As you know, the Chief Clerk's Office has referred this matter over to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a contested case hearing on your application.

SOAH will conduct a preliminary hearing via Zoom video conference at:

10:00 a.m. – November 27, 2023

You are now required to publish notice for this hearing. To help you meet the requirements associated with this notice, we have enclosed the following items:

- Instructions for Notice of Hearing

Please note that it is VERY IMPORTANT that you follow ALL directions in the ENCLOSED INSTRUCTIONS. If you do not, you may be required to republish the notice. One of the most common mistakes we see is the unauthorized changing of notice wording or font. If you have any questions, please contact us before you proceed with publication.

The following items and time limitations are also described in the enclosed instructions. However, due to their importance, we want to highlight them for you.

3. File the original enclosed *Affidavit of Publication* with the TCEQ Office of the Chief Clerk within **30 calendar days** after the notice is published in the newspaper.


If you do not comply with all requirements described in the instructions, further processing of your application may be suspended or the commission may take other actions.

As required by 30 TAC § 80.118(c), the TCEQ Office of the Chief Clerk (OCC) will provide the administrative record to SOAH, and will retain one copy for its files. In addition, one copy of the administrative record will be provided to you by the OCC on CD. Neither SOAH nor TCEQ is responsible for providing additional copies to the parties. However, the OCC can provide copies upon request.

The administrative record is not in evidence until properly offered by motion of a party, and subsequently admitted by the Administrative Law Judge, pursuant to 30 TAC § 80.127(h). The party seeking admission of the administrative record must supply copies to the other parties in the proceeding at the time it is offered, or by agreement of the parties.

NOTICE OF HEARING **Steel Dynamics Southwest, LLC** **SOAH Docket No. 582-24-01358** **TCEQ Docket No. 2023-0442-IWD** **Permit No. WQ0005283000**

APPLICATION.

Steel Dynamics Southwest, LLC, 8534 Highway 89, Sinton, Texas 78387, which operates the Sinton Mill, an iron and steel manufacturing and coil coating facility, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for a major amendment without renewal of Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0005283000 to remove the domestic sewage treatment facility (domestic sewage is routed to the City of Sinton main WWTF), to reduce daily average flow from 1.56 MGD to 1.2 MGD, to incorporate a constructed wetland into the final effluent discharge pathway, to move Outfall 001 and add new Outfall 101, and to add a second paint and galvanizing line to the plant. The draft permit authorizes the discharge of treated process wastewater, utility wastewater, and previously monitored effluent (PME; treated wastewater via Outfall 101 and coil coating process wastewater via Outfall 201) at a daily average flow not to exceed 1,200,000 gallons per day via Outfall 001, and industrial storm water on an intermittent and flow variable basis via Outfalls 002, 003, and 004.

The facility is located at 8534 Highway 89, northeast of the City of Sinton, in San Patricio County, Texas 78387. This link to an electronic map of the site or facility's general location is provided as a public courtesy and is not part of the application or notice. The effluent is discharged via pipe to a constructed wetland (not a water in the state) to Outfall 001 to Ditch 3, thence Ditch 4; or when the constructed wetland is undergoing maintenance the discharge route is via pipe directly to Outfall 001 to Ditch 3, thence to Ditch 4; via Outfall 002 to Ditch 1, thence to Ditch 4; and via Outfalls 003 and 004 to Ditch 3, thence to Ditch 4, thence all outfalls to Chiltipin Creek; thence to Chiltipin Creek Tidal, thence to Aransas River Tidal, thence to Aransas River Tidal in Segment No. 2003 of the San Antonio-Nueces Coastal Basin. The unclassified receiving water uses are minimal aquatic life use for the Ditches (1, 3, and 4), limited aquatic life use for Chiltipin Creek, and high aquatic life use for Chiltipin Creek Tidal. The designated uses for Segment No. 2003 are primary contact recreation and high aquatic life use.

In accordance with Title 30 Texas Administrative Code Section 307.5 and TCEQ's *Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards* (June 2010), an

antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. A Tier 2 review has preliminarily determined that no significant degradation of water quality is expected in Chiltipin Creek Tidal, which has been identified as having high aquatic life use. Existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received.

