The administrative record is not in evidence until properly offered by motion of a party, and subsequently admitted by the Administrative Law Judge, pursuant to 30 TAC § 80.127(h). The party seeking admission of the administrative record must supply copies to the other parties in the proceeding at the time it is offered, or by agreement of the parties.

## **APPLICATION.**

Municipal Operations, LLC, P.O. Box 1689, Spring, Texas 77383, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for new Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0016171001, to authorize the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at an annual average flow not to exceed 1,000,000 gallons per day.

The facility will be located approximately 1.75 miles west-southwest of the intersection of Babcock Road and Scenic Loop Road, in Bexar County, Texas 78023. The unclassified receiving water uses are minimal aquatic life use for Helotes Creek (upstream of unnamed tributary), and limited aquatic life use for the pond and for Helotes Creek (downstream of unnamed tributary). The designated uses for Segment No. 1906 are primary contact recreation, public water supply, and high aquatic life use. In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code § 307.5 and TCEQ's *Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards* (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. A Tier 2 review has preliminarily determined that no significant degradation of water quality is expected in Lower Leon Creek, which have been identified as having high aquatic life uses. Existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received. The TCEQ Executive Director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The permit application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft permit are available for viewing and copying at Igo Library, 13330 Kyle Seale Parkway, San Antonio, Texas.

The purpose of a preliminary hearing is to establish jurisdiction, name the parties, establish a procedural schedule for the remainder of the proceeding, and to address other matters as determined by the judge. The evidentiary hearing phase of the proceeding, which will occur at a later date, will be similar to a civil trial in state district court. The hearing will address the disputed issues of fact identified in the TCEQ order concerning this application issued on August 20, 2024. In addition to these issues, the judge may consider additional issues if certain factors are met.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001, Texas Government Code; Chapter 26, Texas Water Code; and the procedural rules of the TCEQ and SOAH, including 30 TAC Chapter 80 and 1 TAC Chapter 155. The hearing will be held unless all timely hearing requests have been withdrawn or denied.

To request to be a party, you must attend the hearing and show you would be adversely affected by the application in a way not common to members of the general public. Any person may attend the hearing and request to be a party. Only persons named as parties may participate at the hearing.

## **APLICACIÓN.**

P.O. Box 1689, Spring, Texas 77383, ha solicitado a la Comisión de Calidad Ambiental de Texas (TCEQ, por sus siglas en inglés) el nuevo Permiso N.º WQ00 16171001 del Sistema de Eliminación de Descargas de Contaminantes de Texas (TPDES, por sus siglas en inglés), para autorizar la descarga de aguas residuales domésticas tratadas a un flujo promedio anual que no exceda los 1,000,000 galones por día.

La instalación estará ubicada aproximadamente a 1.75 millas al oeste-suroeste de la intersección de Babcock Road y Scenic Loop Road, en el condado de Bexar, Texas 78023. El efluente tratado se descargará a través de tuberías a Helotes Creek, de allí a un estanque, de allí a Helotes Creek, de allí a Culebra Creek, de allí a Lower Leon Creek en el segmento N.º 1906 de la cuenca del río San Antonio. Los usos no clasificados del agua receptora son el uso mínimo de vida acuática para Helotes Creek (aguas arriba de un afluente sin nombre), y el uso limitado de vida acuática para el estanque y para Helotes Creek (aguas abajo de un afluente sin nombre). Los usos designados para el segmento N.º 1906 son la recreación de contacto primario, el suministro público de agua y el alto uso de la vida acuática. De acuerdo con 30 Código Administrativo de Texas § 307.5 y los Procedimientos de la TCEQ *para implementar los Estándares de Calidad del Agua Superficial de Texas* (junio del 2010), se realizó una revisión antidegradación de las aguas receptoras. Una revisión antidegradación de Nivel 1 ha determinado preliminarmente que los usos existentes de la calidad del agua no se verán afectados por esta acción de permiso. Se mantendrán criterios numéricos y narrativos para proteger los usos existentes. Una revisión de Nivel 2 ha determinado preliminarmente que no se espera una degradación significativa de la calidad del agua en Lower Leon Creek, que se ha identificado que tiene altos usos de vida acuática. Los usos existentes se mantendrán y protegerán. La determinación preliminar puede ser reexaminada y puede ser modificada si se recibe nueva información. ### NOTICE OF HEARING

A hearing was requested on issues related to your application and the Commission granted this request. The matter has been referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings. Now you must comply with the following instructions:

the first A&M golfer to do so. Sam, now a senior at A&M and still an amateur, said he heard from old and new friends alike after winning the U.S. Amateur, including an entire elite ball around Interstate 45 long before I-45 existed.

