The party seeking admission of the administrative record must supply copies to the other parties in the proceeding at the time it is offered, or by agreement of the parties.

## NOTICE OF HEARING Stephen Richard Selinger SOAH Docket No. 582-24-08875 TCEQ Docket No. 2023-1667-MWD TPDES Permit No. WQ0016103001

### APPLICATION.

Stephen Richard Selinger, 620 Truelove Trail, Southlake, Texas 76092, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for new Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0016103001, to authorize the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 500,000 gallons per day.

The facility will be located at 1008 Shankle Road, Palmer, in Ellis County, Texas 75152. The treated effluent will be discharged to an unnamed tributary, thence to Fourmile Creek thence to Village Creek, thence to Upper Trinity River in Segment No. 0805 of the Trinity River Basin. The unclassified receiving water uses are minimal aquatic life use for the unnamed tributary and limited aquatic life use for Fourmile Creek. The designated uses for Segment No. 0805 are primary contact recreation and high aquatic life use.

In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code Section 307.5 and the TCEQ's Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. This review has preliminarily determined that no water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses are present within the stream reach assessed; therefore, no Tier 2 degradation determination is required. No significant degradation of water quality is expected in water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses downstream, and existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received. The TCEQ Executive Director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary

decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The permit application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft permit are available for viewing and copying at Ennis Public Library, Front Desk, 501 West Ennis Avenue, Ennis, Texas.

### DIRECT REFERRAL.

The Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision was published in English on August 17, 2022. On December 1, 2023, the Applicant filed a request for direct referral to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH). Therefore, the chief clerk has referred this application directly to SOAH for a hearing on whether the application complies with all applicable statutory and regulatory requirements.

## CONTESTED CASE HEARING.

The State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) will conduct a preliminary hearing via Zoom videoconference. A Zoom meeting is a secure, free meeting held over the internet that allows video, audio, or audio/video conferencing.

The evidentiary hearing phase of the proceeding, which will occur at a later date, will be similar to a civil trial in state district court. The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001, Texas Government Code; Chapter 26, Texas Water Code; TCEQ rules including 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 305; and the procedural rules of the TCEQ and SOAH, including 30 TAC Chapter 80 and 1 TAC Chapter 155. The hearing will be held unless all hearing requests have been withdrawn or denied.

To request to be a party, you must attend the hearing and show you would be adversely affected by the application in a way not common to members of the general public. Any person may attend the hearing and request to be a party. Only persons named as parties may participate at the hearing.

## **NOTICE OF HEARING**

A hearing was requested on issues related to your application and the Commission granted this request. The matter has been referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings. Now you must comply with the following instructions:

## **Please Review Notice**

We have included in the hearing notice all of the information which we believe is necessary. Please read it carefully and notify us immediately if it contains any errors or omissions. You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information published. You may not change the text of the notice without prior approval from the TCEQ.

## **Newspaper Notice**

- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Hearing no less than **30** days before the hearing.
- You must publish the enclosed Notice of Hearing at least once and at your expense, in a newspaper that is regularly published or circulated in each county where, by virtue of the county's geographical relation to the subject matter of the hearing, a person may reasonably believe persons reside who may be affected by the action that may be taken as a result of the hearing. Sheriff Brad Norman has announced that the Ellis County Sheriff's Office Unmanned Aerial

System team is now in operation.
The UAS, or drone, response team consists of seven members of the ECSO Patrol and Criminal Investigation divisions respec-tively. All team members are certified with the FAA as UAS - Part 107 Remote Pilots

"They have all clearly demon-rated that they understand be regulations, operating

requirements, and the procedures for safely flying drones," according to a ECSO media release. "The team went through rigorous training, completed day and night flight operations, flew indoors as well as outdoors, and learned about thermal imaging as some of the training [mem-

bers] went through."

