AN INTERIM ORDER regarding the Petition by OP III ATX GEORGETOWN 220, LP for the creation of Williamson County Municipal Utility District No. 60; TCEQ Docket 2025-0288-DIS.

On May 22, 2025, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission) considered during its open meeting a request for a contested case hearing filed by Williamson County concerning the Petition of OP III ATX GEORGETOWN 220, LP (Petitioner) for the creation of Williamson County Municipal Utility District No. 60 (District) in Williamson County. The hearing request was evaluated under the requirements in the applicable statutes and Commission rules, including 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 55, Subchapter G. The Commission also considered the responses to the hearing request filed by the Executive Director and the Office of Public Interest Counsel and all timely public comment.

After evaluation of all relevant filings, the Commission determined to grant the hearing request of Williamson County and to refer the matter to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a contested case hearing on the Petition with a concurrent referral to the TCEQ's Alternative Dispute Resolution Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY that:

- 1. The request for contested case hearing submitted by Williamson County is hereby GRANTED;
- 2. The matter is REFERRED to SOAH for a contested case hearing on the Petition;
- 3. The matter is REFERRED to the TCEQ's Alternative Dispute Resolution Program to run concurrently with SOAH's scheduling process; and
- 4. If any provision, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Order is for any reason held to be invalid, the invalidity of any portion shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Order.