The TCEQ executive director reviewed this action for consistency with the Texas Coastal Management Program (CMP) goals and policies in accordance with the regulations of the General Land Office and has determined that the action is consistent with the applicable CMP goals and policies.

The TCEQ executive director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The executive director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The permit application, executive director's preliminary decision, and draft permit are available for viewing and copying at Sinton Public Library, 100 North Pirate Boulevard, Sinton, Texas.

CONTESTED CASE HEARING.

The State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) will conduct a preliminary hearing via Zoom videoconference. A Zoom meeting is a secure, free meeting held over the internet that allows video, audio, or audio/video conferencing.

The purpose of a preliminary hearing is to establish jurisdiction, name the parties, establish a procedural schedule for the remainder of the proceeding, and to address other matters as determined by the judge. The evidentiary hearing phase of the proceeding, which will occur at a later date, will be similar to a civil trial in state district court. The hearing will address the disputed issues of fact identified in the TCEQ order

concerning this application issued on May 15, 2023. In addition to these issues, the judge may consider additional issues if certain factors are met.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001, Texas Government Code; Chapter 26, Texas Water Code; and the procedural rules of the TCEQ and SOAH, including 30 TAC Chapter 80 and 1 TAC Chapter 155. The hearing will be held unless all timely hearing requests have been withdrawn or denied.

To request to be a party, you must attend the hearing and show you would be adversely affected by the application in a way not common to members of the general public. Any person may attend the hearing and request to be a party. Only persons named as parties may participate at the hearing.

In accordance with 1 Tex. Admin. Code § 155.401(a), Notice of Hearing, “Parties that are not represented by an attorney may obtain information regarding contested case hearings on the public website of the State Office of Administrative Hearings at www.soah.texas.gov, or in printed format upon request to SOAH.”



NOTICE OF HEARING

A hearing was requested on issues related to your application and the Commission granted this request. The matter has been referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings. Now you must comply with the following instructions:

Please Review Notice

We have included in the hearing notice all of the information which we believe is necessary. Please read it carefully and notify us immediately if it contains any errors or omissions. You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information published. You may not change the text of the notice without prior approval from the TCEQ.

Newspaper Notice

- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Hearing no less than **30** days before the hearing.
- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Hearing at least once and at your expense, in a newspaper that is regularly published or circulated in each county where, by virtue of the county's geographical relation to the subject matter of the hearing, a person may reasonably believe persons reside who may be affected by the action that may be taken as a result of the hearing. Proof of Publication

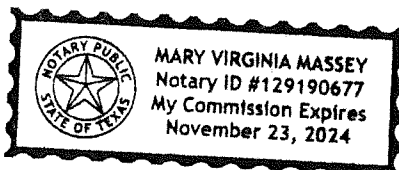

The draft permit authorizes the discharge of treated process wastewater, utility wastewater, and previously monitored effluent (PME) treated wastewater via Outfall 101 and coil coating process wastewater via Outfall 201 at a daily average flow not to exceed 1,200,000 gallons per day via Outfall 001, and industrial storm water on an intermittent and flow variable basis via Outfalls 002, 003, and 004.

The effluent is discharged via pipe to a constructed wetland (not a water in the state) to Outfall 001, to Ditch 3, thence Ditch 4; or when the constructed wetland is undergoing maintenance the discharge route is via pipe directly to Outfall 001 to Ditch 3, thence to Ditch 4; via Outfall 002 to Ditch 1, thence to Ditch 4; and via Outfalls 003 and 004 to Ditch 3, thence to Ditch 4, thence all outfalls to Chilitipin Creek; thence to Chilitipin Creek Tidal, thence to Aransas River Tidal, thence to Aransas River Tidal in Segment No. 2003 of the San Antonio-Nueces Coastal Basin. The unclassified receiving water uses are minimal aquatic life use for the Ditches (1, 3, and 4), limited aquatic life use for Chilitipin Creek, and high aquatic life use for Chilitipin Creek Tidal. The designated uses for Segment No. 2003 are primary contact recreation and high aquatic life use.