The sheriff office's UAS, or drones, are equipped with spot-lights, speakers, trackers, flare infrared zoom, range finder tracking system, a public address system, and forward-looking

infrared cameras, which provide heat mapping capabilities to cover a large area within a few minutes. "This UAS Response Team

will aid in search and rescue efforts, crime scenes, surveillance and reconnaissance missions and help de-escalate potentially dangerous situations by commu-nicating with people on the location," according to the release. "In addition, using the UAS be-fore entering an area, we can tell just how dangerous or hazardous a scene could be.'



Sheriff Brad Norman has announced that the Ellis County Sheriff's Office Unmanned Aerial System team is now in operation.

The UAS, or drone, response team consists of seven members of the ECSO Patrol and Criminal Investigation divisions respectively. All team members are certified with the FAA as UAS - Part 107 Remote Pilots.
"They have all clearly demon-

strated that they understand the regulations, operating

requirements, and the procedures for safely flying drones," according to a ECSO media release. "The team went through rigorous training, completed day and night flight operations, flew indoors as well as outdoors, and learned about thermal imaging as some of the training [mem-

bers] went through."

The sheriff office's UAS, or The sheriff office's UAS, or drones, are equipped with spot-lights, speakers, trackers, flare infrared zoom, range finder tracking system, a public address system, and forward-looking

infrared cameras, which pro vide heat mapping capabilities to cover a large area within a few minutes.
"This UAS Response Team

will aid in search and rescue efforts, crime scenes, surveillance, and reconnaissance missions and help de-escalate potentially dangerous situations by commu-nicating with people on the loca-tion," according to the release. "In addition, using the UAS before entering an area, we can tell just how dangerous or hazardous a scene could be."



## ECSO announces new drone team

Sheriff Brad Norman has announced that the Ellis County Sheriff's Office Unmanned Aerial System team is now in operation.

The UAS, or drone, response team consists of seven m of the ECSO Patrol and Criminal Investigation divisions respectively. All team members are certified with the FAA as UAS - Part 107 Remote Pilots.
"They have all clearly demon-

strated that they understand the regulations, operating

requirements, and the procedures for safely flying drones," according to a ECSO media release. "The team went through rigorous training, completed day and night flight operations, flew indoors as well as outdoors, and learned about thermal imaging as some of the training (mem-

bers] went through."

The sheriff office's UAS, or drones, are equipped with spot-lights, speakers, trackers, flare infrared zoom, range finder tracking system, a public address system, and forward-looking

"This UAS Response Team will aid in search and rescue efforts, crime scenes, surveillance, and reconnaissance missions and help de-escalate potentially dangerous situations by communicating with people on the location," according to the release.
"In addition, using the UAS before entering an area, we can tell just how dangerous or hazardous a scene could be."



**APPLICATION.** Stephen Richard Selinger, 620 Truelove Trail, Southlake, Texas 76092, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for new Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0016103001, to authorize the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 500,000 gallons per day. TCEQ received this application on January 31, 2022.

The facility will be located at 1008 Shankle Road, Palmer, in Ellis County, Texas 75152. The treated effluent will be discharged to an unnamed tributary, thence to Fourmile Creek, thence to Village Creek, thence to Upper Trinity River in Segment No. 0805 of the Trinity River Basin. The unclassified receiving water uses are minimal aquatic life use for the unnamed tributary, and limited aquatic life use for Fourmile Creek. The designated uses for Segment No. 0805 are primary contact recreation and high aquatic life use. In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code Section 307.5 and the TCEQ's Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. This review has preliminarily determined that no water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses are present within the stream reach assessed; therefore, no Tier 2 degradation determination is required. No significant degradation of water quality is expected in water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses downstream, and existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received. Only relevant and material issues raised during the Formal Comment Period can be considered if a contested case hearing is granted on this permit application.

Stephen Richard Selinger, 620 Truelove Trail, Southlake, Texas 76092, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for new Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0016103001, to authorize the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 500,000 gallons per day. TCEQ received this application on January 31, 2022.

