

TPC Group LLC, 8600 Park Place Boulevard, Houston, Texas 77017-2513, ha solicitado a la Comisión de Calidad Ambiental de Texas (TCEQ) para una enmienda a los Permisos Estatales de Calidad de Aire 22052, 46307, 46426 y 19806, emisión de Prevención de Deterioro Significativo (PSD) Calidad de Aire PSDTX1578, PSDTX1580, PSDTX999M1 y PSDTX1586, emisión de Números de Permiso de Incumplimiento N290, N286, and N288 y la emisión de Gases de Efecto (GHG) PSD Permisos de Calidad del Aire GHGPSDTX201, GHGPSDTX202, and GHGPSDTX203 para la emisión de GHGs, el cual autoriza la autorización la modificación de Houston Plant ubicado en 8600 Park Place Boulevard, Houston, Condado de Harris, Texas 77017. Como cortesía pública, hemos proporcionado la siguiente página web a un mapa en línea del sitio o la ubicación general de la instalación. Esta solicitud se está procesando en una manera acelerada, como permitido por las normas de la comisión en el Título 30 (TAC), Capítulo 101, Subcapítulo J, Código Administrativo de Texas (30 Texas Administrative Code, Chapter 101, Subchapter J). La instalación existente emitirá los siguientes contaminantes en una cantidad significativa para requerir una Revisión de Incumplimiento: compuestos orgánicos. La instalación emitirá los siguientes contaminantes del aire en una cantidad significativa: material particulado que incluye material particulado con diámetros de 10 micras o menos y 2.5 micras o menos. Además, la instalación emitirá: monóxido de carbono, compuestos orgánicos, óxidos de nitrógeno, contaminantes atmosféricos peligrosos y dióxido de azufre. De esta instalación no resultará ningún otro aumento de emisiones contaminantes.

Los resultados del modelo del análisis de minimis indican que todos los contaminantes y los tiempos promedio no exceden las concentraciones de minimis respectivas y no requieren análisis de incremento de PSD.

El Director Ejecutivo ha determinado que las emisiones de contaminantes del aire de la instalación existente que están sujetas a la revisión del PSD no violarán ninguna regulación estatal o federal de calidad del aire y no tendrán ningún impacto adverso significativo en los suelos, la vegetación o la visibilidad. Se han evaluado todos los contaminantes del aire y se utilizará la "mejor tecnología de control disponible" para el control de estos contaminantes.

El Condado de Harris ha sido designado como incumplimiento para el ozono porque las Estaciones de Monitoreo Continuo del Aire Ambiental han demostrado que las concentraciones ambientales de ozono exceden los Estándares Nacionales de Calidad del Aire Ambiental (NAAQS) para el ozono. El ozono troposférico no se emite directamente al aire, sino que se crea mediante reacciones químicas entre los óxidos de nitrógeno (NOX) y los compuestos orgánicos volátiles (COV). La Ley Federal de Aire Limpio (FCAA, por sus siglas en inglés) requiere que las nuevas fuentes estacionarias principales y las modificaciones importantes en las fuentes en áreas designadas de incumplimiento deben cumplir con la revisión de nuevas fuentes de incumplimiento antes del comienzo de la construcción.

Según lo requerido por la revisión de incumplimiento, se evaluaron todos los contaminantes del aire y se abordó la "tasa de emisión más baja posible" para el control de estos contaminantes. Los aumentos de emisiones de este proyecto se compensarán con reducciones de emisiones en una proporción de 1.2 a 1. Además, el solicitante ha demostrado que los beneficios de la instalación existente superan significativamente los costos ambientales y sociales impuestos como resultado de su ubicación, construcción o modificación. Finalmente, el solicitante ha certificado que todas las principales fuentes estacionarias de propiedad u operadas por el solicitante en el estado cumplen o están programadas para cumplir con todas las limitaciones y normas de emisión estatales y federales aplicables. El Director Ejecutivo, por lo tanto, ha tomado la determinación preliminar de emitir este permiso.