In accordance with Title 30 Texas Administrative Code Section 307.5 and TCEQ's Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. A Tier 2 review has preliminarily determined that no significant degradation of water quality is expected in Chilitipin Creek Tidal, which has been identified as having high aquatic life use. Existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received.

The TCEQ executive director reviewed this action for consistency with the Texas Coastal Management Program (CMP) goals and policies in accordance with the regulations of the General Land Office and has determined that the action is consistent with the applicable CMP goals and policies.

The TCEQ executive director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The executive director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements.

PUBLIC COMMENT / PUBLIC MEETING. A public meeting will be held and will consist of two parts, an Informal Discussion Period and a Formal Comment Period. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedure Act. 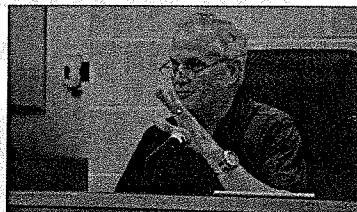
to repeal the usage of the curriculum during a special called meeting on Oct. 6.

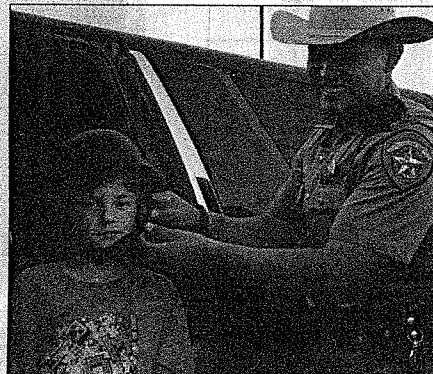

Odem council rejects illegal budget

If last week's city council meeting was any indication, the city of Odem has a financial - and administrative - problem on its hands.

"[The mayor and city administrator] think money grows on trees," said council member Lynnette Tidwell. "This is a mess."

Cities in the state of Texas operate on fiscal year budgets - most beginning Oct. 1 and ending Sept. 30 the following year. That is the case for Odem, yet city council members unanimously rejected a last-minute effort to pass a budget that should have gone into effect Oct. 1.

In part, the budget proposed by Mayor Virginia Garza and City Administrator Janie Martinez failed because it is not allowed by the state of Texas.

According to the Texas Local Government Code, a "budget officer shall prepare each year a municipal budget to cover the proposed expenditures of the municipal government for the succeeding year."

In other words, there must be enough revenue budgeted to "cover"

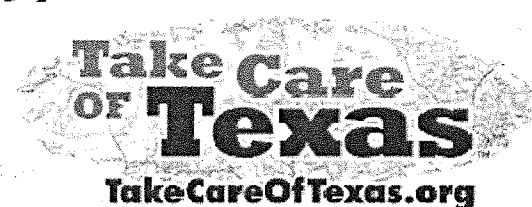

Steel Dynamics Southwest, LLC, 8534 Highway 89, Sinton, Texas 78387, which operates the Sinton Mill, an iron and steel manufacturing and coil coating facility, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for a major amendment without renewal of Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0005283000 to remove the domestic sewage treatment facility (domestic sewage is routed to the City of Sinton main WWTF), to reduce daily average flow from 1.56 MGD to 1.2 MGD, to incorporate a constructed wetland into the final effluent discharge pathway, to move Outfall 001 and add new Outfall 101, and to add a second paint and galvanizing line to the plant. The draft permit authorizes the discharge of treated process wastewater, utility wastewater, and previously monitored effluent (PME; treated wastewater via Outfall 101 and coil coating process wastewater via Outfall 201) at a daily average flow not to exceed 1,200,000 gallons per day via Outfall 001, and industrial storm water on an intermittent and flow variable basis via Outfalls 002, 003, and 004.

