As you know, the Chief Clerk's Office has referred this matter over to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a contested case hearing on your application.

SOAH will conduct a preliminary hearing via Zoom video conference at:

10:00 a.m. – May 13, 2025

As required by 30 TAC § 80.118(c), the TCEQ Office of the Chief Clerk (OCC) will provide the administrative record to SOAH, and will retain one copy for its files. In addition, one copy of the administrative record will be provided to you by the OCC on CD. Neither SOAH nor TCEQ is responsible for providing additional copies to the parties. However, the OCC can provide copies upon request.

The administrative record is not in evidence until properly offered by motion of a party, and subsequently admitted by the Administrative Law Judge, pursuant to 30 TAC § 80.127(h). The party seeking admission of the administrative record must supply copies to the other parties in the proceeding at the time it is offered, or by agreement of the parties.

APPLICATION.

Douglas T. Harrison, 1000 Harrison Road, New Braunfels, Texas 78132, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for new Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit. No. WQ0016211001, to authorize the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 600,000 gallons per day.

The facility will be located approximately 0.4 miles south of the intersection of Harrison Road and State Highway 46, in Comal County, Texas 78132. The treated effluent will be discharged to West Fork Dry Comal Creek, thence to Dry Comal Creek, thence to the Comal River in Segment No. 1811 of the Guadalupe River Basin. The unclassified receiving water use is limited aquatic life use for the West Fork Dry Comal Creek. The designated uses for Segment No. 1811 are primary contact recreation, public water supply, aquifer protection, and high aquatic life use. In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code §307.5 and TCEQ's Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. This review has preliminarily determined that no water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses are present within the stream reach assessed; therefore, no Tier 2 degradation determination is required. No significant degradation of water quality is expected in water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses downstream, and existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received. The TCEQ Executive Director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The

permit application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft permit are available for viewing and copying at Mammen Family Public Library, 131 Bulverde Crossing Road, Bulverde, Texas.

CONTESTED CASE HEARING.

The purpose of a preliminary hearing is to establish jurisdiction, name the parties, establish a procedural schedule for the remainder of the proceeding, and to address other matters as determined by the judge. The evidentiary hearing phase of the proceeding, which will occur at a later date, will be similar to a civil trial in state district court. The hearing will address the disputed issues of fact identified in the TCEQ order concerning this application issued on January 23, 2025. In addition to these issues, the judge may consider additional issues if certain factors are met.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001, Texas Government Code; Chapter 26, Texas Water Code; and the procedural rules of the TCEQ and SOAH, including 30 TAC Chapter 80 and 1 TAC Chapter 155. The hearing will be held unless all timely hearing requests have been withdrawn or denied.

To request to be a party, you must attend the hearing and show you would be adversely affected by the application in a way not common to members of the general public. Any person may attend the hearing and request to be a party. Only persons named as parties may participate at the hearing.

In accordance with 1 Tex. Admin. Code § 155.401(a), Notice of Hearing, “Parties that are not represented by an attorney may obtain information regarding contested case hearings on the public website of the State Office of Administrative Hearings at www.soah.texas.gov, or in printed format upon request to SOAH.”

APLICACIÓN.

Douglas T. Harrison, 1000 Harrison Road, New Braunfels, TX 78132 ha solicitado a la Comisión de Calidad Ambiental del Estado de Texas (TCEQ) por un nuevo para autorizar discharge of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average Flow not to exceed 600,000 gallons per day.

La instalación estará ubicada aproximadamente a 0.4 millas al sur de la intersección de Harrison Road y State Highway 46, en el condado de Comal, Texas 78132. El efluente tratado se descargará al arroyo Comal seco West Fork, de allí al arroyo Comal seco, de allí al río Comal en el Segmento No. 1811 de la cuenca del río Guadalupe. El uso de agua receptora no clasificado es el uso limitado de la vida acuática para el arroyo West Fork Cry Comal. Los usos designados para el Segmento No. 1811 son la recreación de contacto primario, el suministro público de agua, la protección de acuíferos y el uso de alta vida acuática. De acuerdo con 30 Código Administrativo de Texas §307.5 y los Procedimientos para Implementar los Estándares de Calidad del Agua Superficial de Texas de TCEQ (junio de 2010), se realizó una revisión antidegradación de las aguas receptoras. Una revisión antidegradación de Nivel 1 ha determinado preliminarmente que los usos de la calidad del agua existentes no se verán afectados por esta acción de permiso. Se mantendrán los criterios numéricos y descriptivos para proteger los usos existentes. Esta revisión ha determinado preliminarmente que no hay cuerpos de agua con usos excepcionales, altos o intermedios de vida acuática dentro del tramo de arroyo evaluado; por lo tanto, no se requiere una determinación de degradación de Nivel 2. No se espera una degradación significativa de la calidad del agua en los cuerpos de agua con usos excepcionales, altos o intermedios de la vida acuática aguas abajo, y los usos existentes se mantendrán y protegerán. La determinación preliminar puede ser reexaminada y puede ser modificada si se recibe nueva información. 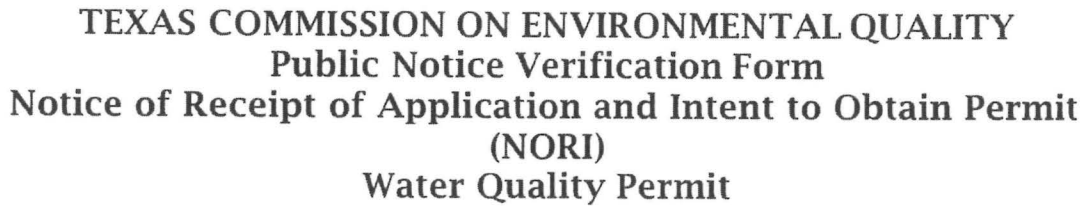

