As you know, the Chief Clerk's Office has referred this matter over to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a contested case hearing on your application.

SOAH will conduct a preliminary hearing via Zoom video conference at:

10:00 a.m. – May 2, 2022

You are now required to publish notice for this hearing. To help you meet the requirements associated with this notice, we have enclosed the following items:


If you do not comply with all requirements described in the instructions, further processing of your application may be suspended or the commission may take other actions.

As required by 30 TAC § 80.118(c), the TCEQ Office of the Chief Clerk (OCC) will provide the administrative record to SOAH, and will retain one copy for its files. In addition, one copy of the administrative record will be provided to you by the OCC on CD. Neither SOAH nor TCEQ is responsible for providing additional copies to the parties. However, the OCC can provide copies upon request.

The administrative record is not in evidence until properly offered by motion of a party, and subsequently admitted by the Administrative Law Judge, pursuant to 30 TAC § 80.127(h). The party seeking admission of the administrative record must supply copies to the other parties in the proceeding at the time it is offered, or by agreement of the parties.

**APPLICATION.**

Stephen Selinger, 620 Truelove Trail, Southlake, Texas 76092, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for new Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0015932001, to authorize the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 405,000 gallons per day. TCEQ received this application on October 1, 2020.

The facility will be located approximately 3,907 feet northwest of the intersection of Getzenander Road and the railroad tracks, and approximately 2,045 feet southeast of the end of Jenkins Road, in Ellis County, Texas 75165. The treated effluent will be discharged to an unnamed tributary, thence to Waxahachie Creek, thence to Bardwell Reservoir in Segment No. 0815 of the Trinity River Basin. The unclassified receiving water uses are minimal aquatic life use for the unnamed tributary and intermediate aquatic life for Waxahachie Creek. The designated uses for Segment No. 0815 are primary contact recreation, public water supply, and high aquatic life use. In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Section 307.5 and the TCEQ's *Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards* (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. A Tier 2 review has preliminarily determined that no significant degradation of water quality is expected in Waxahachie Creek, which has been identified as having intermediate aquatic life use. Existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received. The TCEQ Executive Director has prepared a draft permit which, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The permit application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft permit are available for viewing and copying at Waxahachie City Hall, 401 South Rogers Street, Waxahachie, Texas.

**CONTESTED CASE HEARING.**

Considering directives to protect public health, the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) will conduct a preliminary hearing via Zoom videoconference. A Zoom meeting is a secure, free meeting held over the internet that allows video, audio, or audio/video conferencing.

The purpose of a preliminary hearing is to establish jurisdiction, name the parties, establish a procedural schedule for the remainder of the proceeding, and to address other matters as determined by the judge. The evidentiary hearing phase of the proceeding, which will occur at a later date, will be similar to a civil trial in state district court. The hearing will address the disputed issues of fact identified in the TCEQ order concerning this application issued on January 19, 2022. In addition to these issues, the judge may consider additional issues if certain factors are met.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001, Texas Government Code; Chapter 26, Texas Water Code; and the procedural rules of the TCEQ and SOAH, including 30 TAC Chapter 80 and 1 TAC Chapter 155. The hearing will be held unless all timely hearing requests have been withdrawn or denied.

To request to be a party, you must attend the hearing and show you would be adversely affected by the application in a way not common to members of the general public. Any person may attend the hearing and request to be a party. Only persons named as parties may participate at the hearing.



## INSTRUCTIONS FOR PUBLIC NOTICE For Water Quality Permit

### NOTICE OF HEARING

A hearing was requested on issues related to your application and the Commission granted this request. The matter has been referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings. Now you must comply with the following instructions:

#### **Please Review Notice**

We have included in the hearing notice all of the information which we believe is necessary. Please read it carefully and notify us immediately if it contains any errors or omissions. You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information published. You may not change the text of the notice without prior approval from the TCEQ.

#### **Newspaper Notice**

- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Hearing no less than **30** days before the hearing.
- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Hearing at least once and at your expense, in a newspaper that is regularly published or circulated in each county where, by virtue of the county's geographical relation to the subject matter of the hearing, a person may reasonably believe persons reside who may be affected by the action that may be taken as a result of the hearing. A list of the appropriate counties provided by the executive director is described in the cover letter.

#### **Proof of Publication**

- For each published notice, you must submit proof of publication that shows the notice, the date of publication, and the name of the newspaper to the Office of the Chief Clerk within **10 business days** after the date of publication. Acceptable proof of publication is 1) a copy of the published notice or 2) the original newspaper clipping of the published notice. If you choose to submit a copy of the published notice to the Office of the Chief Clerk, the copy must be on standard-size 8½" x 11" paper and must show

the actual size of the published notice (do not reduce the image when making copies). Published notices longer than 11” must be copied onto multiple 8½” x 11” pages. Please note, submitting a copy of your published notice could result in faster processing of your application. It is recommended that you maintain the original newspaper clipping or tear sheet of the notice for your records.

