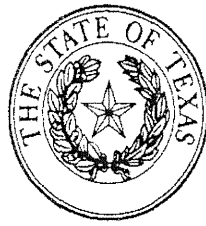


TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY



AN INTERIM ORDER regarding the Petition by Harrington/Turner Enterprises, LP for the Creation of Collin County Municipal Utility District No. 7; TCEQ Docket No. 2022-0533-DIS.

On July 20, 2022, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission) considered during its open meeting requests for hearing and reconsideration filed by numerous entities and individuals concerning the petition of Harrington/Turner Enterprises, LP (Petitioner) for creation of Collin County Municipal Utility District No. 7 (the District). The hearing requests and requests for reconsideration were evaluated under the requirements in the applicable statutes and Commission rules, including 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 55, Subchapter G. The Commission also considered the responses to the hearing requests filed by the Executive Director, the Office of Public Interest Counsel, and Petitioner; the requesters' timely replies; and all timely public comment.