"The whole town of Madisonville," Sam said, in only halfway kidding. These days Madisonville, established in 1853 about 30 miles to the northwest of Huntsville, is best known for a Buc-ees along the interstate — and for being home to a U.S. amateur champ.

Mark like Sam, was born and raised in Madisonville, and became a prominent dentist in town. About nine years ago, however, Mark began dealing with the early onset of Alzheimer's disease, the most common form of dementia that causes the brain to shrink and brain cells to die, according to the Mayo Clinic.

Mark Bennett died in the summer of 2021, a year before Sam won the U.S. Amateur.

"When I was little he would always tell me, you need to sign up for the U.S. junior amateur qualifier, that was his dream," Sam recalled. "He'd just be happy that I was respecting the game and doing things the right way ... that's what is tough ... I'll win this or this and I'll sign, dang, I wish he would have seen that."

"I'll send him text messages on my phone to his number, long paragraphs ... the (Amateur) text message was maybe a little longer than some others."

One of Mark's final verbal messages to Sam was "Don't want to do something" which Sam has tattooed on his arm as a constant reminder of a valued piece of advice from his late father.

Sam excelled at golf, tennis, basketball and baseball at Madisonville. He was all-district in basketball from 2005-17, team defensive most valuable player in baseball in 2007 and a 2006 district champion in tennis.

But Sam truly set himself apart in golf, and he was the Class A state champion in 2016 and Class 4A state runner-up in 2017. By the time he was a junior at A&M he was a first team All-American, and last year he became the 22nd amateur champion, joining past winners like Bryson DeChambeau (2005), Tiger Woods (1994, 1995), Phil Mickelson (1990) and Jack Nicklaus (1959).

A&M golf coach Brian Kortan, who served as Bennett's caddy at the U.S. Amateur and is doing so again at the Masters, was with Bennett a couple of weeks ago for a practice round at the Masters.

"It's everything you think it's going to be," Kortan said of the immaculate and historic course. "It's beautiful, it's big, the detail ... it's like a painting. There's nothing different than you'd imagine. Every blade of grass looks like it's been given its due attention ... And Sam earned his way in."

Bennett is 5-foot-10 and thin, but he appeared ready to take on the world — and the world's best — following a practice round on Tuesday at the Masters. "I'm soaking it all in and I feel like I'm prepared," Bennett told reporters in Augusta. "It's cool being an amateur and I'm going to have fun, but I'm not going to treat it like a hit and giggle. I'm here to compete and test my game."







The treated effluent will be discharged via pipe to Helotes Creek, thence to impounded Helotes Creek, thence to Helotes Creek, thence to Culebra Creek, thence to Lower Leon Creek in Segment No. 1906 of the San Antonio River Basin. The unclassified receiving water uses are minimal aquatic life use for Helotes Creek (upstream of unnamed tributary), and limited aquatic life use for the pond and for Helotes Creek (downstream of unnamed tributary). The designated uses for Segment No. 1906 are primary contact recreation, public water supply, and high aquatic life use. In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code § 307.5 and TCEQ's *Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards* (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. A Tier 2 review has preliminarily determined that no significant degradation of water quality is expected in Lower Leon Creek, which have been identified as having high aquatic life uses. Existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received. 

act, are acting aggressively to bring it under control. The Fed is charged with ensuring price stability as well as maximum employment. The former is the more pressing now.

In August, the unemployment rate stood at 3.7 percent across the nation, and 4.1 percent in Texas. Consumer prices, however, rose 8.3 percent over the previous 12 months.

Fed Chairman Jerome Powell has made no secret that tacking inflation remains his top priority, even in the face of slowing job growth in Texas and across the nation. In August, he said that he's going to keep fighting even though higher interest rates and slower growth will bring "some pain" to households and businesses alike.

In fact, some investors had expected an even larger interest rate hike to be announced this week. And economists expect further rate hikes in coming months, which could bring the federal funds rate to 4.25 percent by the end of the year, and even higher in 2023.

The Fed is moving "purposefully," Powell said Wednesday, in pursuit of 2 percent inflation, its long-term goal, and Americans should expect officials to continue along this path for the time being.

"We think that we'll need to bring our funds rate to a restrictive level

and keep it there for some time," he said Wednesday, at a press conference, adding: "No one knows if this process will lead to a recession."

Don't peek at your 401(k). In advance of the Fed's announcement Wednesday, the Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 147 points. The Nasdaq Composite index and the S&P 500 were both up nearly 1 percent.