El Director Ejecutivo de la TCEQ ha preparado un borrador del permiso, el cual, si es aprobado, establecería las condiciones bajo las cuales la instalación debe operar. 

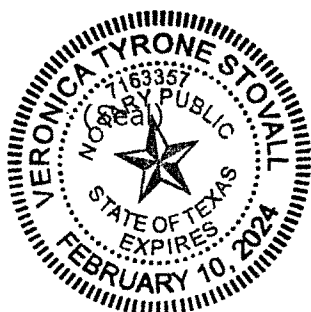

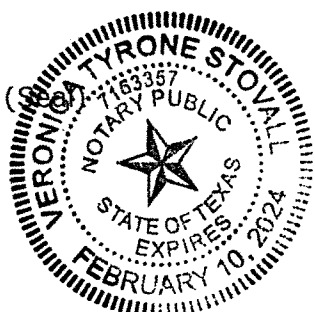

APPLICATION.

TPC Group LLC, 8600 Park Place Boulevard, Houston, Texas 77017-2513, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for an amendment to State Air Quality Permits 22052, 46307, 46426, and 19806, issuance of Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) Air Quality Permits PSDTX1578, PSDTX1580, PSDTX999M1, and PSDTX1586, issuance of Nonattainment Permit Numbers N290, N286, and N288, and issuance of Greenhouse Gas (GHG) PSD Air Quality Permits GHGPSDTX201, GHGPSDTX202, and GHGPSDTX203 for emissions of GHGs, which would authorize modification of the Houston Plant located at 8600 Park Place Boulevard, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77017. As a public courtesy, we have provided the following Web page to an online map of the site or the facility's general location. This application was processed in an expedited manner, as allowed by the commission's rules in 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC), Chapter 101, Subchapter J. The existing facility will emit the following air contaminants in a significant amount to require a Nonattainment Review: organic compounds. The facility will emit the following air contaminants in a significant amount: particulate matter including particulate matter with diameters of 10 microns or less and 2.5 microns or less. In addition, the facility will emit: carbon monoxide, organic compounds, nitrogen oxides, hazardous air pollutants, and sulfur dioxide. No other pollutant emission increase will result from this facility.

The De Minimis analysis modeling results indicate that all pollutants and averaging times do not exceed the respective de minimis concentrations and do not require PSD increment analyses.

The Executive Director has determined that the emissions of air contaminants from the existing facility which are subject to PSD review will not violate any state or federal air quality regulations and will not have any significant adverse impact on soils, vegetation, or visibility. All air contaminants have been evaluated, and "best available control technology" will be used for the control of these contaminants.

Harris County has been designated nonattainment for ozone because Continuous Ambient Air Monitoring Stations have shown that ambient concentrations of ozone exceed the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) for ozone. Ground-level ozone is not emitted directly into the air, but is created by chemical reactions between nitrogen oxides (NOX) and volatile organic compounds (VOC). The Federal Clean Air Act (FCAA) requires that new major stationary sources and major modifications at sources in designated nonattainment areas must satisfy nonattainment new source review prior to commencement of construction.

As required by the nonattainment review, all air contaminants have been evaluated and the "lowest achievable emission rate" has been addressed for the control of these contaminants. The emission increases from this project will be offset with emission reductions by a ratio of 1.2 to 1. Furthermore, the applicant has demonstrated that the benefits of the existing facility significantly outweigh the environmental and social costs imposed as a result of its location, construction, or modification. Finally, the applicant has certified that all major stationary sources owned or operated by the applicant in the state are in compliance or on a schedule for compliance with all applicable state and federal emission limitations and standards. The Executive Director, therefore, has made the preliminary determination to issue this permit.

The TCEQ Executive Director has prepared a draft permit which, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The permit application, executive director's preliminary decision, draft permit, and the executive director's preliminary determination summary and executive director's air quality analysis, are available for viewing and copying at the TCEQ central office, the TCEQ Houston regional office, and online at <https://www.publicnotice.texas.gov/TCP%20DH2%20Amendment%20Application%20Public%20Notice.pdf>. The facility's compliance file, if any exists, is available for public review at the TCEQ Houston Regional Office, 5425 Polk Street Suite H, Houston, Texas.

