The proposed permit from Raptor Ready Mix Hyde Ranch SN 7593 would impact a significant number of residents within House District 99. The Application for Permit 177217L002 seeks to establish a concrete batch plant on the west side of Silver Creek Road in close proximity to single family homes and Brewer High School in Fort Worth, Texas. I am concerned about the detrimental impact in quality of life from the proposed concrete batch plant. For these reasons I oppose the application from Raptor Ready Mix Inc.

I therefore respectfully request a public meeting for the benefit of current and future residents of Tarrant County and the State of Texas. Public meetings are critical for hearing all sides. The robust participation of the public – affected landowners and others – helps ensure that, as Texas grows, it does so with respect for its existing residents of the State.