The facility will be located at 1008 Shankle Road, Palmer, in Ellis County, Texas 75152. The treated effluent will be discharged to an unnamed tributary, thence to Fourmile Creek thence to Village Creek, thence to Upper Trinity River in Segment No. 0805 of the Trinity River Basin. The unclassified receiving water uses are minimal aquatic life use for the unnamed tributary and limited aquatic life use for Fourmile Creek. The designated uses for Segment No. 0805 are primary contact recreation and high aquatic life use. In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code Section 307.5 and the TCEQ's Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. This review has preliminarily determined that no water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses are present within the stream reach assessed; therefore, no Tier 2 degradation determination is required. No significant degradation of water quality is expected in water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses downstream, and existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received. 

These requirements may be satisfied by one publication if the newspaper meets all of the above requirements.

The bold text of the enclosed notice must be printed in the newspaper in a font style or size that distinguishes it from the rest of the notice (i.e., bold, italics). Failure to do so may require re-notice.

#### 3. PUBLISH THE NOTICE IN AN ALTERNATIVE LANGUAGE

You must publish notice in an alternative language <u>IF</u>: either the elementary or middle school nearest to the facility or proposed facility is required to provide a "bilingual education program" (BEP) as required by Texas Education Code (TEC), Chapter 29, Subchapter B, and 19 Tex. Admin. Code §89.1205(a) AND one of the following conditions is met:

- students are enrolled in a program at that school;
- students from that school attend a bilingual education program at another location; or
- the school that otherwise would be required to provide a bilingual education program has been granted an exception from the requirements to provide the program as provided for in 19 Tex. Admin. Code §89.1207(a).

A "bilingual education program" is different from an "English as a second language program" (ESL). An ESL program alone, will not require public notice in an alternative language.

If triggered, you must publish the notice in a newspaper or publication primarily published in the alternative language taught in the bilingual education program. Publication in an alternative language section or insert within a large publication which is not printed primarily in that alternative language does not satisfy these requirements. The newspaper or publication must be of general circulation in the county in which the facility and discharge point are located or proposed to be located. If the facility and discharge point are located or proposed to be located in a municipality, and there exists a newspaper or publication of general circulation in the municipality, you must publish the notice only in the newspaper or publication in the municipality.

You must demonstrate a good faith effort to identify a newspaper or publication in the required language. If there is no general circulation newspaper or publication printed in such language, then publishing in that language is not required. You have the burden to demonstrate compliance with these requirements.

If you are required to publish notice in Spanish, you must translate the site-specific information in the notice that is specific to your application, at your own expense. You may then insert the Spanish translation of your site-specific information into a Spanish template developed by the TCEQ. The Spanish templates are available on the TCEQ website at

http://www.tceq.texas.gov/permitting/wastewater/review/wqspanish\_nori.html. If you are required to publish notice in a language other than Spanish, you must translate the entire public notice, at your own expense.

#### 4. PUT THE APPLICATION IN A PUBLIC PLACE

You must put a copy of the administratively complete application in the public place identified in the enclosed notice.

This copy must be accessible to the public for review and copying beginning on the first day of newspaper publication and remain in place for the publication's designated comment period.

During the technical review, you must update the publicly available application so that it includes all application revisions within 10 business days from the date the revision is transmitted to the TCEQ.

For confidential information contained in the application, you must indicate which specific portions of the application cannot be made available to the public. These portions of the application must be accompanied with the following statement: "Any request for portions of this application that are marked as confidential must be submitted in writing, pursuant to the Public Information Act, to the TCEQ Public Information Coordinator, MC 197, P.O. Box 13087, Austin, Texas 78711-3087."

#### 5. PROVIDE PROOF OF PUBLICATION

For each newspaper in which you published, you must submit proof of publication. Proof of publication must include the following:

- a completed Publisher's Affidavit (enclosed); and
- a copy of the published notice which shows the notice, the date published, and the newspaper name. The copy must be on standard-size  $8\frac{1}{2} \times 11$  paper and must show the <u>actual size</u> of the published notice. Do not reduce the

image when making copies. Published notices longer than 11" must be copied onto multiple  $8\frac{1}{2}$  x 11" pages. Or you can submit the original newspaper clipping.

