As you know, the Chief Clerk's Office has referred this matter over to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a contested case hearing on your application.

SOAH will conduct a preliminary hearing via Zoom video conference at:

10:00 a.m. – September 23, 2025

You are now required to publish notice for this hearing. To help you meet the requirements associated with this notice, we have enclosed the following items:

- Notice for Newspaper Publication
- Instructions for Notice of Hearing
- Affidavit of Publication

Please note that it is VERY IMPORTANT that you follow ALL directions in the ENCLOSED INSTRUCTIONS. If you do not, you may be required to republish the notice. One of the most common mistakes we see is the unauthorized changing of notice wording or font. If you have any questions, please contact us before you proceed with publication.

The following items and time limitations are also described in the enclosed instructions. However, due to their importance, we want to highlight them for you.

If you do not comply with all requirements described in the instructions, further processing of your application may be suspended or the commission may take other actions.

As required by 30 TAC § 80.118(c), the TCEQ Office of the Chief Clerk (OCC) will provide the administrative record to SOAH, and will retain one copy for its files. In addition, one copy of the administrative record will be provided to you by the OCC on CD. Neither SOAH nor TCEQ is responsible for providing additional copies to the parties. However, the OCC can provide copies upon request.

The administrative record is not in evidence until properly offered by motion of a party, and subsequently admitted by the Administrative Law Judge, pursuant to 30 TAC § 80.127(h). The party seeking admission of the administrative record must supply copies to the other parties in the proceeding at the time it is offered, or by agreement of the parties.

APPLICATION.

US Ecology Winnie LLC, 26400 Wilber Road, Winnie, Texas 77665-8745, a commercial nonhazardous industrial and municipal waste disposal facility, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for permit renewal and amendments to authorize disposal of nonhazardous wastes generated from the permittee's facility and from other sources, and for amendment to the permits to change the base of the Injection Zone to 4,000 feet below ground level (BGL), change the top of the Injection Zone to 1,076 feet BGL for WDW346, and change the maximum allowable surface injection pressure based on varying waste stream specific gravity for WDW346, WDW347, WDW348, WDW349 and WDW350. The facility is located at 26400 Wilber Road, Winnie, 77665-8745 in Jefferson County, Texas. The TCEQ received this application on May 28, 2019. The TCEQ Executive Director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared draft permits. The draft permits, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that these permits, if issued, meet all statutory and regulatory requirements. The application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft permits are available for viewing and copying at Beaumont Public Library, 801 Pearl Street, Beaumont, Texas 77701.

CONTESTED CASE HEARING.

Considering directives to protect public health, the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) will conduct a preliminary hearing via Zoom videoconference. A Zoom meeting is a secure, free meeting held over the internet that allows video, audio, or audio/video conferencing.

The purpose of a preliminary hearing is to establish jurisdiction, name the parties, establish a procedural schedule for the remainder of the proceeding, and to address other matters as determined by the judge. The evidentiary hearing phase of the proceeding, which will occur at a later date, will be similar to a civil trial in state district court. The hearing will address the disputed issues of fact identified in the TCEQ order concerning this application issued on February 27, 2024. In addition to these issues, the judge may consider additional issues if certain factors are met.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001, Texas Government Code; Chapter 27, Texas Water Code; and the procedural rules of the TCEQ, including 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapters 80, 305, and 331 and SOAH, including 1 TAC Chapter 155. The hearing will be held unless all timely hearing requests have been withdrawn or denied.

To request to be a party, you must attend the hearing and show you would be adversely affected by the application in a way not common to members of the general public. Any person may attend the hearing and request to be a party. Only persons named as parties may participate at the hearing.

In accordance with 1 Tex. Admin. Code § 155.401(a), Notice of Hearing, “Parties that are not represented by an attorney may obtain information regarding contested case hearings on the public website of the State Office of Administrative Hearings at www.soah.texas.gov, or in printed format upon request to SOAH.”

NOTICE OF HEARING

A hearing was requested on issues related to your application and the Commission granted this request. The matter has been referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings. Now you must comply with the following instructions:

Please Review Notice

We have included in the hearing notice all of the information which we believe is necessary. Please read it carefully and notify us immediately if it contains any errors or omissions. You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information published. You may not change the text of the notice without prior approval from the TCEQ.