DIRECT REFERRAL.

The Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision was published on May 12, 2021. On November 1, 2021, the Applicant filed a request for direct referral to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH). Therefore, the chief clerk has referred this application directly to SOAH for a hearing on whether the application complies with all applicable statutory and regulatory requirements.

CONTESTED CASE HEARING.

Considering directives to protect public health, the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) will conduct a preliminary hearing via Zoom videoconference. A Zoom meeting is a secure, free meeting held over the internet that allows video, audio, or audio/video conferencing.

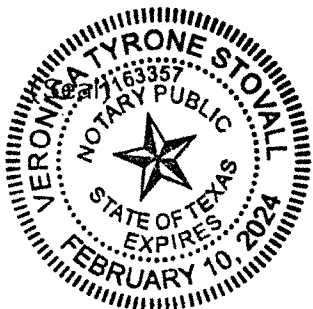

SOLICITUD.

TPC Group LLC, 8600 Park Place Boulevard, Houston, Texas 77017-2513, ha solicitado a la Comisión de Calidad Ambiental de Texas (TCEQ, por sus siglas en inglés) una modificación de los Permisos Estatales de Calidad del Aire 22052, 46307, 46426 y 19806, la expedición de los Permisos de Calidad del Aire de Prevención del Deterioro Significativo (PSD, por sus siglas en inglés) PSDTX1578, PSDTX1580, PSDTX999M1 y PSDTX1586, la emisión de los Permisos de Incumplimiento N290, N286 y N288, y la emisión de los Permisos de Calidad del Aire PSD de Gases de Efecto Invernadero (GHG, por sus siglas en inglés) GHGPSDTX201, GHGPSDTX202 y GHGPSDTX203 para las emisiones de GHG, que autorizarían la modificación de la Planta de Houston ubicada en el 8600 Park Place Boulevard, Houston, Condado de Harris, Texas 77017. Como cortesía pública, hemos proporcionado la siguiente página web que lo dirige a un mapa en línea del sitio o la ubicación general de la instalación. Para conocer la ubicación exacta, consulte la solicitud. Esta solicitud se ha tramitado de forma acelerada, tal y como permiten las normas de la comisión en el Código Administrativo 30 del Estado de Texas (TAC, por sus siglas en inglés), capítulo 101, Subcapítulo J. La instalación existente emitirá los siguientes contaminantes atmosféricos en una cantidad significativa que requiere una revisión de incumplimiento: compuestos orgánicos. La instalación emitirá los siguientes contaminantes atmosféricos en una cantidad significativa: materia particulada, incluida la materia particulada con diámetros de 10 micrones o menos y de 2.5 micrones o menos. Además, la instalación emitirá: monóxido de carbono, compuestos orgánicos, óxidos de nitrógeno, contaminantes atmosféricos peligrosos y dióxido de azufre. No se producirá ningún otro aumento en las emisiones contaminantes de esta instalación.

Los resultados de la modelización del análisis De Minimis indican que todos los contaminantes y tiempos de promedio no superan las respectivas concentraciones de minimis y no requieren análisis de incremento del PSD.

El Director Ejecutivo ha determinado que las emisiones de contaminantes atmosféricos de la instalación existente que están sujetas a la revisión de la PSD no infringirán ninguna normativa estatal o federal sobre calidad del aire y no tendrán ningún impacto adverso significativo en los suelos, la vegetación o la visibilidad. Se han evaluado todos los contaminantes del aire y se utilizará la "mejor tecnología de control disponible" para el control de estos contaminantes.

