Dear Chief Clerk:

On behalf of Park Environmental Equipment, LLC (“Applicant”), we submit this response to the requests for public meeting and contested case hearing (“CCH”) filed in connection with the above-referenced air permit renewal application.

## **II. Background**

The Applicant submitted an application to renew Air Permit No. 79400 for an existing concrete batch plant located in Houston, Harris County, Texas. The application seeks authorization to continue operations under the existing standard permit and does not propose any changes that would result in an increase in allowable emissions or the emission of any new air contaminants.

## **II. Applicable Law**

As acknowledged in the Executive Director’s Response to Public Comment, this application is a renewal that does not result in an increase in allowable emissions.

Under Texas Health and Safety Code § 382.056(g), the Commission may not hold a public meeting for renewal that does not result in an increase in allowable emissions or the emission of new air contaminants. Similarly, pursuant to 30 TAC § 55.201(i), a renewal of this nature does not provide for a contested case hearing.

While THSC § 382.056(o) allows the Commission discretion to hold a hearing in limited circumstances involving an unsatisfactory compliance history, that circumstance is not present here.

## **III. Compliance History**

The compliance history for both the site and the company reflects a rating of 0.00 with a classification of “Unclassified.” Accordingly, there is no indication of an unsatisfactory compliance history that would support the discretionary grant of a hearing.

#### **IV. Consideration of Hearing Requests**

Given that this is a renewal with no increase in emissions and no new air contaminants, the applicable statutory framework does not provide for a public meeting or contested case hearing in this instance.

Consistent with this framework, and as reflected in the Executive Director's analysis, the Applicant understands that further evaluation of the individual hearing requests is not necessary.

#### **V. Conclusion**

The Applicant respectfully supports the Executive Director's recommendation and appreciates the Commission's consideration of this matter.
