainy season, much like the one we have experienced, will create issues that in a 90-degree day with high humidity and a summer south wind (typical early summer Texas weather) would leave the neighborhood flooded with waste hazards and in a stench.

Johnson County does not have maintenance or responsibility for private wastewater treatment facilities. However, the County does have policies and rules on private septic systems which require property owners to be responsible. Leaving private septic systems, a better choice for the neighborhood.

I do have an invested concern that the wastewater facility would have on my property value. My neighborhood and I have worked very hard to have, upkeep, and maintain our homes and property. Not only would the smell and flooding from the wastewater treatment facility decrease my property value but hinder the financial investment that I have worked so hard to achieve.

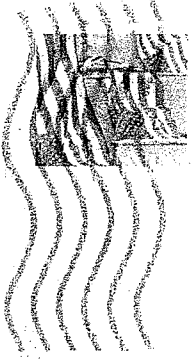

This allows for the absorption of the water. Changing this will only make my problem worse.

We asked about the smell at the public hearing. They stated a % numbers about a west wind that was like 15% of the time. A west wind goes directly to my home. This means we will have to deal with the aroma several days a month. Nobody at the hearing would tell us that the plant would not smell. At another hearing I went to about a proposed plant, the expert representing the facility said, "it smells like money to me". I have enclosed a copy of an article about a plant that the city of Ft. Worth is taking over because of the smell of solid waste. Being only 1/4 mile from this plant this is a great concern. We are not in any City Limits and will have no one other than the planned neighbor hood association they said will assume operations of the plant to hold responsible.

Just like at my home, water run off is a problem. I have seen the sight where this is proposed underwater several times. To quote Johnson County Commissioner Larry Wooley, "this facility is a train wreck waiting to happen". US HWY 67 that runs directly in front of this plant has had water over it deep enough to cover the guard rails. That water runs straight across into the area of the proposed facility. This problem will be much worse due to the building of 400 more homes in the area.

As I write this letter Johnson County is trying to declare an emergency due to PFAS. Biosolids represent an incredible risk to my place. If this facility floods, (and it will), there is no way for me to recover. The builders of this project will have sold and long gone.

I kindly ask that you reconsider this facility. Ask any of the county commissioners and they will tell you that this will be a huge problem due to the amount of water that will run off to this facility. Anyone living around here will tell you the same.

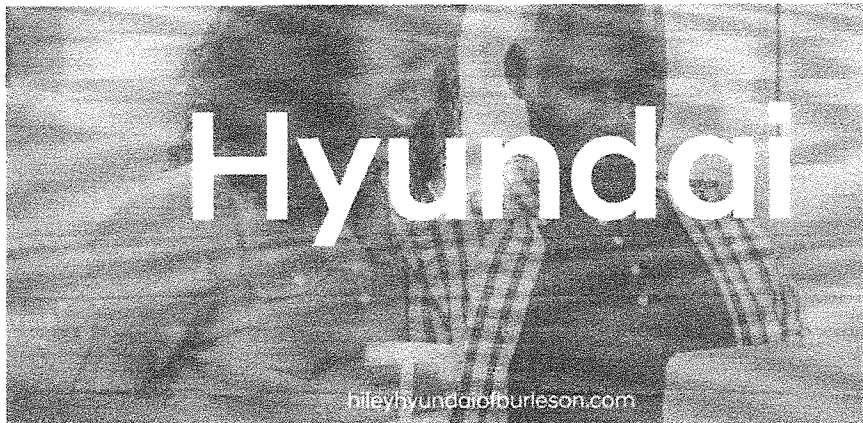
## Fort Worth water utility to take over operations at biosolids plant blamed for foul smell, dead livestock

Fort Worth councilmembers formally ended the city's contract with Synagro Tuesday. The water utility will assume control of the plant on April 5.

FORT WORTH, Texas — The Fort Worth water utility will soon take control of operations at the biosolids plant blamed for foul smells and dead livestock.

Without discussion, city council voted Tuesday to end its contract with plant operator Synagro four years early. The city will pay Synagro \$2.4 million for past operations and maintenance costs, a settlement designed to prevent future lawsuits.

Fort Worth officials said the two sides agreed to end the partnership after "disagreements regarding contract requirements arose between the city and Synagro." It's not clear what the parties dispute, but the plant is at center of a high-profile lawsuit involving farmers in nearby Johnson County.

Fort Worth initially enlisted Synagro to design, build, operate and maintain the plant in 2019. As part of the deal, Synagro would draw treated wastewater from the adjacent Village Creek Water Reclamation facility, dry out the disinfected sludge, and convert the byproduct into nutrient-rich fertilizer pellets.

Such operations began in 2022. Then, city and state officials celebrated the project as "cutting edge."

But people who live near the plant complain about the dead-fish scent that emanates from the area, especially when the wind blows north toward Hurst.

Farmers who purchased the fertilizer say it killed their livestock.

At least five farmers from Johnson County are now suing Synagro, alleging the pellets contain highly-concentrated amounts of forever chemicals.

These chemicals, technically nicknamed "PFAS," do not break down naturally in the environment. The accumulation of such chemicals in the human body increases a person's risk of developing certain cancers and fertility issues, according to peer-reviewed scientific studies cited by the Environmental Protection Agency.

A Johnson County environmental investigator tested a stillborn calf's liver and found forever chemicals roughly 150,000 times the amount the EPA considers safe for drinking water.

"It destroys families," said Luanne Langley, a Johnson County resident who testified before Fort Worth's city council Tuesday. "Once a farmer or rancher finds out their land is contaminated - that's their livelihood. It's gone. You can't sell those cows because you can't eat them."

Synagro denies responsibility and said its own testing proves the product is safe.

Fort Worth's water utility will assume control of the plant on April 5. It will execute operations and maintenance contracts to support transition, a city spokesperson said.

Langley said she hopes the plant's future operators will more stringently test for PFAS and take steps to prevent their release into the environment.

The land the proposed facility is to be built floods and drains into creeks and ponds that ultimately lead to our creek as well as Lake Pat which is the drinking water for most of Cleburne, TX. The proposed facility is located only 3 miles from Lake Pat and could contaminate the public drinking water supply. See the attached map showing this! Wildlife will also be negatively affected through loss of land and possible water contamination.

If the facility is built along with the other plans, it will cause massive flooding of the surrounding properties and areas including the roads we need to drive on to drive into Cleburne. All residents in the area that own 150 ft of road frontage have the option of getting county water so a facility like this is not needed. All the lands surrounding this area are on septic and wells, even other small subdivisions. A facility like this will negatively affect our quality of life. We bought this land to live peacefully in the country, not be near a wastewater facility. The area is already having water issues which can be confirmed by the Johnson County Public Works Director and our County Commissioner Rick Bailey.

We, along with all area residents have NO RECOURSE or REIMBURSEMENT for our wells if they are contaminated, for our cattle if they get sick or die, for our loss of peace and country atmosphere, or for the smell and loss of property values if this facility is allowed to be built.
