NOTICE OF HEARING GLEN E. ANDERS SOAH Docket No. 582-24-06991 TCEQ Docket No. 2023-1607-LIC

APPLICATION.

Glen E. Anders, P.O. Box 486, Texas 76577, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for a Wastewater Operator-Treatment D License. The Executive Director denied Mr. Anders's application for cause. Mr. Anders has requested a formal hearing on the Executive Director's decision. During the review of Mr. Anders' application, the Executive Director discovered that Mr. Anders received two Second-Degree Felonies in 2012. The Executive Director denied Mr. Anders' application because he has been convicted of offenses that directly relate to the license and are sexually violent offenses as referenced in Texas Occupations Code § 53.021(a)(1) and (3).

CONTESTED CASE HEARING.

The State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) will conduct a preliminary hearing via Zoom videoconference. A Zoom meeting is a secure, free meeting held over the internet that allows video, audio, or audio/video conferencing.

The purpose of a preliminary hearing is to establish jurisdiction, name the parties, establish a procedural schedule for the remainder of the proceeding, provide an opportunity for settlement discussions, and address other matters as determined by the administrative law judge. The preliminary hearing will be held unless all timely hearing requests are withdrawn or the parties agree to waive the preliminary hearing.

The evidentiary phase of the contested case hearing, to be held at a later date, will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court to determine whether Mr. Anders should be issued a Wastewater Operator-Treatment D License. Unless agreed to by all parties in attendance at the preliminary hearing, an evidentiary hearing will not be held on the date of this preliminary hearing. If Mr. Anders fails to appear at the preliminary hearing or evidentiary hearing, the Executive Director will request that the hearing be canceled, and that appeal of the Executive Director's decision be dismissed.

Legal Authority: Texas Water Code Chapters 5 and 37; Texas Occupations Code Chapter 53; Texas Government Code, Chapter 2001; 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 30, and the procedural rules of the TCEQ and SOAH, including 30 TAC Chapters 70 and 80 and 1 TAC Chapter 155.