But after the Fed announced and its forecast, the three indexes fell, briefly rebounded, then plunged. The Dow fell more than 500 points on nearly a 2 percent decline. The Nasdaq and S&P also lost nearly 2 percent.

It's been a tumultuous summer for the markets as investors worry the Fed's aggressive posture will tip the economy into recession. In recent days, stocks in every sector has lost some ground, although there are of course exceptions.

Shares of General Mills, for example, jumped by 6.9 percent Wednesday, after the consumer foods giant reported higher sales and earnings than expected in the first quarter. General Mills has also raised its outlook for both sales and profit for the whole year.

ness loan. Consumers and businesses then presumably borrow and spend less, cooling the economy and slowing inflation.

Falling gas prices have slightly lowered headline inflation, which was a stimulus 8.3 percent in August compared with a year earlier. Those declining prices at the gas pump might have contributed to a recent rise in President Joe Biden's public approval ratings, which Democrats hope will boost their prospects in the November midterm elections.

Speaking at a news conference, Chair Jerome Powell said that before Fed officials would consider halting their rate hikes, they would "want to be very confident that inflation is moving back down" to their 2 percent target. He noted that the strength of the job market is fueling pay gains that are helping drive up inflation.

Short-term rates at which the Fed is now envisioning would make a recession likelier next year by sharply raising the costs of mortgages, car loans and business loans. Last week, the average fixed mortgage rate topped 6 percent, its highest point in 14 years, which helps explain why home sales have tumbled. Credit card borrowing costs have reached their highest level since 1996, according to Bankrate.com.

Inflation now appears increasingly fueled by higher wages and by consumers' steady desire to spend and less by the supply shortages that had bedeviled the economy during the pandemic recession. On Sunday, Biden said on CBS' "60 Minutes" that he believed a soft landing for the economy was still possible, suggesting that his administration's recent energy and health care legislation would lower prices for pharmaceuticals and health care.

The law may help lower prescription drug prices, but outside analyses suggest it will do little to immediately bring down overall inflation. Last month, the nonpartisan Congressional Budget Office judged it would have a "negligible" effect on prices through 2023.

tain terrain. Some industries, including housing and automobiles, are directly sensitive to interest rate changes, as consumers typically finance those purchases. Those industries could be looking at a rough road ahead, as the highest interest rates in more than a decade discourage Americans who were contemplating the plunge. Economists are keeping a particularly close eye on the housing market, which has been a major contributor to inflation over the past year — second only to energy,

notes Ruben Gonzalez, chief economist for real estate firm Keller Williams. Today's rate increase signals that mortgage rates, which last week leapt above 6 percent for the first time in six years, could continue to increase. Higher borrowing costs are cooling the market after more than two years of soaring prices and frenzied bidding.

"We expect existing home sales to finish the year down nearly 30 percent, and for the slower pace of home sales to persist into the beginning of 2023," Gonzalez said.

Your application has been declared administratively complete. You must comply with the following instructions. There are seven (7) steps involved in publishing notice. Complete each step.

**1. REVIEW THE NOTICE FOR ACCURACY**

**Read the enclosed notice carefully and notify the Application Review and Processing Team at 512-239-4671 immediately if it contains any errors or omissions.** You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information published. Do not change the text or formatting of the notice or affidavit of publication without prior approval from the TCEQ. Changing the text or formatting of the notice may require new publication at your expense and delay processing of your application.

**2. PUBLISH THE NOTICE IN THE NEWSPAPER**

**You must publish the enclosed notice within 30 days after the date of administrative completeness.** Refer to the cover letter for the date of administrative completeness.

If the facility and discharge point are located or will be located in a municipality, the enclosed notice must be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in the municipality. The bold text of the enclosed notice must be printed in the newspaper in a font style or size that distinguishes it from the rest of the notice (i.e., bold, italics). Failure to do so may require re-notice.

**3. PUBLISH THE NOTICE IN AN ALTERNATIVE LANGUAGE**

**You must publish notice in an alternative language IF:** either the elementary or middle school nearest to the facility or proposed facility is required to provide a “bilingual education program” (BEP) as required by Texas Education Code (TEC), Chapter 29, Subchapter B, and 19 Tex. Admin. Code §89.1205(a) AND one of the following conditions is met:

- students are enrolled in a program at that school;
- students from that school attend a bilingual education program at another location; or
- the school that otherwise would be required to provide a bilingual education program has been granted an exception from the requirements to provide the program as provided for in 19 Tex. Admin. Code §89.1207(a).
