The party seeking admission of the administrative record must supply copies to the other parties in the proceeding at the time it is offered, or by agreement of the parties.

APPLICATION.

US Ecology Winnie LLC, 26400 Wilber Road, Winnie, Texas 77665-8745, a commercial nonhazardous industrial and municipal waste disposal facility, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for permit renewal and amendments to authorize disposal of nonhazardous wastes generated from the permittee's facility and from other sources, and for amendment to the permits to change the base of the Injection Zone to 4,000 feet below ground level (BGL), change the top of the Injection Zone to 1,076 feet BGL for WDW346, and change the maximum allowable surface injection pressure based on varying waste stream specific gravity for WDW346, WDW347, WDW348, WDW349 and WDW350. The facility is located at 26400 Wilber Road, Winnie, 77665-8745 in Jefferson County, Texas. The TCEQ received this application on May 28, 2019. The TCEQ Executive Director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared draft permits. The draft permits, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that these permits, if issued, meet all statutory and regulatory requirements. The application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft permits are available for viewing and copying at Beaumont Public Library, 801 Pearl Street, Beaumont, Texas 77701.

CONTESTED CASE HEARING.

Considering directives to protect public health, the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) will conduct a preliminary hearing via Zoom videoconference. A Zoom meeting is a secure, free meeting held over the internet that allows video, audio, or audio/video conferencing.

The purpose of a preliminary hearing is to establish jurisdiction, name the parties, establish a procedural schedule for the remainder of the proceeding, and to address other matters as determined by the judge. The evidentiary hearing phase of the proceeding, which will occur at a later date, will be similar to a civil trial in state district court. The hearing will address the disputed issues of fact identified in the TCEQ order concerning this application issued on February 27, 2024. In addition to these issues, the judge may consider additional issues if certain factors are met.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001, Texas Government Code; Chapter 27, Texas Water Code; and the procedural rules of the TCEQ, including 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapters 80, 305, and 331 and SOAH, including 1 TAC Chapter 155. The hearing will be held unless all timely hearing requests have been withdrawn or denied.

To request to be a party, you must attend the hearing and show you would be adversely affected by the application in a way not common to members of the general public. Any person may attend the hearing and request to be a party. Only persons named as parties may participate at the hearing.

In accordance with 1 Tex. Admin. Code § 155.401(a), Notice of Hearing, "Parties that are not represented by an attorney may obtain information regarding contested case hearings on the public website of the State Office of Administrative Hearings at www.soah.texas.gov, or in printed format upon request to SOAH."

A hearing was requested on issues related to your application and the Commission granted this request. The matter has been referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings. Now you must comply with the following instructions:

Please Review Notice

US Ecology Winnie LLC, 26400 Wilber Road, Winnie, Texas 77665-8745, a commercial nonhazardous industrial and municipal waste disposal facility, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for permit renewal and amendments to authorize disposal of nonhazardous wastes generated from the permittee's facility and from other sources, and for amendment to the permits to change the base of the Injection Zone to 4,000 feet below ground level (BGL), change the top of the Injection Zone to 1,076 feet BGL for WDW346, and change the maximum allowable surface injection pressure based on varying waste stream specific gravity for WDW346, WDW347, WDW348, WDW349 and WDW350. The facility is located at 26400 Wilber Road, Winnie, 77665-8745 in Jefferson County, Texas. The TCEQ received this application on May 28, 2019. The draft permits, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that these permits, if issued, meet all statutory and regulatory requirements. The application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft permits are available for viewing and copying at Beaumont Public Library, 801 Pearl Street, Beaumont, Texas 77701.

PUBLIC COMMENT / PUBLIC MEETING. You may submit public comments or request a public meeting about this application. The purpose of a public meeting is to provide the opportunity to submit comments or to ask questions about the application. TCEQ holds a public meeting if the Executive Director determines that there is a significant degree of public interest in the application or if requested by a local legislator. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing.

OPPORTUNITY FOR A CONTESTED CASE HEARING. After the deadline for submitting public comments, the Executive Director will consider all timely comments and prepare a response to all relevant and material, or significant public comments. Unless the application is directly referred for a contested case hearing, the response to comments, and the Executive Director's decision on the application, will be mailed to everyone who submitted public comments and to those persons who are on the mailing list for this application. Following the close of all applicable comment and request periods, the Executive Director will forward the application and any requests for reconsideration or for a contested case hearing to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting. The Commission may only grant a request for a contested case hearing on issues the requestor submitted in their timely comments that were not subsequently withdrawn.

If a hearing is granted, the subject of a hearing will be limited to disputed issues of fact or mixed questions of fact and law that are relevant and material to the Commission's decision on the application submitted during the comment period.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR ACTION. The Executive Director may issue final approval of the application unless a timely contested case hearing request or request for reconsideration is filed. 

The executive director has completed the technical review of your application and issued a preliminary decision. You must comply with the following instructions:

Please Review Notice

We have included in the notice all of the information that we believe is necessary. Please read it carefully and notify us immediately if it contains any errors or omissions. You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information published. You may not change the text or formatting of the notice or affidavit of publication without prior approval from the TCEQ.

Newspaper Notice

- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision within **30** <u>calendar</u> days after the date this information was mailed to you (see date of cover letter).
- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision at your expense, in a newspaper(s) that meets the following requirements:
 - First. You must publish notice either 1) in the newspaper of largest general circulation *that is published in the county* in which the facility is located or is proposed to be located, or 2) if a newspaper is not published in the county, the notice must be published in any newspaper of general circulation in the county;

Included in the notice is all of the necessary information. Please read it carefully and notify Tamara Young at Tamara.Young@tceq.texas.gov immediately if it contains any errors or omissions. You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information published. You may not change the text or formatting of the notice without prior approval from the TCEQ.

Newspaper Notice

- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Receipt of Application and Intent to Obtain
 Permit within 30 calendar days after the date of administrative completeness. Refer to the cover letter for the date of administrative completeness.
- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Receipt of Application and Intent to Obtain Permit at your expense, at least once in a newspaper(s) meeting the following requirements:
 - First. You must publish notice either 1) in the newspaper of largest circulation in the county where the facility is or is proposed to be located or, 2) if the facility is located or is proposed to be located in a municipality, in any newspaper of general circulation in the municipality, and
 - Second. You must publish notice either 1) in the newspaper of largest general circulation that is published in the county in which the facility is located or is proposed to be located, or 2) if a newspaper is not published in the county, the notice must be published in any newspaper of general circulation in the county.
