City of Hudson Oaks, 210 Hudson Oaks Drive, Hudson Oaks, Texas 76087, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for new Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0016323001, to authorize the discharge of treated America was transpared a surger flow not to exceed domestic wastewater at an annual average flow not to exceed 1,190,000 gallons per day.

The facility will be located approximately 1,150 feet west of the intersection of Clearview Court and Trinity River Drive, in Parker County, Texas 76087. The treated effluent will be discharged via pipe to South Fork Trinity River, thence to Clear Fork Trinity River Below Lake Weatherford in Segment No. 0831 of the Trinity River Basin. The unclassified receiving water use is high aquatic life use for South Fork Trinity River. The designated uses for Segment No. 0831 are primary contact recreation, public water supply, and high aquatic life use. In accordance with 30 Texas Administrative Code § 307.5 and TCEQ's Procedures to Implement the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards (June 2010), an antidegradation review of the receiving waters was performed. A Tier 1 antidegradation review has preliminarily determined that existing water quality uses will not be impaired by this permit action. Numerical and narrative criteria to protect existing uses will be maintained. A Tier 2 review has preliminarily determined that no significant degradation of water quality is expected in South Fork Trinity River and Segment No. 0831, which have been identified as having high aquatic life uses.
