PETITION.

Crystal Clear Special Utility District (the "District") filed an application with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for authority to levy a revised impact fee of \$5,163 per standard residential connection within the District's service area. The District files this application under the authority of Chapter 395 of the Local Government Code, 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 293, and the procedural rules of the TCEQ.

The purpose of impact fees is to generate revenue to recover the costs of capital improvements or facility expansions made necessary by and attributable to serving new development in the District's service area. At the direction of the District, a registered engineer has prepared a capital improvements plan for the system that identifies the capital improvements or facility expansions and their costs for which the impact fees will be assessed.

The impact fee application and supporting information are available for inspection and copying during regular business hours in the Districts Section of the Water Supply Division, Third Floor of Building F (in the TCEQ Park 35 Office Complex located between Yager and Braker lanes on North IH-35), 12100 Park 35 Circle, Austin, Texas 78753. A copy of the impact fee application and supporting information, as well as the capital improvements plan, is available for inspection and copying at the District's office during regular business hours.

CONTESTED CASE HEARING.

The State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) will conduct a preliminary hearing via Zoom videoconference. A Zoom meeting is a secure, free meeting held over the internet that allows video, audio, or audio/video conferencing.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001, Texas Government Code; Chapters 49 and 54, Texas Water Code; Chapter 395, Texas Local Government Code; TCEQ rules, including 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 293; and the procedural rules of the TCEQ and SOAH, including 30 TAC Chapter 80 and 1 TAC Chapter 155. To participate in the hearing as a party, you must attend the hearing and show you would be affected by the petition in a way not common to members of the general public.

In accordance with 1 Tex. Admin. Code § 155.401(a), Notice of Hearing, "Parties that are not represented by an attorney may obtain information regarding contested case hearings on the public website of the State Office of Administrative Hearings at www.soah.texas.gov, or in printed format upon request to SOAH."



A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF CRYSTAL CLEAR SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT APPROVING IMPACT FEE STUDY AND RESULTING IMPACT FEE AMOUNT, APPROVING LAND USE PLAN AND AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF PROPOSED IMPACT FEE ADJUSTMENT TO THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY FOR APPROVAL

WHEREAS, Crystal Clear Special Utility District ("CCSUD") is a special utility district created under the process established through its enabling legislation, Texas Special District Local Laws Code Chapter 7206; and

WHEREAS, Section 7206.002 of CCSUD's enabling legislation provides that CCSUD is a special utility district created under and essential to accomplish the purposes of Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution; and

WHEREAS, Section 7206.002(c) authorizes CCSUD to increase its water service impact fee "as provided by Chapter 395, Local Government Code, as approved by the commission, or as otherwise provided by law"; and

WHEREAS, Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 395, Section 395.080(b) provides in relevant part that "any district created under Article XVI, Section 59... of the Texas constitution may petition the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission for approval of any proposed impact fees, charges, fees, assessments, or contributions"; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) is the successor agency to the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission and has promulgated rules at 30 Texas Administrative Code Sections 293.171 through 293.176 governing the process for a special district to petition for approval of an increase in impact fees; and

WHEREAS, CCSUD retained Willdan Financial Services, a professional rate consultant, to conduct an impact fee study and to work with M&S Engineering, CCSUD's consulting engineering firm, to develop the capital improvements plan supporting CCSUD's proposed impact fee adjustment; and

WHEREAS, the results of the capital improvements plan and impact fee study recommending a revised impact fee of \$2,896 per standard residential connection, subject to approval by the TCEQ, were presented to and approved by the CCSUD board of directors at its duly-noticed regular board of directors meeting on January 27, 2022; and;

WHEREAS, in the period since board approval of the revised impact fee of \$2,896, M&S Engineering has developed and finalized the land use assumptions and mapping required by the TCEQ; and

CCSUD Impact Fee Resolution

WHEREAS, by the adoption of this resolution, the District approves the Capital Improvement Plan, Land Use Assumptions and establishes new Impact Fees to be assessed upon approval by the TCEQ for all new development;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF CRYSTAL CLEAR SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT:

- 1. That CCSUD, by and through its Board of Directors, hereby reaffirms and ratifies its prior approval of the revised impact fee amount of \$2,896 as set forth in the study developed by CCSUD's updated capital improvements plan.
- 2. That CCSUD, by and through its Board of Directors, approves the land use assumptions and mapping presented to the CCSUD Board of Directors at its May 26, 2022 duly-noticed regular board meeting.
- 3. That CCSUD further authorizes its officers and general manager to take any and all reasonable and necessary steps acting through CCSUD's retained attorneys and consultants to cause to be submitted to TCEQ a petition for consideration of CCSUD's requested adjusted water service impact fee of \$2,896 per standard residential connection.
- 4. That should any paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or section of this Resolution be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Resolution as a whole, or any part or provision hereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of the current impact fee structure previously in effect by the District.



To request a contested case hearing, you must submit the following: (1) your name (or for a group or association, an official representative), mailing address, daytime phone number, and fax number, if any; (2) the name of the petitioner and the TCEQ Internal Control Number; (3) the statement "I/we request a contested case hearing"; (4) a brief description of how you would be affected by the petition in a way not common to the general public; and (5) the location of your property relative to the proposed District's boundaries. You may also submit your proposed adjustments to the application. Requests for a contested case hearing must be submitted in writing to the Office of the Chief Clerk at the address provided in the information section below.