- You must submit a **publisher's affidavit** to the Office of the Chief Clerk within **30 calendar days** after the date of publication. **You must use the enclosed affidavit form.** The affidavit must clearly identify the applicant's name and permit number.

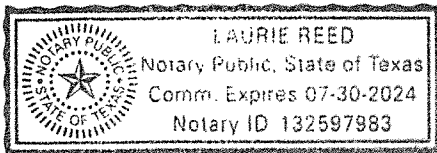

nados por el alto número de detenciones llevadas a cabo en la frontera con México y el traslado de inmigrantes hacia otros os para luego ser deportados o expulsados de Estados, un grupo integrado por 54 organizaciones firmó una carta para pedirle al gobierno que detenga de inmediato las acciones y evite la propagación del covid-19.



El grupo, denominado Rocky Mountain Immigrant Advocacy Network (RMIAN), dijo en la misiva que existía una "profunda preocupación dados los recientes aumentos en el número de personas detenidas, traslados de grupos por todo el país, y el aumento resultante de casos de Covid-19 bajo la custodia del DHS (Departamento de Seguridad Nacional)".

"Aumentar el número de personas inmigrantes detenidas supone un riesgo para la seguridad pública", precisaron e indicaron que "tras arrestar a 13,529 personas a finales de febrero, la Oficina de Inmigración y Aduanas (ICE) ha aumentado este número a 20,430 en poco más de dos meses".

Durante este mismo período, "el número de casos confirmados de Covid-19 bajo custodia de ICE ha aumentado drásticamente", indica la carta dirigida al secretario del DHS, Alejandro Mayorkas, al director en funciones de la Oficina de Ciudadanía y Servicios de Inmigración (USCIS), Tae Johnson, así como a la subdirectora de del Consejo de Política Nacional, Esther Olavarría.

**Problema serio**  
La carta advierte además que, aumentar el número de personas detenidas "supone un riesgo para la seguridad pública" y que el incremento en el número de nuevas infecciones en los centros de detención de ICE "plantea un riesgo innecesario de daño grave a las personas en detención y comunidades aledañas".

Los firmantes recuerdan a los funcionarios que la política de la actual administración es "proteger, seguridad, abordar con humanidad los desafíos en la frontera sur y garantizar la salud y la seguridad públicas".

También mencionan que ICE emitió una guía provisional para todos los empleados de la agencia donde exige que se de "prioridad a sus recursos para cumplir con su misión de seguridad pública", pero que debido al aumento en el número de detenidos "el gobierno parece estar retrocediendo" en sus objetivos. Indicaron además que, el pasado 13 de mayo Johnson parece haber sugerido, durante una audiencia ante el Comité de Asignaciones

del Subcomité de Seguridad Nacional de la Cámara de Representantes, que el gobierno ha continuado y mejorado algunas de las políticas de la administración anterior".

"Sobre la base de ese testimonio, expresamos nuestra profunda preocupación con respecto al plan de la agencia para expandir la detención de inmigrantes. Es decir, ICE mantuvo los contratos vigentes con empresa que maneja prisiones privadas", indicaron.



### Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision (NAPD)

The executive director has completed the technical review of your application and issued a preliminary decision. You must comply with the following instructions. There are seven (7) steps involved in publishing notice. Complete each step.

#### 1. REVIEW THE NOTICE FOR ACCURACY

Read the enclosed notice carefully and notify the Wastewater Permitting Section at 512-239-4671 immediately if it contains any errors or omissions. You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information published. Do not change the text or formatting of the notice or affidavit of publication without prior approval from the TCEQ. Changing the text or formatting of the notice may require new publication at your expense and delay processing of your application.

#### 2. PUBLISH THE NOTICE IN THE NEWSPAPER

You must publish the enclosed notice as soon as possible, but no later than 45 days from the date on the cover letter.

For renewal applications, you must publish at least once in the same newspaper that you published the Notice of Receipt of Application and Intent to Obtain Permit.

For all other applications, you must publish at least once in a newspaper regularly published or circulated within each county where the facility and discharge point are located or proposed to be located.

The bold text of the enclosed notice must be printed in the newspaper in a font style or size that distinguishes it from the rest of the notice (i.e., bold, italics). Failure to do so may require re-notice.