If you are required to publish notice in an alternative language and are unable to do so, complete and submit the Alternative Language Exemption form (enclosed).

#### 6. PROVIDE PROOF OF APPLICATION VIEWING LOCATION

You must submit a completed Public Notice Verification Form (enclosed) which certifies that the administratively complete application was placed at the public place identified in the enclosed notice.

#### 7. SUBMIT PROOFS TO TCEQ

The proof of publication documents (Step 5) and the completed Public Notice Verification Form (Step 6) must be submitted to TCEQ within 30 days of publication.

#### **Additional Information**

If you fail to publish the notice or submit proofs within the timeframes noted above, the TCEQ may suspend further processing on your application or take other actions in accordance with 30 Tex. Admin. Code §39.405(a).

Stephen Richard Selinger, 620 Truelove Trail, Southlake, Texas 76092, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for proposed Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0016103001 (EPA I.D. No. TX0142361) to authorize the discharge of treated wastewater at a volume not to exceed a daily average flow of 500,000 gallons per day. The domestic wastewater treatment facility will be located at 1008 Shankle Road, Palmer, in Ellis County, Texas 75152. The discharge route will be from the plant site to an unnamed tributary; thence to Fourmile Creek; thence to Village Creek; thence to the Upper Trinity River. ADDITIONAL NOTICE. TCEQ's Executive Director has determined the application is administratively complete and will conduct a technical review of the application. After technical review of the application is complete, the Executive Director may prepare a draft permit and will issue a preliminary decision on the application. Notice of the Application and Preliminary Decision will be published and mailed to those who are on the county-wide mailing list and to those who are on the mailing list for this application. That notice will contain the deadline for submitting public comments.

PUBLIC COMMENT / PUBLIC MEETING. You may submit public comments or request a public meeting on this application. The purpose of a public meeting is to provide the opportunity to submit comments or to ask questions about the application. TCEQ will hold a public meeting if the Executive Director determines that there is a significant degree of public interest in the application or if requested by a local legislator. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing.

OPPORTUNITY FOR A CONTESTED CASE HEARING. After the deadline for submitting public comments, the Executive Director will consider all timely comments and prepare a response to all relevant and material, or significant public comments. Unless the application is directly referred for a contested case hearing, the response to comments, and the Executive Director's decision on the application, will be mailed to everyone who submitted public comments and to those persons who are on the mailing list for this application. If comments are received, the mailing will also provide

instructions for requesting reconsideration of the Executive Director's decision and for requesting a contested case hearing. A contested case hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

TO REQUEST A CONTESTED CASE HEARING, YOU MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN YOUR REQUEST: your name, address, phone number; applicant's name and proposed permit number; the location and distance of your property/activities relative to the proposed facility; a specific description of how you would be adversely affected by the facility in a way not common to the general public; a list of all disputed issues of fact that you submit during the comment period and, the statement "[I/we] request a contested case hearing." If the request for contested case hearing is filed on behalf of a group or association, the request must designate the group's representative for receiving future correspondence; identify by name and physical address an individual member of the group who would be adversely affected by the proposed facility or activity; provide the information discussed above regarding the affected member's location and distance from the facility or activity; explain how and why the member would be affected; and explain how the interests the group seeks to protect are relevant to the group's purpose.

Following the close of all applicable comment and request periods, the Executive Director will forward the application and any requests for reconsideration or for a contested case hearing to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting.

The Commission may only grant a request for a contested case hearing on issues the requestor submitted in their timely comments that were not subsequently withdrawn. If a hearing is granted, the subject of a hearing will be limited to disputed issues of fact or mixed questions of fact and law relating to relevant and material water quality concerns submitted during the comment period.

If you submit public comments, a request for a contested case hearing or a reconsideration of the Executive Director's decision, you will be added to the mailing list for this specific application to receive future public notices mailed by the Office of the Chief Clerk.
