#### APPLICATION.

Wilco MUD 45 WWTP, LLC, 3300 Bee Caves Road, Suite 650-1233, West Lake Hills, Texas 78746, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for new Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0016146001, to authorize the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at an annual average flow not to exceed 2,000,000 gallons per day.

The facility will be located approximately 1.56 miles southeast of the Intersection of Farm-to-Market Road 3349 and County, Road 404, In-Williamson Contact recreation, public water supply, aquifer protection, and high aquatic life use. In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code §307.5 and the TCEQ Implementation procedures (June 2010) for the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards, an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1, antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. This review has preliminarily determined that no water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses and present within the stream reach assessed; therefore, no Tier 2 degradation determination is required. No significant degradation of water quality is expected in water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses downstream, and existing uses will

be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. **PETITION.** Ava Rohde and Rummel & Rohde Farms LTD., a Texas limited partnership, (Petitioners) filed a petition for creation of North Fork Municipal Utility District of Williamson County (District) with the Tex-Quality (TCEQ). The petition was filed pursuant to Article XVI, §59 of the Constitution of the State of Tex-as; Chapters 49 and 54 of the Texas Water Code; 30 Texas Administra-

tive Code Chapter 293; and the pro-cedural rules of the TCEQ. The petition states that: (1) the Petitioners hold title to a majority in value of the land to be included in the proposed District; (2) there are no lienholders on the property to be included in the proposed District;
(3) the proposed District will contain approximately 343 acres located within Williamson County, Texas; and (4) none of the land within the proposed District is within the corporate limits or extraterritorial juris-diction of any city.

The territory to be included in the proposed District is depicted in the vicinity map designated as Exhibit "A", which is attached to this doc-

The petition further states that the proposed District will: (1) construct, maintain, and operate a waterworks system, including the purchase and sale of water for domestic and commercial purposes; (2) construct, maintain, and operate a wastewater collection, treatment, and disposal system for domestic and commercial purposes; (3) construct, install, maintain, purchase, and operate drainage and roadway facilities and improvements; and (4) construct, install, maintain, purchase, and operate facilities, systems, plants, and enterprises as shall be consonant proposed District is created.

According to the petition, a preliminary investigation has been made to determine the cost of the project. and it is estimated by the Petitioners that the cost of said project will be approximately \$83.731.000. The financial analysis was based on an assumed funding of an estimated \$53,407,914 (\$47,044,314 for water, wastewater, and drainage plus \$6,363,600 for roads) as presented in application material at the time of



If a contested case hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

The unclassified receiving water use is limited aquatic life use for Boggy Creek. The designated uses for Segment No. 1244 are primary contact recreation, public water supply, aquifer protection, and high aquatic life use.