#### 3. PUBLISH THE NOTICE IN AN ALTERNATIVE LANGUAGE

You must publish notice in an alternative language **IF**: either the elementary or middle school nearest to the facility or proposed facility is required to provide a "bilingual education program" (BEP) as required by Texas Education Code (TEC), Chapter 29, Subchapter B, and 19 Tex. Admin. Code §89.1205(a) AND one of the following conditions is met:

- students are enrolled in a program at that school;
- students from that school attend a bilingual education program at another location; or
- the school that otherwise would be required to provide a bilingual education program has been granted an exception from the requirements to provide the program as provided for in 19 Tex. Admin. Code §89.1207(a).

A "bilingual education program" is different from an "English as a second language program" (ESL). An ESL program alone, will not require public notice in an alternative language.

If triggered, you must publish the notice in a newspaper or publication primarily published in the alternative language taught in the bilingual education program. Publication in an alternative language section or insert within a large publication which is not printed primarily in that alternative language does not satisfy these

requirements. The newspaper or publication must be of general circulation in the county in which the facility and discharge point are located or proposed to be located. If the facility and discharge point are located or proposed to be located in a municipality, and there exists a newspaper or publication of general circulation in the municipality, you must publish the notice only in the newspaper or publication in the municipality.

You must demonstrate a good faith effort to identify a newspaper or publication in the required language. If there is no general circulation newspaper or publication printed in such language, then publishing in that language is not required. You have the burden to demonstrate compliance with these requirements.

- any subsequent revisions to these documents.

This copy must be accessible to the public for review and copying beginning on the first day of newspaper publication and remain in place until the commission has taken action on the application or the commission refers issues to the State Office of Administrative Hearings.

For confidential information contained in the application, you must indicate which specific portions of the application cannot be made available to the public. These portions of the application must be accompanied with the following statement: "Any request for portions of this application that are marked as confidential must be submitted in writing, pursuant to the Public Information Act, to the TCEQ Public Information Coordinator, MC 197, P.O. Box 13087, Austin, Texas 78711-3087."

#### **5. PROVIDE PROOF OF PUBLICATION**

**For each newspaper in which you published, you must submit proof of publication.** Proof of publication must include the following:

- a completed Publisher's Affidavit (enclosed); and
- a copy of the published notice which shows the notice, the date published, and the newspaper name. The copy must be on standard-size 8½ x 11" paper and must show the actual size of the published notice. Do not reduce the image when making copies. Published notices longer than 11" must be

copied onto multiple 8½ x 11" pages. Or you can submit the original newspaper clipping.

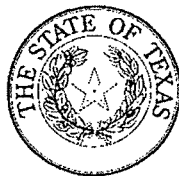

**APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY DECISION.** Stephen Richard Sellinger, 620 Truelove Trail, Southlake, Texas 76092, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for new Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0015932001, to authorize the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 405,000 gallons per day. TCEQ received this application on October 1, 2020.

The facility will be located approximately 3,907 feet northwest of the intersection of Getzenander Road and the railroad tracks, and approximately 2,045 feet southeast of the end of Jenkins Road, in Ellis County, Texas 75165. The treated effluent will be discharged to an unnamed tributary, thence to Waxahachie Creek, thence to Bardwell Reservoir in Segment No. 0815 of the Trinity River Basin. The unclassified receiving water uses are minimal aquatic life use for the unnamed tributary and intermediate aquatic life for Waxahachie Creek. The designated uses for Segment No. 0815 are primary contact recreation, public water supply, and high aquatic life use. In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code Section 307.5 and the TCEQ's Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. A Tier 2 review has preliminarily determined that no significant degradation of water quality is expected in Waxahachie Creek, which has been identified as having intermediate aquatic life use. Existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received. The TCEQ Executive Director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The permit application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft permit are available for viewing and copying at Waxahachie City Hall, 401 South Rogers Street, Waxahachie, Texas.

**PUBLIC COMMENT / PUBLIC MEETING. You may submit public comments or request a public meeting about this application.** The purpose of a public meeting is to provide the opportunity to submit comments or to ask questions about the application. TCEQ holds a public meeting if the Executive Director determines that there is a significant degree of public interest in the application or if requested by a local legislator. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing.

**OPPORTUNITY FOR A CONTESTED CASE HEARING.** After the deadline for submitting public comments, the Executive Director will consider all timely comments and prepare a response to all relevant and material or significant public comments. **Unless the application is directly referred for a contested case hearing, the response to comments will be mailed to everyone who submitted public comments and to those persons who are on the mailing list for this application. If comments are received, the mailing will also provide instructions for requesting a contested case hearing or reconsideration of the Executive Director's decision.** A contested case hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in a state district court.