Newspaper and Mailed Notice

- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Hearing no less than **30** days before the hearing.
- You must publish the notice, at your expense, in a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the facility is located or proposed to be located. You must also publish notice in a newspaper of general circulation in each county which is adjacent or contiguous to each county in which the facility is located or proposed to be located. This requirement may be satisfied by one publication if the newspaper meets all of these requirements.

Proof of Publication

- For each published notice, you must submit proof of publication that shows the notice, the date of publication, and the name of the newspaper to the Office of the Chief Clerk within **10 business days** after the date of publication. Acceptable proof of publication is 1) a copy of the published notice or 2) the original newspaper clipping of the published notice. If you choose to submit a copy of the published notice to the Office of the Chief Clerk, the copy must be on standard-size 8½" x 11" paper and must show the actual size of the published notice (do not reduce the image when



Following the close of all applicable comment and request periods, the Executive Director will forward the application and any requests for reconsideration or for a contested case hearing to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting. The Commission may only grant a request for a contested case hearing on issues the requestor submitted in their timely comments that were not subsequently withdrawn.

If a hearing is granted, the subject of a hearing will be limited to disputed issues of fact or mixed questions of fact and law that are relevant and material to the Commission's decision on the application submitted during the comment period.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR ACTION. The Executive Director may issue final approval of the application unless a timely contested case hearing request or request for reconsideration is filed. If a timely hearing request or request for reconsideration is filed, the Executive Director will not issue final approval of the permit[s] and will forward the application and request to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY DECISION

The executive director has completed the technical review of your application and issued a preliminary decision. You must comply with the following instructions:

Please Review Notice

We have included in the notice all of the information that we believe is necessary. Please read it carefully and notify us immediately if it contains any errors or omissions. You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information published. You may not change the text or formatting of the notice or affidavit of publication without prior approval from the TCEQ.

Newspaper Notice

- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision within **30 calendar days** after the date this information was mailed to you (see date of cover letter).
- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision at your expense, in a newspaper(s) that meets the following requirements:
 - First. You must publish notice either 1) in the newspaper of largest general circulation *that is published in the county* in which the facility is located or is proposed to be located, or 2) if a newspaper is not published in the county, the notice must be published in any newspaper of general circulation in the county;
 - Second. You must publish the enclosed Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision at least once in the same newspaper as the Notice of Receipt of Application and Intent to Obtain Permit; and

If comments are received, the mailing will also provide instructions for requesting reconsideration of the Executive Director's decision and for requesting a contested case hearing.** A contested case hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

TO REQUEST A CONTESTED CASE HEARING, YOU MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN YOUR REQUEST: your name, address, phone number; applicant's name and permit number; the location and distance of your property/activities relative to the facility; a specific description of how you would be adversely affected by the facility in a way not common to the general public; a list of all disputed issues of fact that you submit during the comment period and, the statement "[I/we] request a contested case hearing." If the request for contested case hearing is filed on behalf of a group or association, the request must designate the group's representative for receiving future correspondence; identify by name and physical address an individual member of the group who would be adversely affected by the facility or activity; provide the information discussed above regarding the affected member's location and distance from the facility or activity; explain how and why the member would be affected; and explain how the interests the group seeks to protect are relevant to the group's purpose.

Following the close of all applicable comment and request periods, the Executive Director will forward the application and any requests for reconsideration or for a contested case hearing to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting. The Commission may only grant a request for a contested case hearing on issues the requestor submitted in their timely comments that were not subsequently withdrawn.

If a hearing is granted, the subject of a hearing will be limited to disputed issues of fact or mixed questions of fact and law that are relevant and material to the Commission's decision on the application submitted during the comment period.

You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information published. You may not change the text or formatting of the notice without prior approval from the TCEQ.

Newspaper Notice

- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Receipt of Application and Intent to Obtain Permit within **30 calendar days** after the date of administrative completeness. Refer to the cover letter for the date of administrative completeness.
- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Receipt of Application and Intent to Obtain Permit at your expense, at least once in a newspaper(s) meeting the following requirements:
