

Information provided indicates that the City did not consent to the inclusion of the land into the District's area. After the 90-day period passed without receiving the City's consent to the annexation, a petition was submitted to the City requesting the City provide water and sanitary sewer services to the proposed annexation area. The 120-day period for reaching a mutually agreeable contract expired and the information provided indicates that the Petitioners and the City have not executed a mutually agreeable contract for service. Pursuant to Local Government Code § 42.042, failure to execute such an agreement constitutes authorization for the Petitioners to initiate proceedings to include the proposed annexation area into the District. The territory to be annexed into the District is depicted in the vicinity map designated as Exhibit "A," which is attached to this docu

If a hearing request is filed, the Executive Director will not approve the amended petition and will forward the amended petition and hearing request to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting. If a contested case hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.