The facility is located at 8534 Highway 89, northeast of the City of Sinton, in San Patricio County, Texas 78387. This link to an electronic map of the site or facility's general location is provided as a public courtesy and is not part of the application or notice. The effluent is discharged via pipe to a constructed wetland (not a water in the state) to Outfall 001 to Ditch 3, thence Ditch 4; or when the constructed wetland is undergoing maintenance the discharge route is via pipe directly to Outfall 001 to Ditch 3, thence to Ditch 4; via Outfall 002 to Ditch 1, thence to Ditch 4; and via Outfalls 003 and 004 to Ditch 3, thence to Ditch 4, thence all outfalls to Chiltipin Creek; thence to Chiltipin Creek Tidal, thence to Aransas River Tidal, thence to Aransas River Tidal in Segment No. 2003 of the San Antonio-Nueces Coastal Basin. The unclassified receiving water uses are minimal aquatic life use for the Ditches (1, 3, and 4), limited aquatic life use for Chiltipin Creek, and high aquatic life use for Chiltipin Creek Tidal. The designated uses for Segment No. 2003 are primary contact recreation and high aquatic life use.

In accordance with Title 30 Texas Administrative Code Section 307.5 and TCEQ's *Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards* (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. A Tier 2 review has preliminarily determined that no significant degradation of water quality is expected in Chiltipin Creek Tidal, which has been identified as having high aquatic life use. Existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received.

The TCEQ executive director reviewed this action for consistency with the Texas Coastal Management Program (CMP) goals and policies in accordance with the regulations of the General Land Office and has determined that the action is consistent with the applicable CMP goals and policies.

The TCEQ executive director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The executive director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements.

PUBLIC COMMENT / PUBLIC MEETING. A public meeting will be held and will consist of two parts, an Informal Discussion Period and a Formal Comment Period. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedure Act. APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY DECISION. Steel Dynamics Southwest, LLC, 8534 Highway 89, Sinton, Texas 78387, which operates the Sinton Mill, an iron and steel manufacturing and coil coating facility, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for a major amendment without renewal of Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0005283000 to remove the domestic sewage treatment facility (domestic sewage is routed to the City of Sinton main WWTF), to reduce daily average flow from 1.56 MGD to 1.2 MGD, to incorporate a constructed wetland into the final effluent discharge pathway, to move Outfall 001 and add new Outfall 101, and to add a second paint and galvanizing line to the plant. The draft permit authorizes the discharge of treated process wastewater, utility wastewater, and previously monitored effluent (PME; treated wastewater via Outfall 101 and coil coating process wastewater via Outfall 201) at a daily average flow not to exceed 1,200,000 gallons per day via Outfall 001, and industrial storm water on an intermittent and flow variable basis via Outfalls 002, 003, and 004. The TCEQ received this application on October 14, 2021.

The facility is located at 8534 Highway 89, northeast of the City of Sinton, in San Patricio County, Texas 78387. This link to an electronic map of the site or facility's general location is provided as a public courtesy and is not part of the application or notice. For the exact location, refer to the application.

The effluent is discharged via pipe to a constructed wetland (not a water in the state) to Outfall 001 to Ditch 3, thence Ditch 4; or when the constructed wetland is undergoing maintenance the discharge route is via pipe directly to Outfall 001 to Ditch 3, thence to Ditch 4; via Outfall 002 to Ditch 1, thence to Ditch 4; and via Outfalls 003 and 004 to Ditch 3, thence to Ditch 4, thence all outfalls to Chiltipin Creek; thence to Chiltipin Creek Tidal, thence to Aransas River Tidal, thence to Aransas River Tidal in Segment No. 2003 of the San Antonio-Nueces Coastal Basin. The unclassified receiving water uses are minimal aquatic life use for the Ditches (1, 3, and 4), limited aquatic life use for Chiltipin Creek, and high aquatic life use for Chiltipin Creek Tidal. The designated uses for Segment No. 2003 are primary contact recreation and high aquatic life use.

In accordance with Title 30 Texas Administrative Code Section 307.5 and TCEQ's *Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards* (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. A Tier 2 review has preliminarily determined that no significant degradation of water quality is expected in Chiltipin Creek Tidal, which has been identified as having high aquatic life use. Existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received.

The TCEQ executive director reviewed this action for consistency with the Texas Coastal Management Program (CMP) goals and policies in accordance with the regulations of the General Land Office and has determined that the action is consistent with the applicable CMP goals and policies.

The TCEQ executive director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The executive director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The permit application, executive director's preliminary decision, and draft permit are available for viewing and copying at Sinton Public Library, 100 North Pirate Boulevard, Sinton, Texas.

