APPLICATION.

Douglas T. Harrison, 1000 Harrison Road, New Braunfels, Texas 78132, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for new Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit. No. WQ0016211001, to authorize the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 600,000 gallons per day.

The facility will be located approximately 0.4 miles south of the intersection of Harrison Road and State Highway 46, in Comal County, Texas 78132. The treated effluent will be discharged to West Fork Dry Comal Creek, thence to Dry Comal Creek, thence to the Comal River in Segment No. 1811 of the Guadalupe River Basin. The unclassified receiving water use is limited aquatic life use for the West Fork Cry Comal Creek. The designated uses for Segment No. 1811 are primary contact recreation, public water supply, aquifer protection, and high aquatic life use. In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code §307.5 and TCEO's Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. This review has preliminarily determined that no water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses are present within the stream reach assessed; therefore, no Tier 2 degradation determination is required. No significant degradation of water quality is expected in water bodies with exceptional, high, or intermediate aquatic life uses downstream, and existing uses will be maintained and protected. The preliminary determination can be reexamined and may be modified if new information is received. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The evidentiary hearing phase of the proceeding, which will occur at a later date, will be similar to a civil trial in state district court. The hearing will address the disputed issues of fact identified in the TCEO order concerning this application issued on January 23, 2025. In addition to these issues, the judge may consider additional issues if certain factors are met.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001, Texas Government Code: Chapter 26, Texas Water Code: and the procedural rules of the TCEO and SOAH. including 30 TAC Chapter 80 and 1 TAC Chapter 155. The hearing will be held unless all timely hearing requests have been withdrawn or denied.

To request to be a party, you must attend the hearing and show you would be adversely affected by the application in a way not common to members of the general public. Any person may attend the hearing and request to be a party. Only persons named as parties may participate at the hearing.
