PETITION.

VORWERK FARMS, LLC, a Texas limited liability company (Petitioner) filed a petition for the creation of Williamson County Municipal Utility District No. 52 (District) with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). The petition was filed pursuant to Article XVI, § 59 and Article III, § 52 of the Constitution of the State of Texas; Chapters 49 and 54 of the Texas Water Code; 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 293; and the procedural rules of the TCEQ.

The petition states that: (1) the Petitioner holds title to a majority in value of the land to be included in the proposed District; (2) there is no lienholder on the property other than Texas Farm Credit Services, FLCA; (3) the proposed District will contain approximately 152.29 acres of land, more or less, located entirely within Williamson County, Texas; (4) no portion of land within the proposed District is within the corporate limits or extraterritorial jurisdiction of any city, town or village in Texas.

The petition further states that the proposed District will (1) purchase, construct, acquire, improve, or extend inside or outside of its boundaries any and all works, improvements, facilities, plants, equipment, and appliances necessary or helpful to supply and distribute water for municipal, domestic, and commercial purposes; (2) to collect, transport, process, dispose of and control domestic, and commercial wastes; (3) to gather, conduct, divert, abate, amend and control local stormwater or other local harmful excesses of water in the District; and (4) to purchase, construct, acquire, improve, or extend inside or outside or its boundaries such additional facilities, systems, plants and enterprises, road facilities, and park and recreational facilities, as shall be consonant with the purposes for which the District is created.

According to the petition, a preliminary investigation has been made to determine the cost of the project, and it is estimated by the Petitioners, from the information available at this time, that the cost of said project will be approximately \$43,255,000 (\$35,200,000 for water, wastewater, and drainage facilities, \$1,955,000 for recreational and \$6,100,000 for road facilities).