El condado de Harris ha sido designado como zona de incumplimiento para el ozono porque las estaciones de control continuo del aire ambiente han demostrado que las concentraciones de ozono en el ambiente superan las Normas Nacionales de Calidad del Aire Ambiental (NAAQS, por sus siglas en inglés) para el ozono. El ozono a nivel del suelo no se emite directamente al aire, sino que se crea mediante reacciones químicas entre los óxidos de nitrógeno (NOX, por sus siglas en inglés) y los compuestos orgánicos volátiles (COV, por sus siglas en inglés). La Ley Federal de Aire Limpio (FCAA, por sus siglas en inglés) exige que las nuevas fuentes estacionarias importantes y las modificaciones importantes de las fuentes situadas en las zonas de incumplimiento deben cumplir la revisión de nuevas fuentes de incumplimiento antes de iniciar la construcción.

Tal como exige la revisión de incumplimiento, se han evaluado todos los contaminantes del aire y se ha abordado la cuestión del "índice de emisión más bajo posible" para el control de estos contaminantes. El aumento de las emisiones de este proyecto se compensará con la reducción de las mismas en una proporción de 1.2 a 1. Además, el solicitante ha demostrado que los beneficios de la instalación existente superan significativamente los costes ambientales y sociales impuestos como resultado de su ubicación, construcción o modificación. Por último, el solicitante ha certificado que todas las fuentes estacionarias importantes que posee u opera en el estado cumplen o tienen un calendario de cumplimiento de todas las limitaciones y normas de emisiones estatales y federales aplicables. Por lo tanto, el Director Ejecutivo ha tomado la determinación preliminar de emitir este permiso.

El Director Ejecutivo de la TCEQ ha preparado un proyecto de permiso que, de ser aprobado, establecería las condiciones bajo las cuales debe operar la instalación. La solicitud de permiso, la decisión preliminar del director ejecutivo, el borrador de permiso, y el resumen de la determinación preliminar del director ejecutivo y el análisis de la calidad del aire del director ejecutivo, están disponibles para ver y copiar en la oficina central de la TCEQ, la oficina regional de la TCEQ en Houston, y en línea en <https://www.publicnotice.live/TPC%20DH%20Amendment%20Application%20Public%20Notice.pdf>. 
If you do not comply with all requirements described in the instructions, further processing of your application may be suspended or the commission may take other actions.

APPLICATION.

TPC Group LLC, 8600 Park Place Boulevard, Houston, Texas 77017-2513, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for an amendment to State Air Quality Permits 22052, 46307, 46426, and 19806, issuance of Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) Air Quality Permits PSDTX1578, PSDTX1580, PSDTX999M1, and PSDTX1586, issuance of Nonattainment Permit Numbers N290, N286, and N288, and issuance of Greenhouse Gas (GHG) PSD Air Quality Permits GHGPSDTX201, GHGPSDTX202, and GHGPSDTX203 for emissions of GHGs, which would authorize modification of the Houston Plant located at 8600 Park Place Boulevard, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77017. This application was processed in an expedited manner, as allowed by the commission's rules in 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC), Chapter 101, Subchapter J. The existing facility will emit the following air contaminants in a significant amount to require a Nonattainment Review: organic compounds. The facility will emit the following air contaminants in a significant amount: particulate matter including particulate matter with diameters of 10 microns or less and 2.5 microns or less. In addition, the facility will emit: carbon monoxide, organic compounds, nitrogen oxides, hazardous air pollutants, and sulfur dioxide. No other pollutant emission increase will result from this facility.

The De Minimis analysis modeling results indicate that all pollutants and averaging times do not exceed the respective de minimis concentrations and do not require PSD increment analyses.

The Executive Director has determined that the emissions of air contaminants from the existing facility which are subject to PSD review will not violate any state or federal air quality regulations and will not have any significant adverse impact on soils, vegetation, or visibility. All air contaminants have been evaluated, and “best available control technology” will be used for the control of these contaminants.

Harris County has been designated nonattainment for ozone because Continuous Ambient Air Monitoring Stations have shown that ambient concentrations of ozone exceed the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) for ozone. Ground-level ozone is not emitted directly into the air, but is created by chemical reactions between nitrogen oxides (NOX) and volatile organic compounds (VOC). The Federal Clean Air Act (FCAA) requires that new major stationary sources and major modifications at sources in designated nonattainment areas must satisfy nonattainment new source review prior to commencement of construction.