The Executive Director may approve the application unless a written request for a contested case hearing is filed within 30 days after the newspaper publication of this notice. If a hearing request is filed, the Executive Director will not approve the petition and will forward the petition and hearing request to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting to determine whether a contested case hearing will be held. If a contested case hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

NOTICE OF COMMENCEMENT STAGE IV CRITICAL PERIOD FOR SAN ANTONIO POOL

The purpose of this notice is to advise Edwards Aquifer (Aquifer) groundwater withdrawal permit holders that the General Manager of the Edwards Aquifer Authority (EAA) determined that the criteria for declaring Stage IV of the EAA Critical Period Management Plan (CPM) have been satisfied. The General Manager hereby gives notice of implementation of Stage IV of the CPM in the San Antonio Pool effective August 22, 2024. When water levels of the Aquifer or springflows of Comal Springs or San Marcos Springs decline below certain levels, the CPM requires reductions in withdrawals from the Aquifer. This plan is designed to slow the rate of decline of Aquifer levels or springflows. During a stage of the CPM, a permit holder's groundwater withdrawal amount authorized within an Initial Regular Permit is adjusted downward by the calculations in § 715.218 of the EAA rules. For the San Antonio Pool, permitted withdrawal amounts are reduced by 40% during Stage IV.

In accordance with EAA rules, once per calendar year, irrigators may claim an exemption from critical period reductions so they can finish irrigating a crop already planted. To take advantage of this exemption, an irrigator must demonstrate that irrigation of the crop through harvest would require the irrigator to exceed his or her reduced permitted groundwater withdrawal amount. Persons finishing out a crop may file a Notice of Intent to Finish Out a Crop with the EAA at any time during the calendar year; however, such a form shall not be filed after December 1st. See EAA RULES § 715.219. These notice forms are available on the EAA website at www.edwardsaquifer.org, or may be obtained by requesting a copy. To aid in calculating the groundwater withdrawal amount authorized, permit holders may use the EAA Groundwater Calculator also available on the website.

PETITION. SA Tomahawk Rock, LP, Lennar Homes of Texas Land and Construction, Ltd. and AG EHC II (LEN) MULTI STATE 4, LLC, (Petitioners) filed a petition with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for the annexation of land into Guadalupe County Municipal Utility District No. 6 (District) under Local Government Code Section(§) 42.042 and the procedural rules of the TCEQ.

The petition states that: (1) the Petitioners hold title to all the property in the proposed annexation area to be included in the District; (2) there are no lienholders on the property to be annexed into the District; (3) the proposed property annexation will consist of (3) separate land tracts totaling approximately 244.823 acres located within Guadalupe County; and (4) all of the land within the proposed property annexation is within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Cibolo, Texas (City). The property proposed for annexation is near the western boundary of the district. Access to the annexation tracts will be by Green Valley Road to the north.


In accordance with Local Government Code §§ 42.0425 and 42.042, a petition was submitted to the City, requesting the City's consent to the annexation of land into the District. Information provided indicates that the City did not consent to the inclusion of the land into the District's area. After the 90-day period passed without receiving the City's consent to the annexation, a petition was submitted to the City requesting the City provide water and sanitary sewer services to the proposed annexation area. The 120-day period for reaching a mutually agreeable contract expired and the information provided indicates that the Petitioners and the City have not executed a mutually agreeable contract for service. Pursuant to Local Government Code § 42.042, failure to execute such an agreement constitutes authorization for the Petitioners to initiate proceedings to include the proposed annexation area into the District. The territory to be annexed into the District is depicted in the vicinity map designated as Exhibit "A," which is attached to this document.

CONTESTED CASE HEARING. The TCEQ rnay grant a contested case hearing on this amended petition if a written hearing request is filed within 30 days after the newspaper publication of

To request a contested case hearing, you must submit the following: (1) your name (or for a group or association, an official representative), mailing address, daytime phone number, and fax number, if any; (2) the name of the Petitioners and the TCEQ Internal Control Number; (3) the statement "I/we request a contested case hearing"; (4) a brief description of how you would be affected by the amended petition in a way not common to the general public; and 5) the location of your property relative to the proposed District's boundaries. You may also submit your proposed adjustments to the amended petition which would satisfy your concerns. Requests for a contested case hearing must be submitted in writing to the Office of the Chief Clerk at the address provided in the information section below.

The Executive Director may approve the amended petition unless a written request for a contested case hearing is filed within 30 days after the newspaper publication of this notice. If a hearing request is filed, the Executive Director will not approve the amended petition and will forward the amended petition and hearing request to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting. If a contested case hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

Does Crystal Clear SUD have your go-ahead to proceed with notice as requested? For ease of reference, below is the excerpt from CCSUD's cover letter requesting partial waiver of notice requirements:

Upon a finding of administrative and technical completeness, CCSUD respectfully requests a limited waiver of the Commission's notice requirements in connection with this application. Commission Rule 293.173, governing Impact Fee Notice Action and Requirements, requires that notice of an impact fee application be both published and provided by mail to "each owner of property within the service area... unless good cause is shown why such notice should not be given." Good cause exists here because CCSUD's service area consists of 175 square miles, and tens of thousands of individual landowners (many of whom are not retail customers of CCSUD but rely on private wells). Thus, written mailed notice would be prohibitively expensive.

As an alternative to individual mailed notice to all landowners, CCSUD proposes to send mailed notice to all landowners and developers who requested that CCSUD's consulting engineer perform hydraulic service feasibility and cost studies to properties within the District within the past 5 years. CCSUD further proposes inclusion of a billing insert to each of its approximately 6,000 current customers that would direct customers to the Commission-approved notice on CCSUD's website once issues. Finally, CCSUD proposed strict compliance with the newspaper publication requirements set forth in Commission Rule 293.173(c)(1).