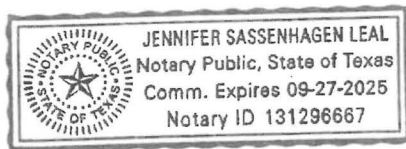

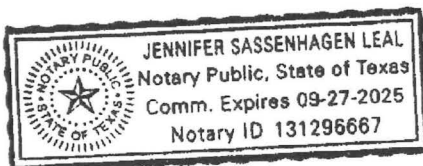

Harrison, 1000 Harrison Road, New Braunfels, Texas 78132, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for new Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0016211001, to authorize the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 600,000 gallons per day. TCEQ received this application on September 1, 2022.

The facility will be located approximately 0.4 miles south of the intersection of Harrison Road and State Highway 46, in Comal County, Texas 78132. The treated effluent will be discharged to West Fork Dry Comal Creek, thence to Dry Comal Creek, thence to the Comal River in Segment No. 1811 of the Guadalupe River Basin. The unclassified receiving water use is limited aquatic life use for the West Fork Dry Comal Creek. The designated uses for Segment No. 1811 are primary contact recreation, public water supply, aquifer protection, and high aquatic life use. In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code §307.5 and TCEQ's *Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards* (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. This review has preliminarily determined that no water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses are present within the stream reach assessed; therefore, no Tier 2 degradation determination is required. No significant degradation of water quality is expected in water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses downstream, and existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received. The bold text of the enclosed notice must be printed in the newspaper in a font style or size that distinguishes it from the rest of the notice (i.e., bold, italics). Failure to do so may require re-notice.

3. PUBLISH THE NOTICE IN AN ALTERNATIVE LANGUAGE

You must publish notice in an alternative language IF: either the elementary or middle school nearest to the facility or proposed facility is required to provide a "bilingual education program" (BEP) as required by Texas Education Code (TEC), Chapter 29, Subchapter B, and 19 Tex. Admin. Code §89.1205(a) AND one of the following conditions is met:

- students are enrolled in a program at that school;
- students from that school attend a bilingual education program at another location; or
- the school that otherwise would be required to provide a bilingual education program has been granted an exception from the requirements to provide the program as provided for in 19 Tex. Admin. Code §89.1207(a).

For confidential information contained in the application, you must indicate which specific portions of the application cannot be made available to the public. These portions of the application must be accompanied with the following statement: "Any request for portions of this application that are marked as confidential must be submitted in writing, pursuant to the Public Information Act, to the TCEQ Public Information Coordinator, MC 197, P.O. Box 13087, Austin, Texas 78711-3087."

5. PROVIDE PROOF OF PUBLICATION

For each newspaper in which you published, you must submit proof of publication. Proof of publication must include the following:

- a completed Publisher's Affidavit (enclosed); and
- a copy of the published notice which shows the notice, the date published, and the newspaper name. The copy must be on standard-size 8½ x 11" paper and must show the actual size of the published notice. Do not reduce the image when making copies. Published notices longer than 11" must be

copied onto multiple 8½ x 11" pages. Or you can submit the original newspaper clipping.

If you are required to publish notice in an alternative language and are unable to do so, complete and submit the Alternative Language Exemption form (enclosed).

Your application has been declared administratively complete. You must comply with the following instructions. There are seven (7) steps involved in publishing notice. Complete each step.

1. REVIEW THE NOTICE FOR ACCURACY

Read the enclosed notice carefully and notify the Application Review and Processing Team at 512-239-4671 immediately if it contains any errors or omissions. You are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of all information published. Do not change the text or formatting of the notice or affidavit of publication without prior approval from the TCEQ. Changing the text or formatting of the notice may require new publication at your expense and delay processing of your application.

2. PUBLISH THE NOTICE IN THE NEWSPAPER

You must publish the enclosed notice within 30 days after the date of administrative completeness. Refer to the cover letter for the date of administrative completeness.
