RE: Initial Application for Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester License- Second and Final Notice

Dear Mr. Brown:

This second and final notice is in regard to your Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester license application received by Executive Director (ED) of the Texas Commission of Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in September 2023. As part of the application review process, the ED is required to review an applicant's criminal history. The review was conducted in accordance with guidelines established by 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Section (§) 30.35. Any additional information that you may have submitted in response to our initial notice on October 31, 2023 regarding your rehabilitation efforts and compliance with court ordered requirements was also considered.

The review of your application revealed that you received a Class-B Misdemeanor in 2002, three Class-A Misdemeanors in 2004, a State Jail Felony in 2005, a Class-A Misdemeanor and a State Jail Felony in 2006, a Third-Degree Felony in 2011, and deferred adjudication for a Class-A Misdemeanor in 2022. The ED intends to deny your Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester license application because you have been and she considers you to have been convicted of offenses that directly relate to the license as referenced in Texas Occupations Code (TOC) § 53.021(a)(1). The ED also considered the factors in TOC §§ 53.022 and 53.023 and this decision was based on the nature and seriousness of the crimes, the relationship of the crimes to the purposes for requiring a license to engage in the occupation, the opportunity the license may offer to engage in further criminal activity of the same type as that in which you were previously involved, the extent and nature of your past criminal activity, your age when the crimes were committed, the amount of time that has elapsed since your last criminal activity, and the fact that you have not completed supervision and are scheduled to complete court supervision in October 2023.

You may request a formal hearing on the denial of your Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester license application. The hearing request must be made in writing and must contain your name, address, and phone number. The Chief Clerk's Office must receive your request no later than 30 calendar days after the United States Post Office delivery date of this letter. The formal hearing is known as a contested case hearing and is conducted by the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH). The contested case hearing usually consists of a preliminary hearing and an evidentiary hearing. The purpose of a preliminary hearing is to establish jurisdiction, name the parties, establish a procedural schedule for the remainder of the proceeding, provide an opportunity for settlement discussions, and address other matters as determined by the administrative law judge. The preliminary hearing will be held unless all timely hearing requests are withdrawn or denied or the parties agree to waive the preliminary hearing.

The evidentiary phase of the contested case hearing, to be held at a later date, will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court to determine whether you should be issued a Backflow Prevention Assembly Tester license. Unless agreed to by all parties in attendance at the preliminary hearing, an evidentiary hearing will not be held on the date of this preliminary hearing.


If you fail to appear at the preliminary hearing or evidentiary hearing, the ED will request that the hearing be canceled and that the appeal of the ED's decision be dismissed.

SOAH's rules allow for participation by telephone or videoconference. Permission must be obtained from SOAH at least ten days before the hearing.

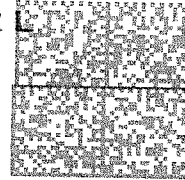
