APPLICATION.

Gilden Blair Blackburn and Timothy Edward Carter, 8131 Old Brock Road, Brock, Texas 76087, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for new Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0016124001, to authorize the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 75,000 gallons per day.

The facility will be located approximately 1,265 feet southeast from the intersection of Brock Spur Road and Quanah Hill Road, in Parker County, Texas 76087. The treated effluent will be discharged via a man-made ditch, thence to a roadside ditch, thence to an unnamed tributary, thence to Price Lake, thence to an unnamed tributary, thence to an unnamed pond, thence to an unnamed tributary, thence to the Brazos River Below Possum Kingdom Lake in Segment No. 1206 of the Brazos River Basin. The unclassified receiving water uses are minimal aquatic life use for the man-made ditch and unnamed tributaries, limited aquatic life use for the unnamed pond, and high aquatic life use for Price Lake and Grindstone Creek. The designated uses for Segment No. 1206 are primary contact recreation, public water supply, and high aquatic life use.

In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code §307.5 and the TCEQ implementation procedures (June 2010) for the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards, an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. A Tier 2 review has preliminarily determined that no significant degradation of water quality is expected in Price Lake or Grindstone Creek, which have been identified as having high aquatic life use. Existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received. The TCEQ Executive Director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The permit application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft permit are available for viewing and copying at Weatherford City Hall, 303 Palo Pinto Street, Weatherford, Texas.

CONTESTED CASE HEARING.

The purpose of a preliminary hearing is to establish jurisdiction, name the parties, establish a procedural schedule for the remainder of the proceeding, and to address other matters as determined by the judge. The evidentiary hearing phase of the proceeding, which will occur at a later date, will be similar to a civil trial in state district court. The hearing will address the disputed issues of fact identified in the TCEQ order concerning this application issued on October 2, 2023. In addition to these issues, the judge may consider additional issues if certain factors are met.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001, Texas Government Code; Chapter 26, Texas Water Code; and the procedural rules of the TCEQ and SOAH, including 30 TAC Chapter 80 and 1 TAC Chapter 155. The hearing will be held unless all timely hearing requests have been withdrawn or denied.

To request to be a party, you must attend the hearing and show you would be adversely affected by the application in a way not common to members of the general public. Any person may attend the hearing and request to be a party. Only persons named as parties may participate at the hearing.

In accordance with 1 Tex. Admin. Code § 155.401(a), Notice of Hearing, "Parties that are not represented by an attorney may obtain information regarding contested case hearings on the public website of the State Office of Administrative Hearings at www.soah.texas.gov, or in printed format upon request to SOAH."

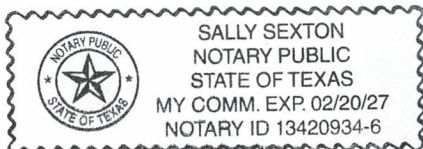