PUBLIC COMMENT / PUBLIC MEETING. You may submit public comments or request a public meeting about this application. The purpose of a public meeting is to provide the opportunity to submit written or oral comment or to ask questions about the application. Generally, the TCEQ will hold a public meeting if the executive director determines that there is a significant degree of public interest in the application or if requested by a local legislator. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing.

OPPORTUNITY FOR A CONTESTED CASE HEARING. After the deadline for public comments, the executive director will consider the comments and prepare a response to all relevant and material, or significant public comments. **The response to comments, along with the executive director's decision on the application, will be mailed to everyone who submitted public comments or who requested to be on a mailing list for this application. If comments are received, the mailing will also provide instructions for requesting a contested case hearing or reconsideration of the executive director's decision.** A contested case hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in a state district court.

TO REQUEST A CONTESTED CASE HEARING, YOU MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN YOUR REQUEST: your name, address, phone number; applicant's name and proposed permit number; the location and distance of your property/activities relative to the proposed facility; a specific description of how you would be adversely affected by the facility in a way not common to the general public; a list of all disputed issues of fact that you submit during the comment period; and the statement "[I/we] request a contested case hearing." If the request for contested case hearing is filed on behalf of a group or association, the request must designate the group's representative for receiving future correspondence; identify by name and physical address an individual member of the group who would be adversely affected by the proposed facility or activity; provide the information discussed above regarding the affected member's location and distance from the facility or activity; explain how and why the member would be affected; and explain how the interests the group seeks to protect are relevant to the group's purpose.

Following the close of all applicable comment and request periods, the executive director will forward the application and any requests for reconsideration or for a contested case hearing to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting.

The Commission may only grant a request for a contested case hearing on issues the requestor submitted in their timely comments that were not subsequently withdrawn. **If a hearing is granted, the subject of a hearing will be limited to disputed issues of fact or mixed questions of fact and law relating to relevant and material water quality concerns submitted during the comment period.**

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR ACTION. The executive director may issue final approval of the application unless a timely contested case hearing request or a timely request for reconsideration is filed. If a timely hearing request or request for reconsideration is filed, the executive director will not issue final approval of the permit and will forward the application and requests to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting.

MAILING LIST. If you submit public comments, a request for a contested case hearing or a reconsideration of the executive director's decision, you will be added to the mailing list for this specific application to receive future public notices mailed by the Office of the Chief Clerk. In addition, you may request to be added to: (1) the permanent list for a specific applicant name and permit number; and (2) the mailing list for a specific county. If you wish to be placed on the permanent and the county mailing list, clearly specify which list(s) and send your request to TCEQ Office of the Chief Clerk at the address below.



Instructions for Public Notice for a Water Quality Permit

Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision (NAPD)

The executive director has completed the technical review of your application and issued a preliminary decision. You must comply with the following instructions. There are seven (7) steps involved in publishing notice. Complete each step.

1. REVIEW THE NOTICE FOR ACCURACY

Read the enclosed notice carefully and notify the Wastewater Permitting Section at 512-239-4671 immediately if it contains any errors or omissions. You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information published. Do not change the text or formatting of the notice or affidavit of publication without prior approval from the TCEQ. Changing the text or formatting of the notice may require new publication at your expense and delay processing of your application.

2. PUBLISH THE NOTICE IN THE NEWSPAPER

You must publish the enclosed notice as soon as possible, but no later than 45 days from the date on the cover letter.

For renewal applications, you must publish at least once in the same newspaper that you published the Notice of Receipt of Application and Intent to Obtain Permit.

For all other applications, you must publish at least once in a newspaper regularly published or circulated within each county where the facility and discharge point are located or proposed to be located.

The bold text of the enclosed notice must be printed in the newspaper in a font style or size that distinguishes it from the rest of the notice (i.e., bold, italics). Failure to do so may require re-notice.

3. PUBLISH THE NOTICE IN AN ALTERNATIVE LANGUAGE

You must publish notice in an alternative language IF: either the elementary or middle school nearest to the facility or proposed facility is required to provide a "bilingual education program" (BEP) as required by Texas Education Code (TEC), Chapter 29, Subchapter B, and 19 Tex. Admin. Code §89.1205(a) AND one of the following conditions is met:

- students are enrolled in a program at that school;
- students from that school attend a bilingual education program at another location; or
- the school that otherwise would be required to provide a bilingual education program has been granted an exception from the requirements to provide the program as provided for in 19 Tex. Admin. Code §89.1207(a).