**TO REQUEST A CONTESTED CASE HEARING, YOU MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN YOUR REQUEST: your name, address, phone number; applicant's name and proposed permit number; the location and distance of your property/activities relative to the proposed facility; a specific description of how you would be adversely affected by the facility in a way not common to the general public; a list of all disputed issues of fact that you submit during the comment period; and the statement "[I/we] request a contested case hearing." If the request for contested case hearing is filed on behalf of a group or association, the request must designate the group's representative for receiving future correspondence; identify by name and physical address an individual member of the group who would be adversely affected by the proposed facility or activity; provide the information discussed above regarding the affected member's location and distance from the facility or activity; explain how and why the member would be affected; and explain how the interests the group seeks to protect are relevant to the group's purpose.**

Following the close of all applicable comment and request periods, the Executive Director will forward the application and any requests for reconsideration or for a contested case hearing to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting.

The Commission may only grant a request for a contested case hearing on issues the requestor submitted in their timely comments that were not subsequently withdrawn. **If a hearing is granted, the subject of a hearing will be limited to disputed issues of fact or mixed questions of fact and law relating to relevant and material water quality concerns submitted during the comment period.**

**EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR ACTION.** The Executive Director may issue final approval of the application unless a timely contested case hearing request or request for reconsideration is filed. If a timely hearing request or request for reconsideration is filed, the Executive Director will not issue final approval of the permit and will forward the application and request to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting.

**MAILING LIST.** If you submit public comments, a request for a contested case hearing or a reconsideration of the Executive Director's decision, you will be added to the mailing list for this specific application to receive future public notices mailed by the Office of the Chief Clerk. 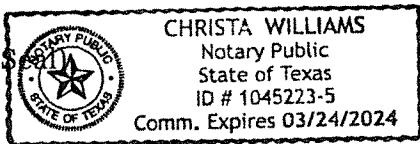

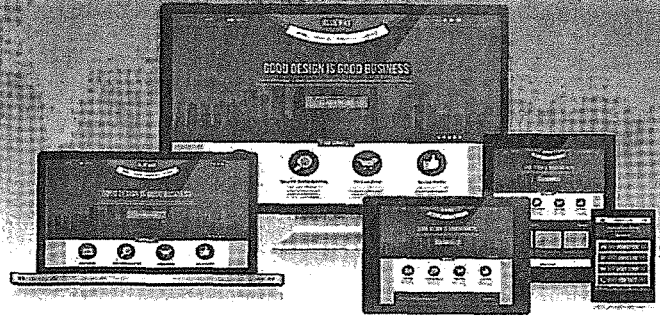

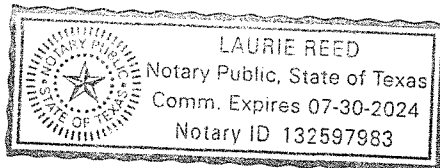

# En enero vencen los permisos de trabajo de miles de inmigrantes con TPS, pero el gobierno trabaja en una extensión

Miles de indocumentados amparados temporalmente de la deportación quedarán en el limbo a partir del 4 enero y esperan que Joe Biden renueve el programa humanitario. Mientras tanto, la USCIS dijo a Univision Noticias que, en breve, extenderá la fecha de las autorizaciones de empleo.

Miles de inmigrantes centroamericanos y del Caribe protegidos por un Estado de Protección Temporal (TPS) aguardan expectantes la llegada del presidente electo Joe Biden a la Casa Blanca el 20 de enero, pero no saben qué harán en las dos semanas previas porque habrán vencido sus permisos de trabajo.

"Nos preocupa perder nuestras propiedades, nuestros negocios, separamos de nuestras familias", dice Orlando López, un transportista de nacionalidad hondureña con más de 20 años en Estados Unidos. "Será que nos van a quitar lo que nos ha costado tanto?",

pregunta. "No sabemos nada, si los van a prorrogar, si nos van a arrestar o si podremos seguir trabajando. Solo nos queda la esperanza en la promesa que hizo Biden, que cuando asuma nos restaurará el TPS", agrega el activista.

Biden, durante su campaña, dijo que repararía el TPS y también protegería a los dreamers desde el primer día de su gobierno, y que en los primeros 100 días de su mandato enviaría al Senado un plan de reforma migratoria con un camino a la ciudadanía para indocumentados que cumplan con ciertos requisitos.

El TPS otorta una protección diferida de deportación y una autorización de empleo que se renueva cada vez que se proroga el amparo.

En el caso de El Salvador y Sudán del Sur, el programa estará vigente hasta el 2 de mayo de 2022.

El TPS para Honduras y Nicaragua fue otorgado en enero de 1999 por razones humanitarias tras el paso del huracán Mitch por Centroamérica.

El TPS para Haití fue otorgado en 2010 luego de un catastrófico terremoto ocurrido en ese país que dejó unos 300,000 fallecidos. El alivio migratorio fue establecido para per-

mitir que los haitianos en Estados Unidos pudieran permanecer y trabajar legalmente mientras su país se recuperaba del desastre.