As required by the nonattainment review, all air contaminants have been evaluated and the “lowest achievable emission rate” has been addressed for the control of these contaminants. The emission increases from this project will be offset with emission reductions by a ratio of 1.2 to 1. Furthermore, the applicant has demonstrated that the benefits of the existing facility significantly outweigh the environmental and social costs imposed as a result of its location, construction, or modification. Finally, the applicant has certified that all major stationary sources owned or operated by the applicant in the state are in compliance or on a schedule for compliance with all applicable state and federal emission limitations and standards. The Executive Director, therefore, has made the preliminary determination to issue this permit.

The TCEQ Executive Director has prepared a draft permit which, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The permit application, executive director’s preliminary decision, draft permit, and the executive director’s preliminary determination summary and executive director’s air quality analysis, are available for viewing and copying at the TCEQ central office, the TCEQ Houston regional office, and online at <https://www.publicnotice.live/TPC%20DH2%20Amendment%20Application%20Public%20Notice.pdf>. The facility’s compliance file, if any exists, is available for public review at the TCEQ Houston Regional Office, 5425 Polk Street Suite H, Houston, Texas.

DIRECT REFERRAL.

The Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision was published on May 12, 2021. On November 1, 2021, the Applicant filed a request for direct referral to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH). Therefore, the chief clerk has referred this application directly to SOAH for a hearing on whether the application complies with all applicable statutory and regulatory requirements.

CONTESTED CASE HEARING.

Considering directives to protect public health, the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) will conduct a preliminary hearing via Zoom videoconference. A Zoom meeting is a secure, free meeting held over the internet that allows video, audio, or audio/video conferencing.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with the Chapter 2001, Texas Government Code; Chapter 382, Texas Health and Safety Code; TCEQ rules including 30 TAC Chapter 116, Subchapters A and B; and the procedural rules of the TCEQ and SOAH, including 30 TAC Chapter 80 and 1 TAC Chapter 155.

To request to be a party, you must attend the hearing and show you would be affected by the application in a way not common to the general public. Any person may attend the hearing and request to be a party. Only persons named as parties may participate at the hearing.



NOTICE OF HEARING

A hearing was requested on issues related to your application and the Commission granted this request. The matter has been referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings. Now you must comply with the following instructions:

Please Review Notice

We have included in the notice all of the information which we believe is necessary. Please read it carefully and notify us immediately if it contains any errors or omissions. You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information published. You may not change the text of the notice or affidavit of publication without prior approval from the TCEQ.

Newspaper Notice

- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Hearing no less than **30** days before the hearing.
- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Hearing (Example A) at your expense, in the public notice section of a newspaper that is of general circulation in the municipality in which the facility is located or proposed to be located or in the municipality nearest to the location or proposed location of the facility.
- Example B must be published in the **same issue** of the newspaper as Example A; however, it must be published in a prominent location (other than the public notice section). Example B notice refers the public to the "public notice" section of the newspaper where Example A provides more information regarding the permit application.

- Example B must be a total of at least **6 column inches (standard advertising units)** with a vertical dimension of at least **3 inches** and a horizontal dimension of **2 column widths**. If the newspaper chosen does not use standard advertising units for measurement, the notice must be at least **12 square inches** with the shortest side of at least **3 inches**.

If you choose to submit a copy of the published notice to the Office of the Chief Clerk, the copy must be on standard-size 8½" x 11" paper and must show the actual size of the published notice (do not reduce the image when making copies). - You must furnish a copy of the notices and affidavits to the EPA regional administrator in Dallas, all local air pollution control agencies with jurisdiction in the county in which the construction is to occur; and the air pollution control agency of any nearby state in which air quality may be adversely affected by the emissions from the new or modified facility.

You must meet all publication requirements. **If you fail to publish the notice or submit proof of publication on time, then** the TCEQ may suspend further processing on your application or take other actions.
