





nopoly.
Our state legislators
also promised lower bills by allowing companies to compete in retailing electricity to 85 percent of Texans. We already know that didn't work out-prices remain lower in the few lucky places served by electric cooperative or city-owned util-

Overall, though, the new system worked rea-sonably well for a while, but the crows are coming home to roost.

Years of excessive profiteering, low investment, and system decay have taken their toll because for-profit companies will not invest one penny more than they must. And our elected repre-sentatives did not ask them to do nearly enough over the last two decades.

The first warning came in 2011 when cold weather triggered blackouts across Central Texas When Texans didn't heed that warning, the grid collapsed in February 2021. This summer, prices are spiking as the grid manager, ERCOT, issues emergency alerts at an unprecedented frequency due to the outdated grid.

The competitive mar-ket is not the problem; it's

the incompetent referee. Corporate consolidation has shrunk the num-ber of companies generat-ing electricity and the number of retailers selling it to consumers. Making matters worse, the companies that generate electricity are buying up

the companies selling it.

If that sounds like the old-school monopolies that lawmakers intended to dismantle, that would be correct. Only this time, the Legislature has taken away the Public Utilities Commission's authority over these neo-monopolies.

Most electricity con-sumers in competitive markets rely on the PUC's PowertoChoose-.com to find a retailer. There are hundreds of plans to choose from, but more than half are controlled by just seven cor-porations that use multiple brand names to confuse consumers.

Houston-based NRG, which provided about 12 percent of Texas genera-tion capacity, owns six retailers selling dozens of plans to consumers. Vistra, the largest generator in the United States with 17 percent of Texas generation, operates three

retail electricity subsid-iaries doing the same. Together, Vistra and NRG control at least 70 percent of the retail elec-tricity market while generating 30 percent of the state's electricity. Texas lawmakers never imag-ined these so-called gen-tailers would control so much of the market, and any economist can explain it crushes competition.

"Inflation is every-where today, and the last thing we need is addi-tional costs running through the system, especially when it's captured by just a handful of parties that haven't acted in the consumer's interest historically. I see an op-

portunity for a lot of money-grabbing and not necessarily better out-comes," said Michael Lee, CEO of Octopus Energy U.S., a retailer trying to break into the ERCOT market. Lee wants the PUC to

limit how many compa-nies, brands and plans one corporate parent may own. I think we need new laws and anti-trust attorneys to break up

monopolistic behavior. The key to lower electricity prices is to reduce fuel costs in the long term. Natural gas and coal prices are highly volatile, but they are unlikely to come down

much. Wind, solar and hydro have no fuel costs. They only require an investment in maintenance and equipment, which is getting cheaper every year. The more we rely on them, the lower our bills will drop. President Joe Biden made two important

announcements this week that should help First, he will not impose new tariffs on Asian solar panels, and second-ly, he will use the Defense Production Act to en-courage greater U.S. man-ufacturing of critical clean energy equipment.

Corporate consolida-tion is adding to electricity prices. Texans need competition and innovation to lower our bills, not more of the same old erony capitalism.



City of Houston, 10500 Bellaire Boulevard, Houston, Texas 77072, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for a major amendment to Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0010495030 to authorize the removal of the existing Sublethal Whole Effluent Toxicity (WET) limits and monitoring requirements from the permit pursuant to the Environmental Protection Agency's WET policies, the Clean Water Act, and the Code of Federal Regulations. The current permit authorizes the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at an annual average flow not to exceed 26,400,000 gallons per day. TCEQ received this application on October 22, 2021.

The facility is located at 12901 Hermitage Lane, in the City of Houston, Harris County, Texas 77079. The treated effluent is discharged directly to Buffalo Bayou Above Tidal in Segment No. 1014 of the San Jacinto River Basin. The designated uses for Segment No. 1014 are primary contact recreation and limited aquatic life use. In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code Section 307.5 and the TCEQ's *Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards* (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. A Tier 2 review is not required since no exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life use water bodies have been identified in the discharge route. Existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing.

After the deadline for submitting public comments, the Executive Director will consider all timely comments and prepare a response to all relevant and material, or significant public comments. 5. PROVIDE PROOF OF PUBLICATION

For each newspaper in which you published, you must submit proof of publication. Proof of publication must include the following:

- a completed Publisher's Affidavit (enclosed); and

If the request for contested case hearing is filed on behalf of a group or association, the request must designate the group's representative for receiving future correspondence; identify by name and physical address an individual member of the group who would be adversely affected by the proposed facility or activity; provide the information discussed above regarding the affected member's location and distance from the facility or activity; explain how and why the member would be affected; and explain how the interests the group seeks to protect are relevant to the group's purpose.

Following the close of all applicable comment and request periods, the Executive Director will forward the application and any requests for reconsideration or for a contested case hearing to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting.

The Commission may only grant a request for a contested case hearing on issues the requestor submitted in their timely comments that were not subsequently withdrawn. If a hearing is granted, the subject of a hearing will be limited to disputed issues of fact or mixed questions of fact and law relating to relevant and material water quality concerns submitted during the comment period.
