APPLICATION.

Kelly Ranch Estates, LLC, 1800 Lone Oak Road, Suite 8, Weatherford, Texas 76086, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for new Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0016370001, to authorize the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at an annual average flow not to exceed 2,250,000 gallons per day.

The facility will be located approximately 1,000 feet west of the intersection of Kelly Road and U.S. Route 377, in Parker County, Texas 76035. The treated effluent will be discharged to Bear Creek, thence to Benbrook Lake in Segment No. 0830 of the Trinity River Basin. The unclassified receiving water use is high aquatic life use for Bear Creek. The designated uses for Segment No. 0830 are primary contact recreation, public water supply, and high aquatic life use. In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code § 307.5 and the TCEO's Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. A Tier 2 review has preliminarily determined that no significant degradation of water quality is expected in Bear Creek, which has been identified as having high aquatic life use. Existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received. The TCEQ Executive Director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The permit application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft permit are available for viewing and copying at East Parker County Library, 201 Farm-to-Market Road 1187 North, Aledo, Texas.

DIRECT REFERRAL.

The Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision was published on March 16, 2024. On August 21, 2024, the Applicant filed a request for direct referral to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH). Therefore, the chief clerk has referred this application directly to SOAH for a hearing on whether the application complies with all applicable statutory and regulatory requirements.

CONTESTED CASE HEARING.

The State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) will conduct a preliminary hearing via Zoom videoconference. A Zoom meeting is a secure, free meeting held over the internet that allows video, audio, or audio/video conferencing.

The purpose of a preliminary hearing is to establish jurisdiction, name the parties, establish a procedural schedule for the remainder of the proceeding, and to address other matters as determined by the judge. The evidentiary hearing phase of the proceeding, which will occur at a later date, will be similar to a civil trial in state district court. The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001, Texas Government Code; Chapter 26, Texas Water Code; TCEQ rules including 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 305; and the procedural rules of the TCEQ and SOAH, including 30 TAC Chapter 80 and 1 TAC Chapter 155. The hearing will be held unless all hearing requests have been withdrawn or denied.

To request to be a party, you must attend the hearing and show you would be adversely affected by the application in a way not common to members of the general public. Any person may attend the hearing and request to be a party. Only persons named as parties may participate at the hearing.

Kelly Ranch Estates, LLC, 1800 Lone Oak Road, Suite 8, Weatherford, Texas 76086, ha solicitado a la Comisión de Calidad Ambiental de Texas (TCEQ) el nuevo Permiso No. WQ00 16370001 del Sistema de Eliminación de Descargas Contaminantes de Texas (TPDES), para autorizar la descarga de aguas residuales domésticas tratadas a un caudal promedio anual que no exceda 2.250.000 galones por día.

La instalación estará ubicada aproximadamente a 1,000 pies al oeste de la intersección de Kelly Road y la ruta estadounidense 377, en el condado de Parker, Texas 76035. El efluente tratado se descargará a Bear Creek y de allí al lago Benbrook en el segmento 0830 de la cuenca del río Trinity. El uso de agua receptora no clasificada es un uso intensivo de vida acuática para Bear Creek. Los usos designados para el Segmento No. 0830 son recreación de contacto primario, suministro público de agua y uso intensivo de vida acuática. De acuerdo con 30 Código Administrativo de Texas § 307.5 y los Procedimientos de la TCEQ para implementar los Estándares de Calidad del Agua Superficial de Texas (junio de 2010), se realizó una revisión de antidegradación de las aguas receptoras. Una revisión antidegradación de Nivel 1 ha determinado preliminarmente que los usos existentes de la calidad del agua no se verán afectados por esta acción de permiso. Se mantendrán criterios numéricos y narrativos para proteger los usos existentes. Una revisión de Nivel 2 ha determinado preliminarmente que no se espera una degradación significativa de la calidad del agua en Bear Creek, que ha sido identificado como de alto uso para la vida acuática. Los usos existentes se mantendrán y protegerán. La determinación preliminar puede reexaminarse y modificarse si se recibe nueva información. Your application has been declared administratively complete. You must comply with the following instructions. There are seven (7) steps involved in publishing notice. Complete each step.

1. REVIEW THE NOTICE FOR ACCURACY

Read the enclosed notice carefully and notify the Application Review and Processing Team at 512-239-4671 immediately if it contains any errors or omissions. You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information published. Do not change the text or formatting of the notice or affidavit of publication without prior approval from the TCEQ. Changing the text or formatting of the notice may require new publication at your expense and delay processing of your application.

2. PUBLISH THE NOTICE IN THE NEWSPAPER

You must publish the enclosed notice within 30 days after the date of administrative completeness. Refer to the cover letter for the date of administrative completeness.

You must publish the enclosed notice at your expense, at least once in the newspaper of largest circulation within each county where the facility and discharge point are located or will be located. If the facility and discharge point are located or will be located in a municipality, the enclosed notice must be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in the municipality. These requirements may be satisfied by one publication if the newspaper meets all of the above requirements.

The bold text of the enclosed notice must be printed in the newspaper in a font style or size that distinguishes it from the rest of the notice (i.e., bold, italics). Failure to do so may require re-notice.

3. PUBLISH THE NOTICE IN AN ALTERNATIVE LANGUAGE

You must publish notice in an alternative language <u>IF</u>: either the elementary or middle school nearest to the facility or proposed facility is required to provide a "bilingual education program" (BEP) as required by Texas Education Code (TEC), Chapter 29, Subchapter B, and 19 Tex. Admin. Code §89.1205(a) AND one of the following conditions is met:

- students are enrolled in a program at that school;
- students from that school attend a bilingual education program at another location; or