A "bilingual education program" is different from an "English as a second language program" (ESL). An ESL program alone, will not require public notice in an alternative language.

If triggered, you must publish the notice in a newspaper or publication primarily published in the alternative language taught in the bilingual education program. Publication in an alternative language section or insert within a large publication which is not printed primarily in that alternative language does not satisfy these

requirements. The newspaper or publication must be of general circulation in the county in which the facility and discharge point are located or proposed to be located. If the facility and discharge point are located or proposed to be located in a municipality, and there exists a newspaper or publication of general circulation in the municipality, you must publish the notice only in the newspaper or publication in the municipality.

You must demonstrate a good faith effort to identify a newspaper or publication in the required language. If there is no general circulation newspaper or publication printed in such language, then publishing in that language is not required. You have the burden to demonstrate compliance with these requirements.

If you are required to publish notice in Spanish, you must translate the site-specific information in the notice that is specific to your application, at your own expense. You may then insert the Spanish translation of your site-specific information into a Spanish template developed by the TCEQ. The Spanish templates are available on the TCEQ website at

www.tceq.texas.gov/permitting/wastewater/review/napd/wqspanish_napd.html. If you are required to publish notice in a language other than Spanish, you must translate the entire public notice, at your own expense.

4. PUT THE APPLICATION IN A PUBLIC PLACE

You must put a copy of the following documents in the public place identified in the enclosed notice:

- the complete application,
- the executive director's preliminary decision as contained in the technical summary and fact sheet,
- the draft permit, and
- any subsequent revisions to these documents.

This copy must be accessible to the public for review and copying beginning on the first day of newspaper publication and remain in place until the commission has taken action on the application or the commission refers issues to the State Office of Administrative Hearings.

For confidential information contained in the application, you must indicate which specific portions of the application cannot be made available to the public. These portions of the application must be accompanied with the following statement: "Any request for portions of this application that are marked as confidential must be submitted in writing, pursuant to the Public Information Act, to the TCEQ Public Information Coordinator, MC 197, P.O. Box 13087, Austin, Texas 78711-3087."

5. PROVIDE PROOF OF PUBLICATION

For each newspaper in which you published, you must submit proof of publication. Proof of publication must include the following:

- a completed Publisher's Affidavit (enclosed); and
- a copy of the published notice which shows the notice, the date published, and the newspaper name. The copy must be on standard-size 8½ x 11" paper and must show the actual size of the published notice. Do not reduce the image when making copies. Published notices longer than 11" must be

copied onto multiple 8½ x 11" pages. Or you can submit the original newspaper clipping.

If you are required to publish notice in an alternative language and are unable to do so, complete and submit the Alternative Language Exemption form (enclosed).

6. PROVIDE PROOF OF APPLICATION VIEWING LOCATION

This copy must be accessible to the public for review and copying beginning on the first day of newspaper publication and remain in place for the publication's designated comment period.

During the technical review, you must update the publicly available application so that it includes all application revisions within 10 business days from the date the revision is transmitted to the TCEQ.

For confidential information contained in the application, you must indicate which specific portions of the application cannot be made available to the public. These portions of the application must be accompanied with the following statement: "Any request for portions of this application that are marked as confidential must be submitted in writing, pursuant to the Public Information Act, to the TCEQ Public Information Coordinator, MC 197, P.O. Box 13087, Austin, Texas 78711-3087."

5. PROVIDE PROOF OF PUBLICATION

For each newspaper in which you published, you must submit proof of publication. Proof of publication must include the following:

- a completed Publisher's Affidavit (enclosed); and
- a copy of the published notice which shows the notice, the date published, and the newspaper name. The copy must be on standard-size 8½ x 11" paper and must show the actual size of the published notice. Do not reduce the

image when making copies. Published notices longer than 11" must be copied onto multiple 8½ x 11" pages. Or you can submit the original newspaper clipping.
