Otis Redding III, who followed father into music, dies at 59

Singer and guitarist Otis Redding III, the son and namesake of the legendary 1960s soul singer, has died from cancer at age 59, his family said Wednesday.

Redding was just 3 years old when his father, Otis Redding, perished along with several band members in a plane crash on Dec. 10, 1967. More than a decade later, the younger Redding and his brother, Dexter, formed the funk band The Reddings, which recorded six albums in the 1980s.

Though singles "Remote Control" and "Call The Law" by The Reddings made appearances on the Billboard music charts, the Redding brothers never matched their father's success. Redding continued playing and performing after the band recorded its final album in 1988.

He was once hired for a European tour as guitarist for soul singer Eddie Floyd, another whose guidance the younger Redding became comfortable performing "(Sittin' On) The Dock of the Bay" and other songs of his famous father.

Redding worked with his family's charity in Macon, the Otis Redding Foundation, to organize summer camps that teach children to play music, and served as board president for the local chapter of Meals on Wheels.

Foo Fighters plan summer album, first since drummer's death

Foo Fighters have announced a new album is in the works, the first since the death of the band's drummer, Taylor Hawkins.

The rockers said in a statement that the upcoming 10-track "But Here We Are" will be "a brutally honest and emotionally raw response to everything Foo Fighters endured over the last year."

Hawkins, the lead, driving singer, is "rescued," with the lyrics "I'm just waiting to be rescued/ Bring me back to life/Kings and queens

and in-betweens/We all deserve the right."

The new album will be released June 2 and is produced by Greg Kurstin and Foo Fighters. Other titles include "Hearing Voices," "Show Me How," "Nothing At All" and "Rest," the ending song.

Hawkins died March 25, 2022, during a South American tour with the rock band. He was 50.

'Rust' movie reboots, Baldwin returning to set

Filming on the Western movie "Rust" could resume this week in Montana, the

production company said Wednesday, in the aftermath of the fatal shooting of a cinematographer during a rehearsal with actor Alec Baldwin on the original production in New Mexico.

Baldwin will continue his involvement as an actor and coproducer, and Rust Movie Productions attorney Melina Spadone said via a representative that filming will restart Thursday at the Yellowstone Film Ranch.

The production company finalized a settlement last month with New Mexico workplace safety regulators over "serious" violations, agreeing to a \$10,000 fine to resolve a scathing safety review that de-

tailed unheeded complaints and misfires on set before cinematographer Halyna Hutchins was shot and killed in October 2021.

Plans to resume filming were outlined last year by widower Matthew Hutchins in a proposed settlement to a wrongful death lawsuit that would make him an executive producer on a rebooted "Rust."

Prosecutors in Santa Fe are pressing forward with involuntary manslaughter charges against actor Baldwin and a weapons supervisor Hannah Gutiérrez-Reed. Baldwin and Gutiérrez-Reed have pleaded not guilty.



- Conocer la tierra es quererla.






