APPLICATION.

Indie Catch LLC, 5599 San Felipe Street, Suite 565, Houston, Texas 77056, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for new Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0016213001, to authorize the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 975,000 gallons per day.

The facility will be located at 7601 County Road 508, in the City of Alvarado, Johnson County, Texas 76009. The treated effluent will be discharged to Mountain Creek, thence to Joe Pool Lake in Segment No. 0838 of the Trinity River Basin. The unclassified receiving water use is limited aquatic life use for the Mountain Creek. The designated uses for Segment No. 0838 are primary contact recreation, public water supply, and high aquatic life use.

In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code § 307.5 and the TCEQ's *Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards* (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. This review has preliminarily determined that no water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses are present within the stream reach assessed; therefore, no Tier 2 degradation determination is required. No significant degradation of water quality is expected in water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses downstream, and existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received. The TCEQ Executive Director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The

permit application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft permit are available for viewing and copying at Alvarado Public Library, 210 North Baugh Street, Alvarado, Texas.

The hearing will be held unless all timely hearing requests have been withdrawn or denied.

El uso no clasificado del agua receptora es un uso limitado de la vida acuática para Mountain Creek. 

If the facility and discharge point are located or will be located in a municipality, the enclosed notice must be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in the municipality. These requirements may be satisfied by one publication if the newspaper meets all of the above requirements.

The bold text of the enclosed notice must be printed in the newspaper in a font style or size that distinguishes it from the rest of the notice (i.e., bold, italics). Failure to do so may require re-notice.

3. PUBLISH THE NOTICE IN AN ALTERNATIVE LANGUAGE

You must publish notice in an alternative language <u>IF</u>: either the elementary or middle school nearest to the facility or proposed facility is required to provide a "bilingual education program" (BEP) as required by Texas Education Code (TEC), Chapter 29, Subchapter B, and 19 Tex. Your application has been declared administratively complete. You must comply with the following instructions. There are seven (7) steps involved in publishing notice. Complete each step.

1. REVIEW THE NOTICE FOR ACCURACY

Read the enclosed notice carefully and notify the Application Review and Processing Team at 512-239-4671 immediately if it contains any errors or omissions.
